Jason Reinhard moved, seconded by Ann Holstein and carried unanimously to approve item (10):

**10. Approve Bond Resolution dated June 11, 2012 of the Board of Education of the Greenville Central School District authorizing the issuance of not to exceed \$877,929.05 aggregate principal amount of general obligation serial bonds to finance the acquisition of school vehicles at an estimated maximum cost of \$877,929.05, the levy of a tax in annual installments in payment thereof, the expenditure of such sum for such purpose, and determining other matters in connection therewith.**

*(WHEREAS, the qualified voters of the Greenville Central School District (the “School district”) at the annual School District meeting duly held on May 15, 2012, duly approved a proposition (the “Proposition”) authorizing the acquisition of the School Vehicles at a cost not to exceed \$877,929.05, the expenditure of such sum for such purpose, the levy of the necessary tax therefor taking into account state aid received, to be levied and collected in annual installments in such years and in such amounts as may be determined by the Board of Education, and, to finance the same, the issuance of general obligation bonds and notes in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$877,929.05; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE GREENVILLE CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT (by the favorable vote of not less than two-thirds of such Board) AS FOLLOWS:*

*Section 1. The Board hereby finds and determines that the acquisition of school buses and vans (collectively, the “School Vehicles”), as approved by, the voters of the School District at the annual School District meeting held on May 15, 2012, is a Type II action within the meaning of the State Environmental Quality Review Act and the regulations promulgated thereunder (collectively, “SEQRA”) and no further action under SEQRA is required with respect to such acquisition.*

*Section 2. The School District shall acquire the School Vehicles, as approved by the voters of the School District at the annual School District meeting duly held on May 15, 2012.*

*Section 3. The School District is hereby authorized to issue its general obligation serial bonds (the “Bonds”) in the aggregate principal amount of not*

*to exceed \$877,929.05 pursuant to the Local Finance Law of New York, in order to finance the acquisition of the School Vehicles.*

*Section 4. The class of objects or purposes to be financed pursuant to this Resolution is the acquisition of the School Vehicles.*

*Section 5. It is hereby determined and stated that (a) the maximum cost of the acquisition of the School Vehicles, as estimated by the Board of Education, is \$877,929.05; (b) no money has heretofore been authorized to be applied to the payment of the cost of said acquisition; (c) the School District plans to finance the cost of said acquisition entirely from funds raised by the issuance of the Bonds and bond anticipation notes hereinafter referred to; and (d) the School District, including any subordinate entity of the School District (within the meaning of Section 265(b)(3)(E) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code")), is not expected to issue more than \$10,000,000 of "qualified tax-exempt obligations" (as defined in Section 265(b)(3)(B) of the Code) during the 2012 calendar year.*

*Section 6. The following additional matters are hereby determined and stated:*

- a) The period of probable usefulness of the specific objects or purposes for which the bonds authorized by this Resolution are to be issued in five (5) years, within the limitation of Section 11.00(a)(29) of the Law.*
- b) The requirements of Section 37.00 of the Law and Section 416 of the Education Law have been met.*
- c) The Bonds authorized by this Resolution are not private activity bonds as defined in Section 141 of the Code.*
- d) All of the proceeds of the Bonds authorized by this Resolution and any notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said Bonds shall be used to pay for the acquisition of the School Vehicles.*
- e) All actions taken by the employees of the School District in placing the Proposition before the voters are hereby approved, ratified and confirmed.*
- f) The Recitals set forth at the beginning of this Resolution are hereby incorporated in this Resolution as if set forth in full in this place.*

*Section 7. The power to further authorize the issuance of the Bonds and bond anticipation notes and to prescribe the terms, form and contents of the Bonds and bond anticipation notes (including, without limitation, the use of substantially level or declining annual debt service as provided by Section 21 of the Local Finance Law, the power to designate the Bonds and bond anticipation notes as "qualified tax-exempt obligations" as provided in Section 265(b) of the Code and the consolidation with other issues), subject to the provisions of this Resolution and the Local Finance Law, and to sell and deliver the Bonds and bond anticipation notes, is hereby delegated to the President of the Board of Education. The President of the Board of Education is hereby authorized to sign and the District Clerk is hereby authorized to attest any Bonds and bond anticipation notes issued pursuant to this Resolution, and the District Clerk is hereby authorized to affix to such Bonds and bond anticipation notes the corporate seal of the School District.*

