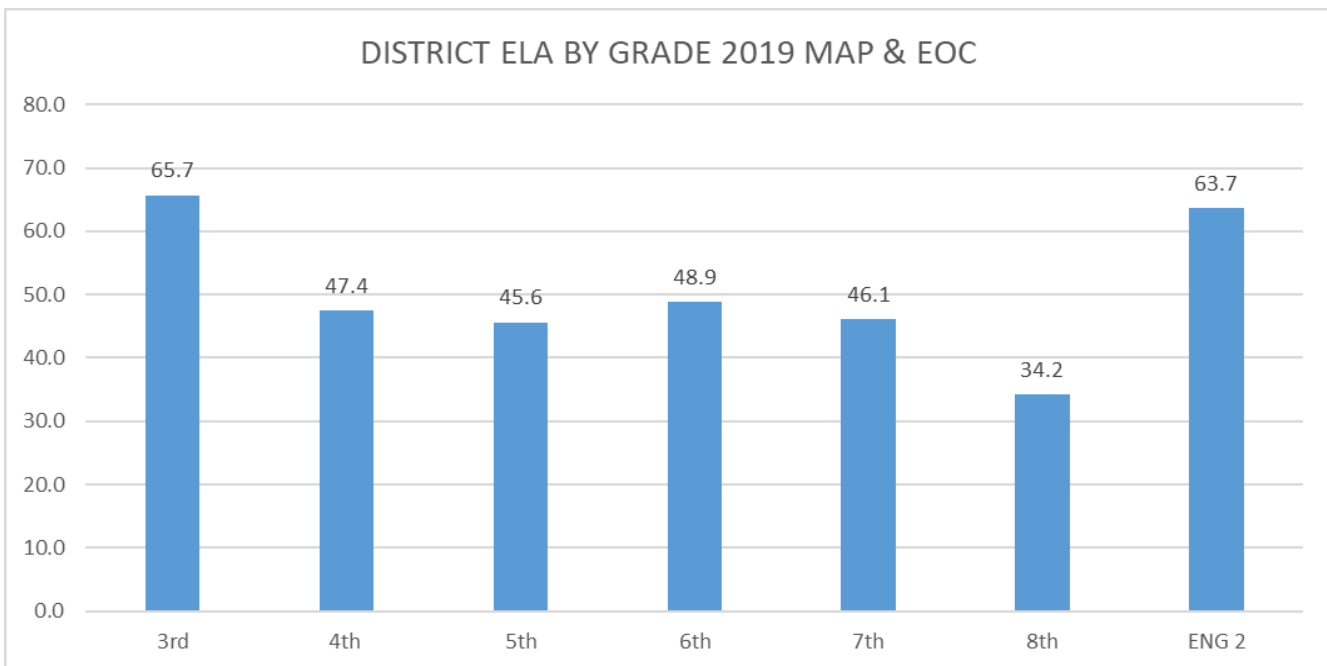
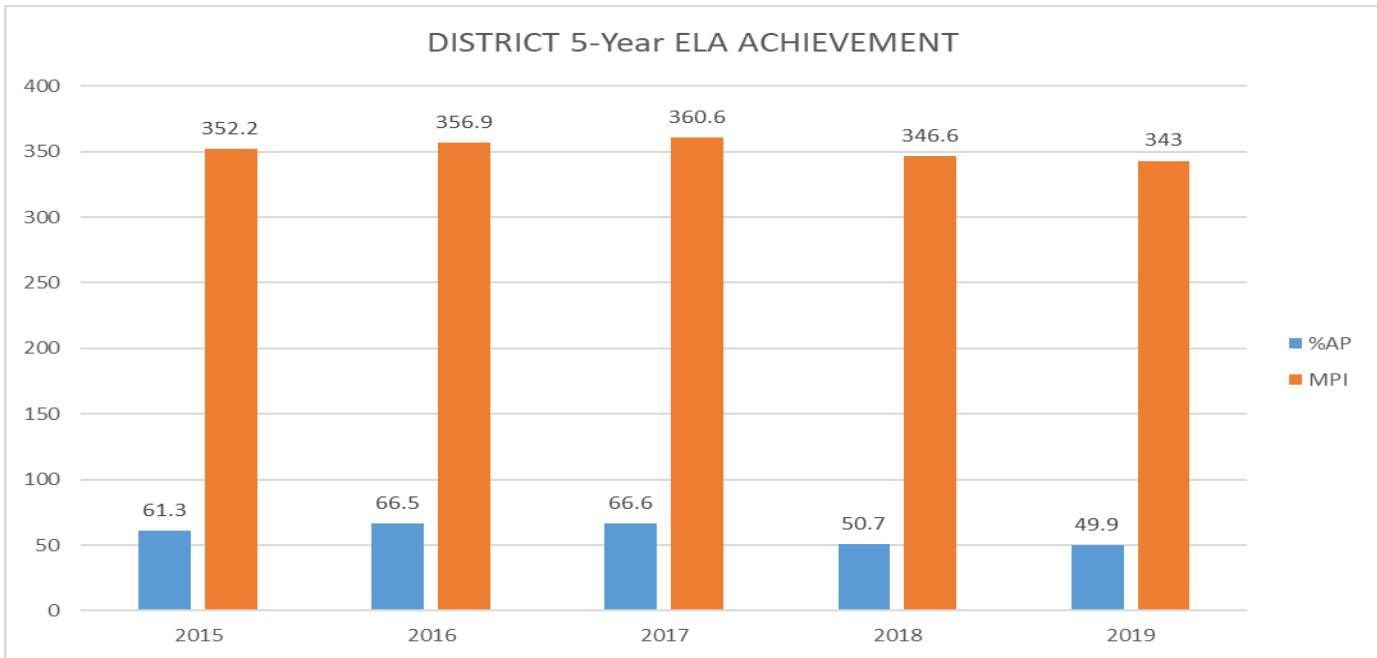
- In the spring of 2019 the Missouri Assessment Program (MAP) and End of Course (EOC) exams had new assessments in the area of Science. Therefore, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) recommended against year to year comparisons and created new proficiency ranges (below basic to advance) and new status targets. Likewise, the EOC in Government was a field tested item and scores will not be released to schools.
- This fall the state released a new platform and reporting view for the Annual Performance Report (APR). The new method of measuring districts was to compare schools to the state averages, instead of reporting a percentage score as in years past.

