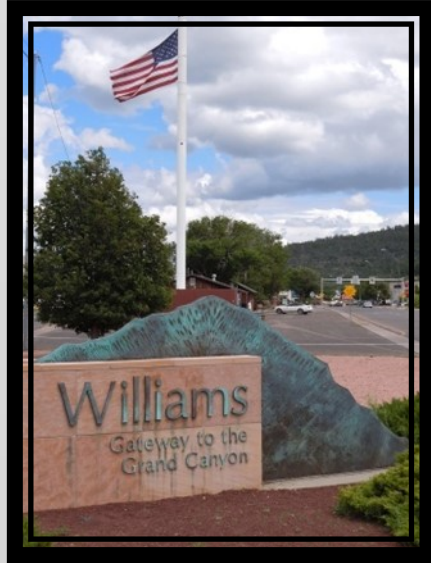


Williams Area
