- Strong organizational, communication, and interpersonal skills.

The Librarian/Media Specialist provides leadership in developing, maintaining, and promoting a comprehensive school library media program that supports the instructional goals of Coyle Public Schools. - Assist students and staff in locating, evaluating, and utilizing information effectively.
- Manage library circulation, cataloging, inventory, and collection development processes.
- Evaluate library resources and recommend additions, updates, and replacements as needed.
- Maintain a welcoming, organized, and student-centered library environment.
- Support the use of instructional technology and digital learning tools throughout the district.
- Coordinate reading initiatives, book fairs, literacy events, and other programs that encourage student engagement.
- Train and assist staff in accessing and utilizing library and digital resources.
- Develop and maintain library policies and procedures in accordance with district guidelines.
- Prepare reports, maintain records, and manage library budgets as assigned.
- Stay current on developments in library science, educational technology, and literacy instruction.
- Attend faculty meetings, professional development activities, and district events as required.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Principal or Superintendent.

Physical Requirements:

- Ability to stand, walk, bend, lift, and carry library materials and equipment weighing up to 25 pounds.
- Ability to operate computers, audiovisual equipment, and other instructional technology.
- Ability to perform duties in a school environment with frequent interaction with students and staff.

- School library/media center and classroom environments.
- Occasional evening or after-school events and activities.
- Frequent interaction with students, staff, parents, and community members.