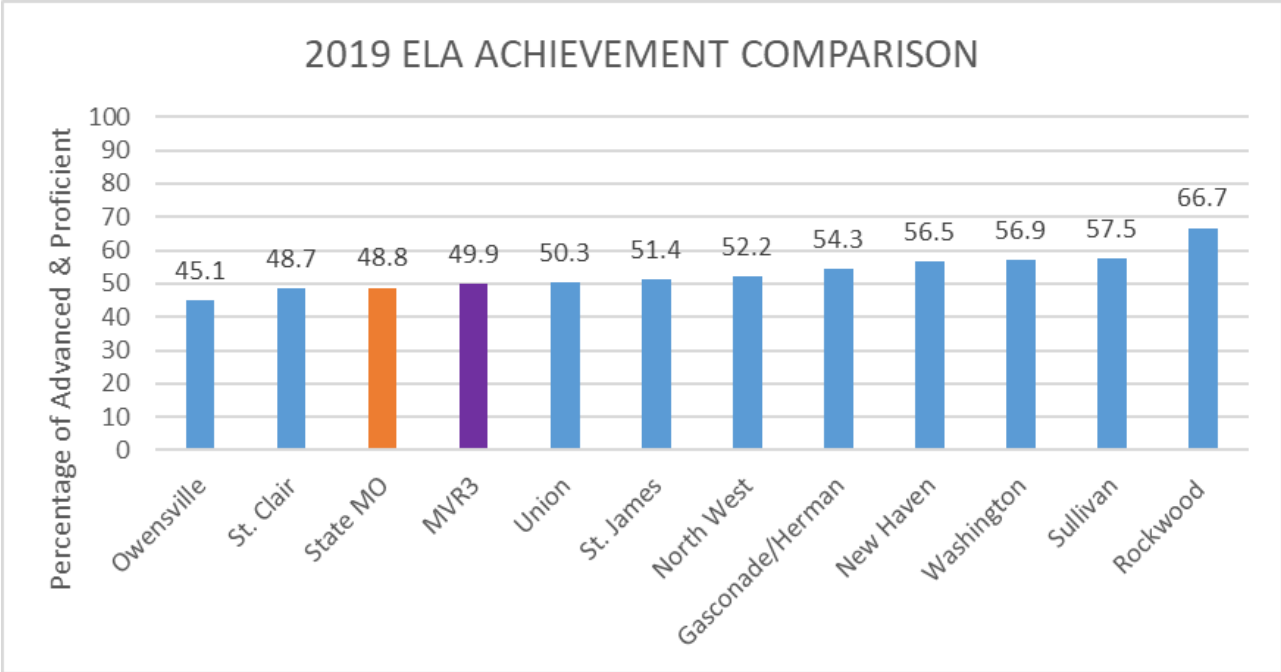
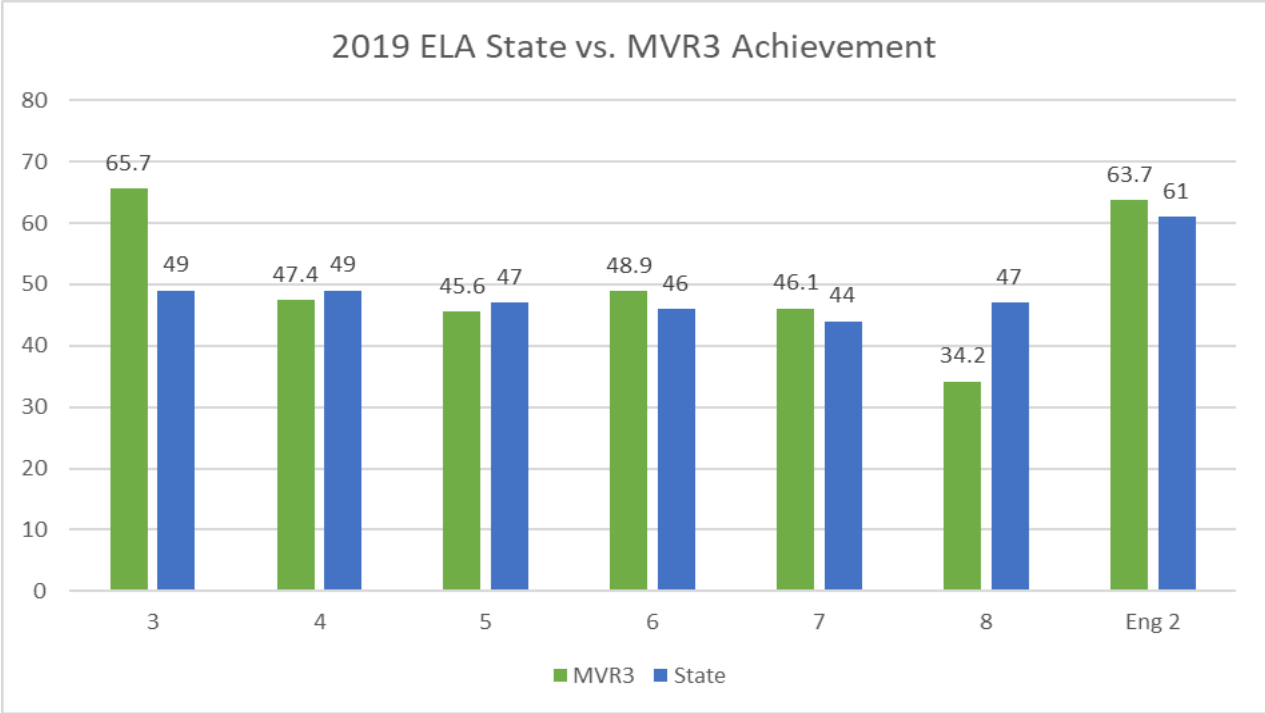
APR Performance Areas: The following are the areas in which points are awarded for overall district accountability. All MVR-III school and student data is averaged into a district APR report card including:

