Completing one application allows you to apply for multiple scholarships. These scholarships are for Galesburg High School seniors and are privately funded. Scholarship recipients are selected by those who fund the scholarship or by a committee at GJSHS.

Galesburg *Promise*

The Galesburg Promise program consists of funds to assist students with the cost of tuition at Carl Sandburg College. All seniors are encouraged to apply to Sandburg and for the Galesburg Promise even if attending Sandburg is not your first option.

Students must apply to Carl Sandburg College BEFORE completing the Promise Application.

There are 2 steps to the Galesburg Promise. You must complete the Promise Application AND the Foundation Scholarship Application.

The Counseling Office is partnering with Carl Sandburg College for a Promise Application Workshop on the morning of Tuesday, January 27th. All students who have applied to Carl Sandburg College will receive a pass to attend.
