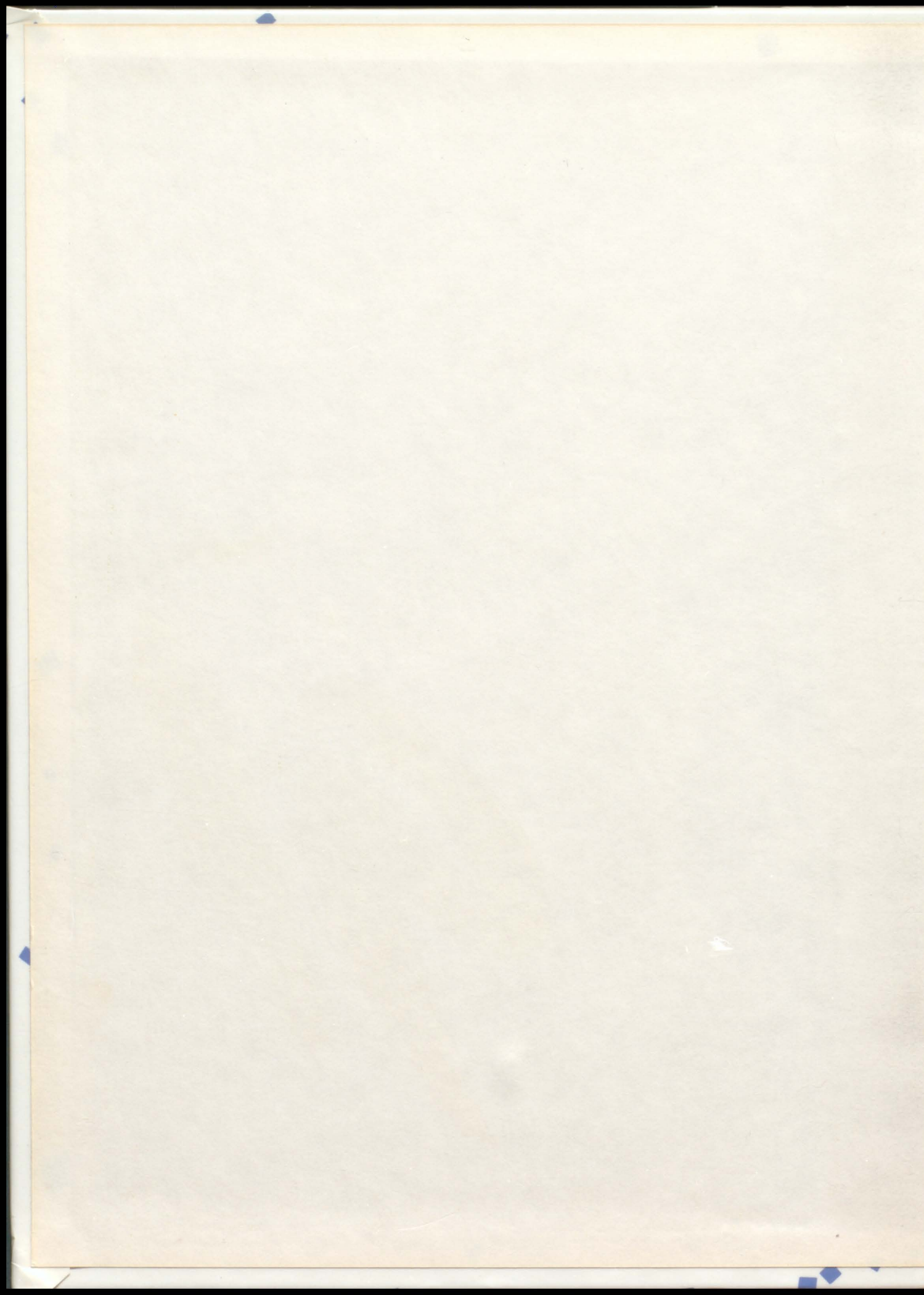

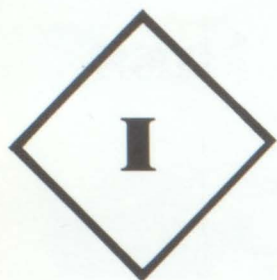