- ***Achievement***- MAP and EOC
- ***Sub Group Achievement***- MAP and EOC of (free/reduced lunch, racial/ethnic background, English language learners, and students with disabilities)
- ***College and Career Readiness Standards***
 - Indicators 1/3- Percent of graduates who scored at or above the state standards on measures of college or career readiness such as: ACT, ACT WorkKeys, or ASVAB
 - Indicator 4- Percent of graduates who earned a qualifying score on an: AP, TSA and/or received college credit through early college, dual enrollment or approved dual credit
 - Indicator 5/6- Percent of graduates who: attend post-secondary education/training, are in the military, or complete a career education program and are placed in occupations, within 6 months of graduation

- ***Graduation Rate***

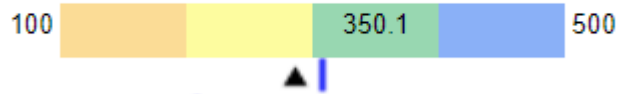

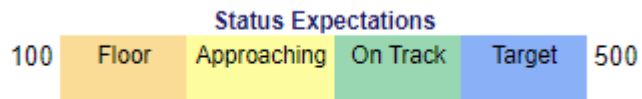

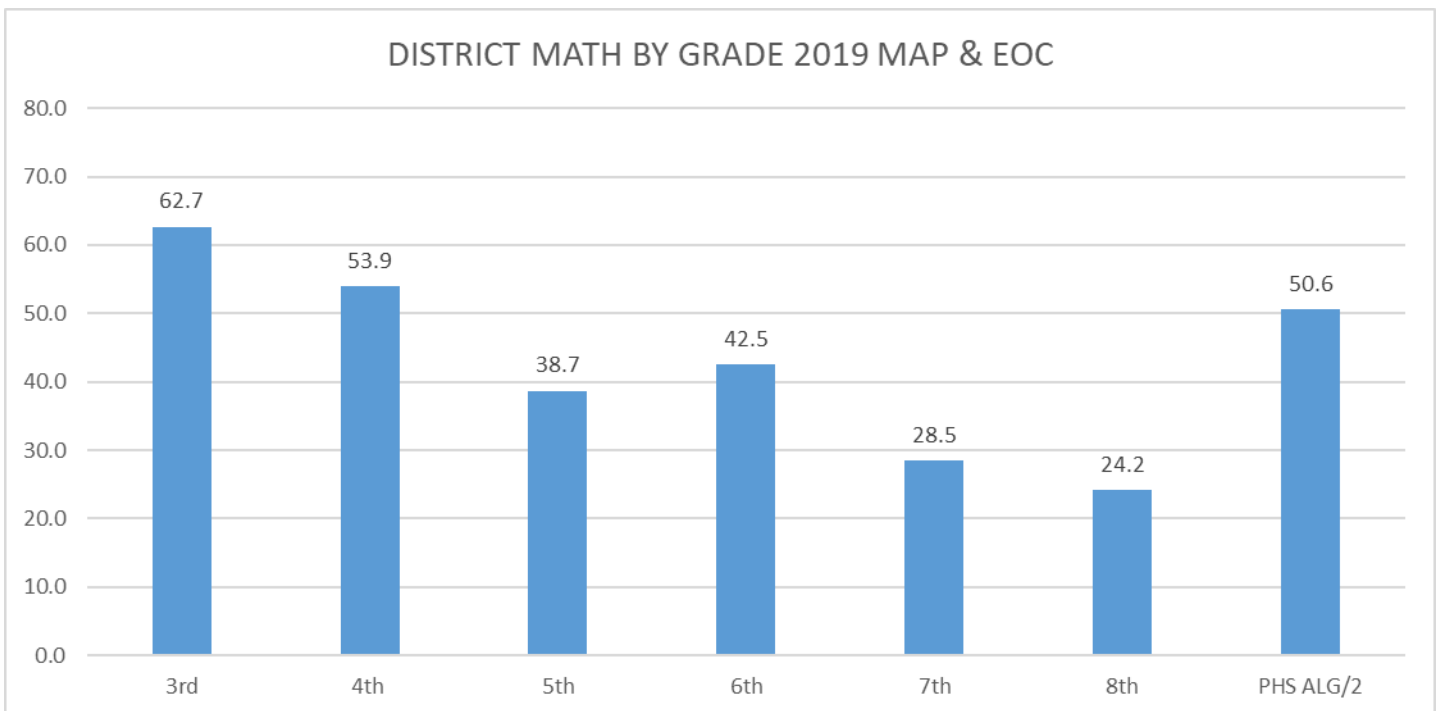
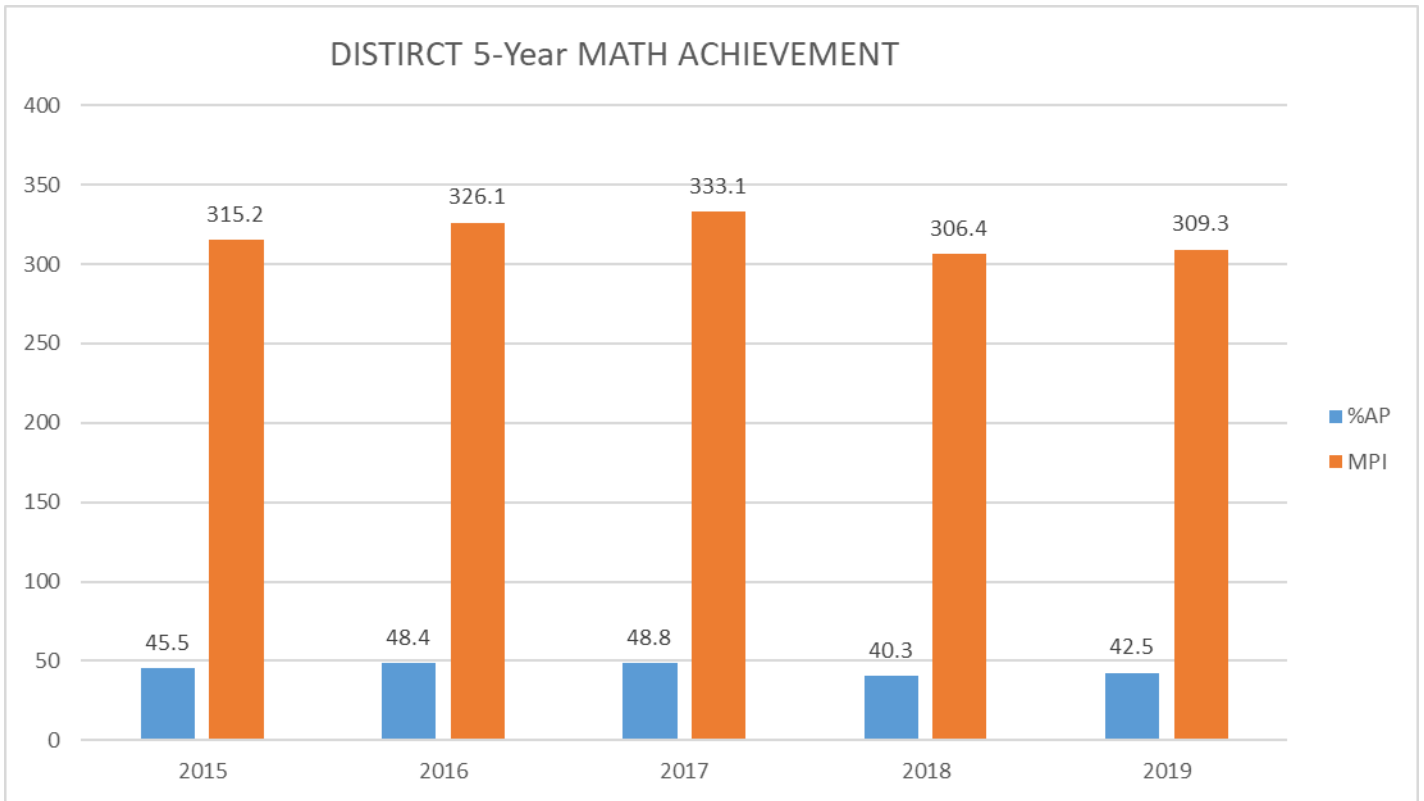

