Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) Notice for Directory Information

The *Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act* (FERPA), a Federal law, requires that Cheney Unified School District, with certain exceptions obtain your written consent prior to the disclosure of personally identifiable information from your child's education records. However, Cheney USD 268 may disclose appropriately designated "directory information" without written consent, unless you have advised the District to the contrary in accordance with District procedures. The primary purpose of directory information is to allow Cheney USD 268 to include this type of information from your child's education records in certain school publications.

Examples include:

- A playbill, showing your student's role in a drama production;
- Annual yearbook;
- Honor roll or other recognition lists;
- Graduation programs;
- Sports activity programs, showing weight and height of team members;
- Music concert programs;
- School directory

Directory information, which is information that is generally not considered harmful or an invasion of privacy if released, can also be disclosed to outside organizations without a parent's prior written consent. Outside organizations include, but are not limited to, companies that manufacture class rings or publish yearbooks.

In addition, two federal laws require local educational agencies (LEAs) receiving assistance under the *Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965* (ESEA) to provide military recruiters, upon request, with the following information – names, addresses and telephone listings – unless parents have advised the LEA that they do not want their student's information disclosed without their prior written consent. **[Note: These laws are Section 9528 of the ESEA (20 U.S.C. § 7908) and 10 U.S.C. § 503(c).]**

If you do **not** want Cheney Unified School District to disclose directory information from your child's education records without your prior written consent, you must notify the District in writing by **Sept 1, 2025**. Cheney Unified School District has designated the following information as directory information:

- **Student's name**
- **Address**
- **Telephone listing**
- **Electronic mail address**
- **Photograph**
- **Date and place of birth**
- **Major field of study**
- **Dates of attendance**
- **Grade level**
- **Participation in officially recognized activities and sports**
- **Weight and height of members of athletic teams**
- **Degrees, honors, and awards received**
- **The most recent educational agency or institution attended**
- **Student ID number, user ID, or other unique personal identifier used to communicate in electronic systems that cannot be used to access education records without a PIN, password, etc. (A student's SSN, in whole or in part, cannot be used for this purpose.)**

Student Entrance Requirements

Any child who is five years old on or before August 31 is eligible to attend kindergarten. Any child who is six years old on or before August 31 is eligible to enter the first grade. Requirements for enrolling in Kansas schools include: a valid birth certificate, proof of immunization and a current physical examination.

Free or Reduced Child Nutrition Program

Free or reduced priced meal benefits are available to those students whose families have a total income lower than the federal guidelines to suggest for lunch assistance. Applications are available on our district website, www.usd268.org, as part of enrollment. Applications should be filled out completely and submitted through the enrollment process. Parents are strongly encouraged to apply for free or reduced priced lunches as it benefits families financially. Regardless of whether or not a family intends to accept the reduced meal rates, qualifying for the benefits will help in funding the school's at-risk programs. All information is kept in strict confidence.

Notice to Families Enrolled in the Cheney USD 268 School District

Any household qualifying for free meal benefits will not have to pay Instructional Fees. Qualifying households will pay the following fees for the 2025-2026 school year:

- Those qualifying for Free Meal Benefits: **No Instructional Fees**
- Those qualifying for Reduced Meal Benefits: **Instructional Fees will be half of the regular instructional fee amount.**

Non-Resident Student Enrollment (Policy JBCC)

New non-resident students will be approved only to the extent that space is available. The USD 268 Board of Education will determine the capacity available in each grade level in the school district for each upcoming school year. The number of open seats available to non-resident students in each grade level can be found on the district's website at www.usd268.org. New applications must be submitted between June 1 and June 30 of each year. You will be officially notified in July if capacity is available for your child.

Student Physical Examinations

The KSHSAA requires that a physical examination form, signed by a physician and parent, be on file with the school district before a student may practice or participate in any type of interscholastic sport or cheerleading. These forms are available at the CHS and CMS school offices. They are also posted on our website under EXPLORE; PARENT LINKS; SCHOOL PHYSICAL. As a reminder, the school district does not pay for physical examinations required for participation in athletics and cheerleading.

Physical examinations are not required for regular physical education courses. It is the responsibility of the parents to inform the school of any physical education limitations due to medical conditions.

Required Health Assessments

A state law requires a child health assessment for all children ages eight and under, including preschoolers who are enrolling for the first time in any Kansas school. This health assessment may be completed up to 12 months prior to school entry or within 90 days after school entry. Noncompliance may result in exclusion from school.

HealthWave Insurance for Kids

HealthWave is a state and federally funded health insurance program that can provide Kansas children and teens with health insurance at little or no cost. Parents are encouraged to call HealthWave at 800-792-4884 for information or an application. You may also visit their website at <http://www.benefitsapplication.com/apply/KS/Healthwave>.