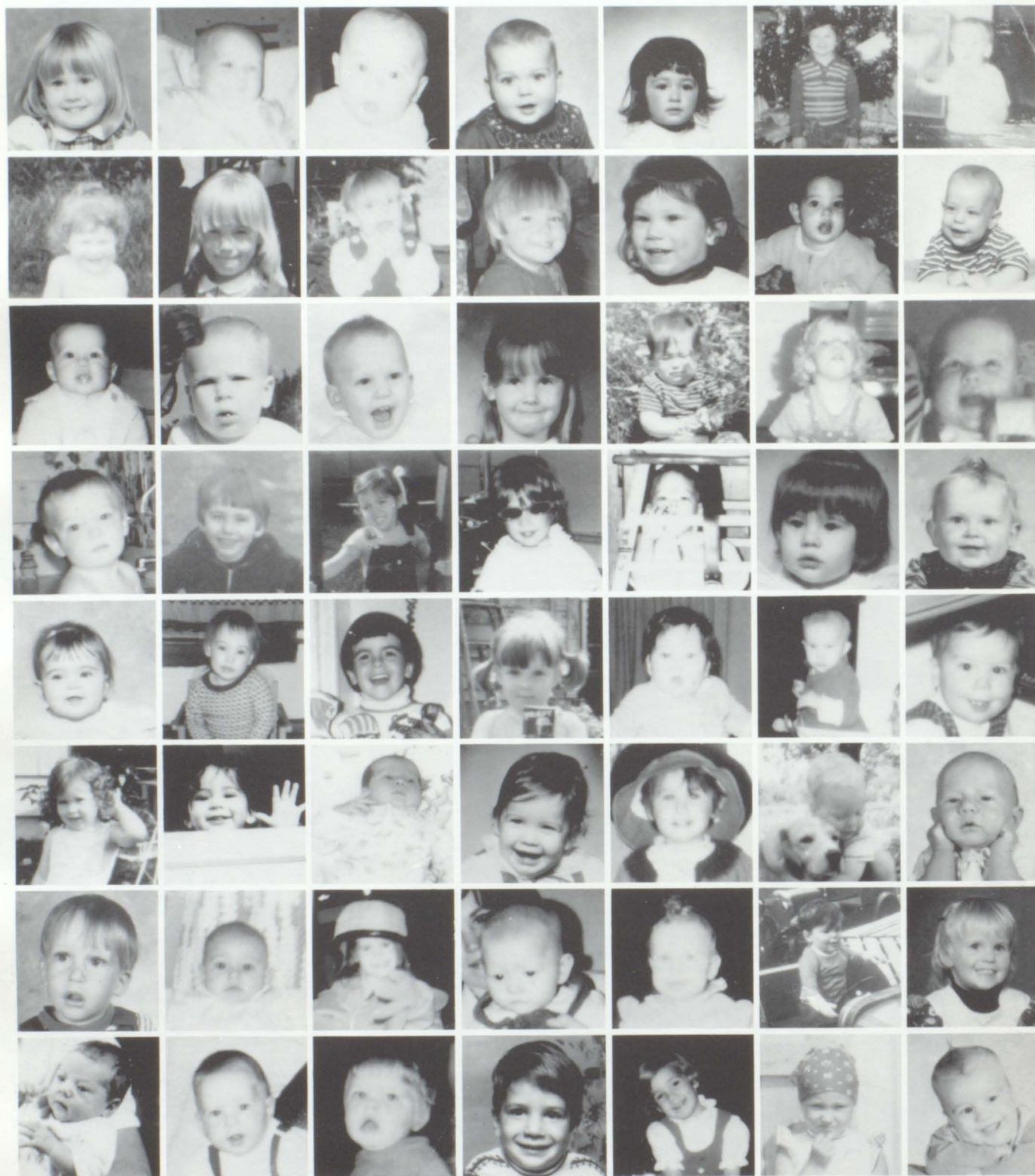
Dedication to Senior Class