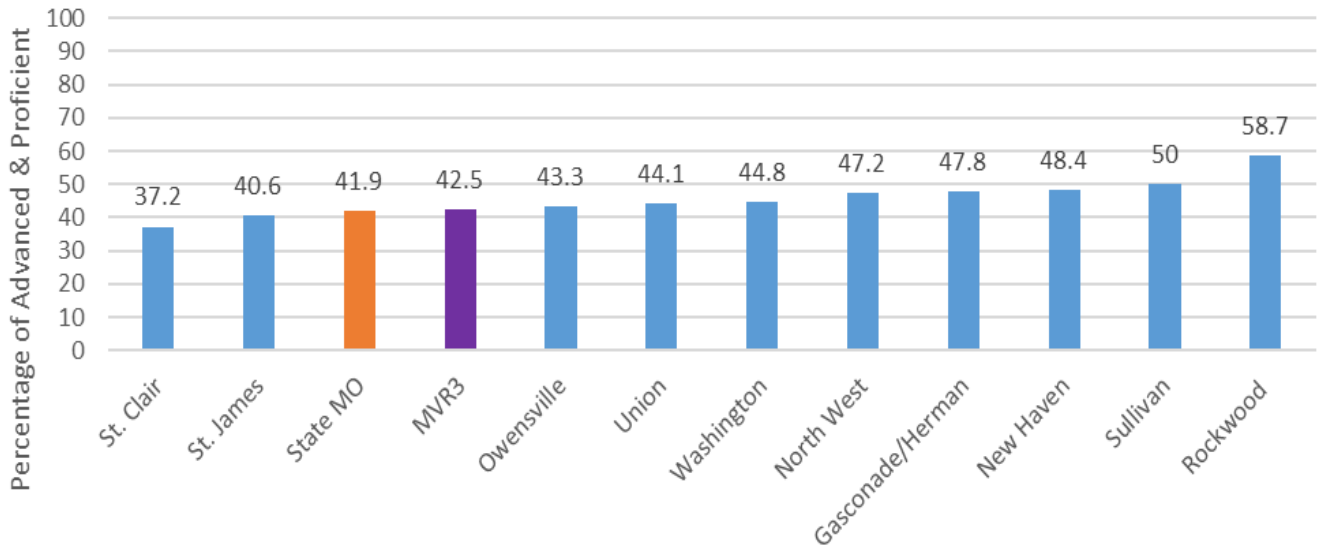
ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT: District Mathematics Achievement