Annual Asbestos Notification

Cheney USD 268 wants district patrons to understand that the district is in compliance with federal asbestos management regulations. It is important to note that all friable asbestos materials must be removed from schools. Once such material has been identified, a program can be implemented to ensure that the material is maintained in good condition, with appropriate procedures followed should any asbestos material be disturbed for any reason. The district has implemented a plan to inform and train staff members how to maintain remaining asbestos. This management plan is on file at all school offices. Questions concerning Cheney USD 268's asbestos management plan should be directed to the District Office at 316-542-3512. Parents Right to Know-Provision of ESEA of 2002

The Elementary and Secondary Act of 2002 (ESEA or "Every Student Succeeds Act") requires schools to annually notify parents of their right to request information on the professional qualifications of their child's teachers and paraprofessionals. The ESEA goal is for every child to have "highly qualified" teachers. Highly qualified teachers in Kansas are those individuals who have obtained college degrees and full Kansas certification as a teacher in the area the individual is teaching. Teachers have not had certification or licensure requirements waived on an emergency, temporary, or provisional basis when they are highly qualified.

A parent who wishes to know the qualifications of his/her child's teacher or paraprofessional may request this information from the building principal.

District Report Card & State Assessment Scores

To view the State Assessments data, scroll all the way down and click on the National Assessment of Education Progress icon. To get your child's individual assessment score, you may call your child's building principal.

Compliance with Federal Regulations

In compliance with all federal, state, and district laws, policies and regulations, Cheney USD 268 shall not discriminate on the basis of gender, ethnicity, color, national origin, age, homelessness or handicap in the employment or educational activities operated by the district. It is the intent of Cheney USD 268 to comply with both the letter and the spirit of the law in making certain that discrimination does not exist in its policies, regulations, or operations.

Grievance procedures for Title 9 and Section 504 have been established for students, parents, and staff members who feel that discrimination has been shown by the school district. Specific complaints of alleged discrimination under the Title 9 should be referred to the; Regional Office for Civil Rights, 324 East 11th Street, Kansas City, Missouri 64106. Specific complaints of alleged discrimination under Section 504 should be referred to; Marc Woofter, Superintendent, Cheney USD 268, 100 W. Sixth Ave., Cheney KS 67025.

Senior Citizen Activity Passes

Any Cheney USD 268 patron who is 65 or older and resides within the school district is eligible to receive a complimentary pass to district-sponsored activities where admission is charged. Nonresident grandparents at least 65 years of age are also eligible for senior citizen passes when their grandchild is participating in any type of co-curricular activity. Contact the Cheney High School office at 316-542-3113 to receive a complimentary senior citizen pass.

Board of Education Policy 07-23

The unlawful possession, use, or distribution of illicit drugs and/or alcohol by students or school employees on school premises or as a part of any school activity is prohibited. This policy is required by the 1989 amendments to Drug Free Schools and Communities Act, P.L. 102-226.

Immunization Requirements for the 2025 - 2026 School Year

K.A.R. 28-1-20 defines immunizations required for any individual who attends school or a childcare program operated by a school. Below are the requirements for the indicated school year. Please carefully review the requirements. The usual number of doses required are listed; however there are exceptional circumstances that could alter the number of doses a child needs. If you have questions about your child's immunization status, contact your child's primary care provider or local health department.

Proof of receiving the required immunizations must be provided to the school prior to the student attending the first day of school.

Meningococcal (MenACWY) Vaccine:

Two doses are required for 11th and 12th grade students. The 1st dose is due at entry to 7th grade at 11-12 years of age. The 2nd dose is due at entry to 11th grade at 16-18 years of age. Any 11th graders who are not yet 16 years old, should wait until their 16th birthday to receive the dose. *Those 16-18 year olds with no previous MenACWY vaccine, only one dose required.*

Notes

* Varicella (chickenpox) vaccine is not required if child has had disease **and** disease is documented by physician signature. Without a physician signature, vaccine is still required even if you believe your child has had chickenpox disease.

** Total doses needed depend on vaccine type and child's age when doses were administered.

*** Three doses are acceptable if the 3rd dose was given after 4 years of age, and there are at least 6 months between the second and third doses.

~ All students in grades 7-12 must have one dose of Tdap regardless of the interval since the last dose of DTaP or Td.

Additional ACIP RECOMMENDED Vaccines

Not Required for School Entry

HPV (Human Papillomavirus) Vaccine:

2 doses recommended at age 11 years *See below:*
2 doses needed if series is started at 11-14 years
3 doses needed if series is started at 15 years or older

Influenza (Flu) Vaccine and COVID-19 Vaccine:

Annual vaccine recommended for everyone 6 months of age and older