2019 MATH State vs. MVR3 Achievement



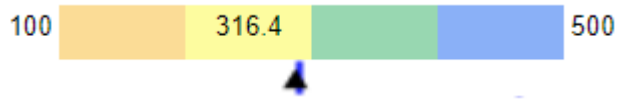
2019 MATH ACHIEVEMENT COMPARISON

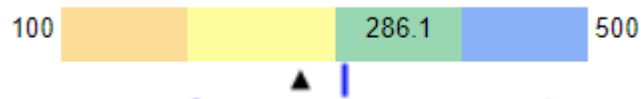

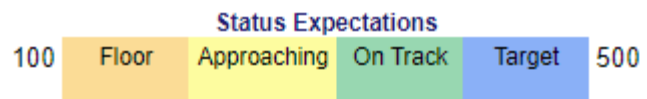

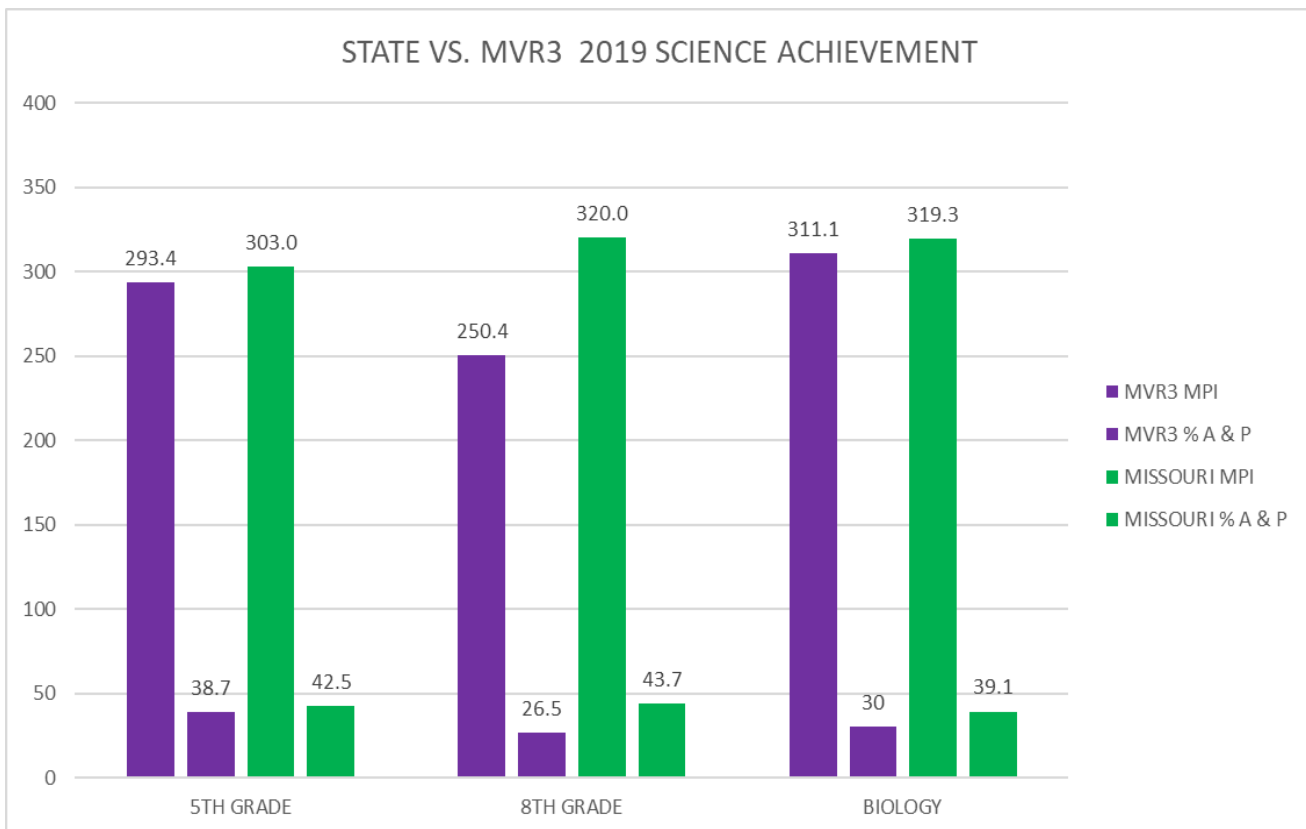
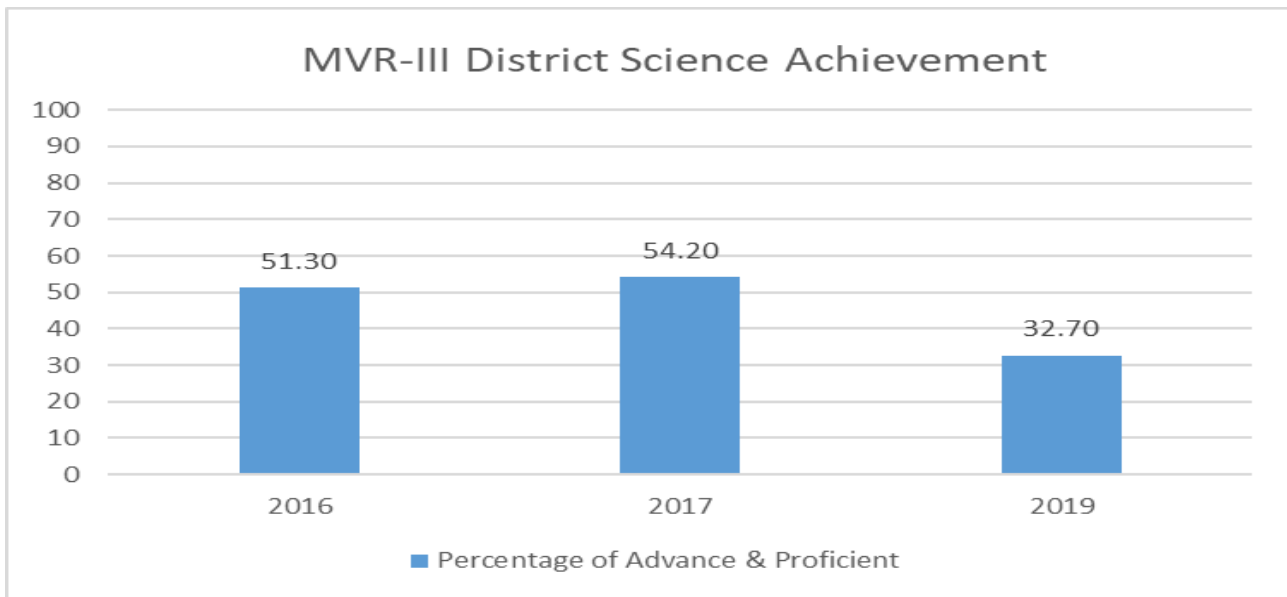

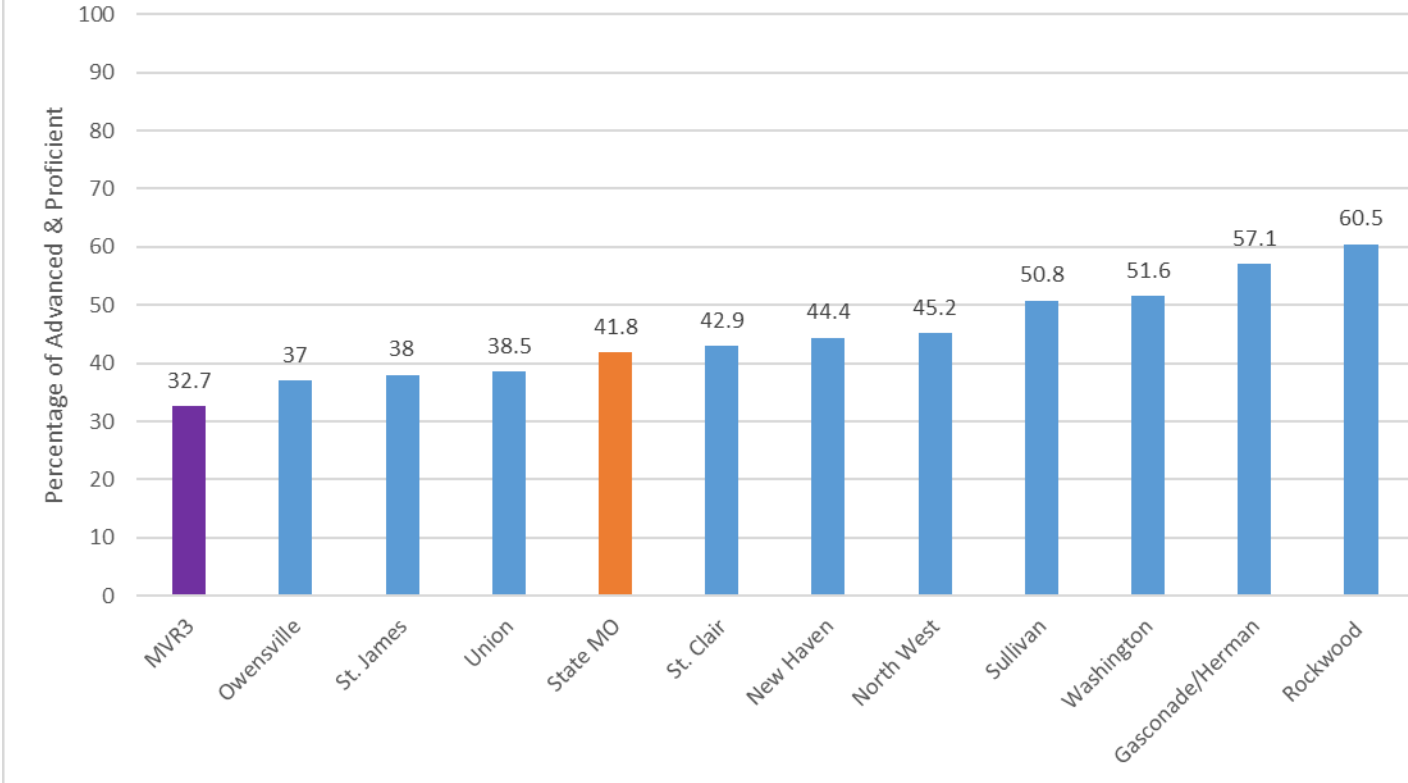
ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT: District Science Achievement



2019 5TH GRADE SCIENCE vs. STATE



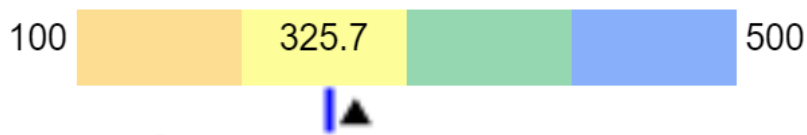
2019 SCIENCE ACHIEVEMENT COMPARISON

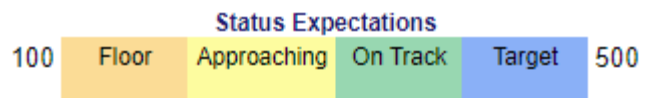
DISTRICT Science SUB-GROUP ACHIEVEMENT

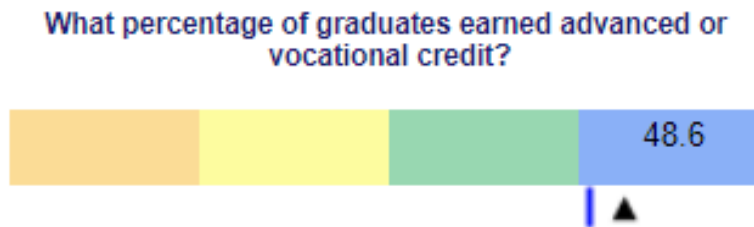

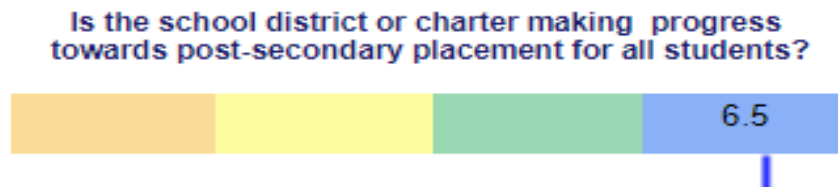

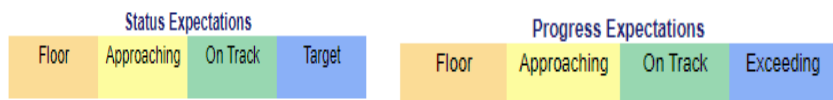

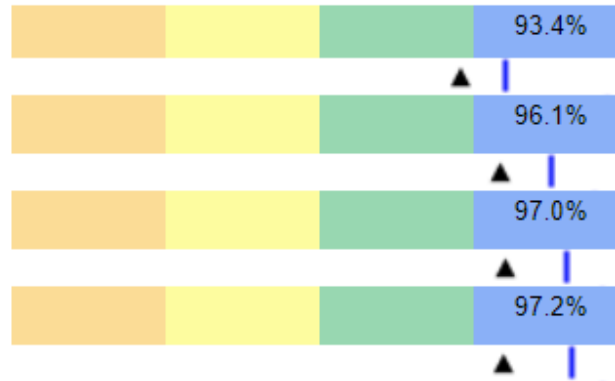
What percentage of students were present 90% of the time?

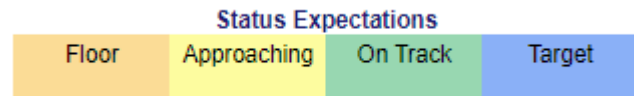
What percentage of students graduated after 4, 5, 6 or 7 years?