*Section 8. The faith and credit of the School District are hereby irrevocably pledged for the payment of the principal of and interest on such Bonds and bond anticipation notes as the same respectively become due and payable. Annual appropriation shall be made in each year sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such obligations becoming due and payable in such year. Unless paid from other sources, there shall be levied annually on all taxable real*

*property within said School District, a tax sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such obligations as the same become due and payable.*

*Section 9. The temporary use of available funds of the School District, not immediately required for the purpose or purposes for which the same were borrowed, received or otherwise created, is hereby authorized, ratified and confirmed, pursuant to, and subject to the restrictions of, Section 165.10 of the Law, for the acquisition of the School Vehicles. As provided in Section 165.10 of the Law, the Board intends to reimburse such funds from the proceeds of the bonds or notes authorized hereby. This Resolution shall constitute the declaration of the School District's "official intent" to reimburse expenditures relating to the acquisition of the School Vehicles with proceeds of the Bonds and notes, as required by United States Treasury Regulation Section 1.150-2.*

*Section 10. This Resolution (or a summary hereof) shall be published by the Clerk of the School District together with a notice in substantially the form prescribed by Section 81.00 of said Local Finance Law, and such publication shall be in the official newspaper of the School District. The validity of the Bonds or of any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of the sale of the Bonds may be contested only if such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which the School District is not authorized to expend money, or the provisions of law which should be complied with at the date of publication of this Resolution are not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty (20) days after the date of such publication; or if said obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.*

*Section 11. The Board hereby covenants and agrees with the holders from time to time of the Bonds authorized hereby, and any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation thereof, that the Board will duly and faithfully observe and comply with the provisions of the Code relating to such actions which the Board must take or cause to be taken to ensure the status of the interest on the bonds authorized hereby, and any notes issued in anticipation thereof, is and remains excludable from federal income taxation.*

Real Property Tax Law§1318 limits the amount of unexpended surplus funds a school district can retain to no more than 4% of the next years' budgetary appropriation.

It is the recommendation of Ms. Sutherland not to use any of the unassigned fund balance to reinstate cuts. This funding source should not be used for an expense that cannot be sustained. One year later the cuts will be made again and you will have no "savings" to help in future years.

*(THIS INTER-MUNICIPAL AGREEMENT made and entered into as of this 1<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2012, by and between the CAIRO-DURHAM CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT, a public school district of the State of New York, with offices located at 424 Main Street, Cairo, New York 12413 (hereinafter "Cairo SD") and the GREENVILLE CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT, a public school district of the State of New York with offices located at Rt. 81, Greenville, New York 12083 (hereinafter "Greenville SD").*

*WHEREAS, the Greenville SD owns and maintains facilities and staffing necessary for the repair, maintenance and other tasks associated with maintaining a school bus fleet for a public school district (hereinafter "Bus Maintenance Operations"); and*

*WHEREAS, the Cairo SD operates a school bus fleet but does not own or maintain the facilities and staffing for the repair, maintenance, and other tasks associated with maintaining a school bus fleet for a public school district; and*  
*WHEREAS, the Cairo SD is desirous of utilizing the Bus Maintenance Operations of the Greenville SD; and*  
*WHEREAS, the Greenville SD is desirous of providing Bus Maintenance Operations for the Cairo SD; and*  
*WHEREAS, the Greenville SD is willing to provide Bus Maintenance Operations to the Cairo SD, upon the terms and conditions contained herein; and*  
*WHEREAS, parties have discussed and fully negotiated the costs associated with such services and that entering into this Agreement will be economically beneficial to both parties; and*  
*WHEREAS, Article 5-G, Section 119-o of the General Municipal Law specifically authorizes municipal corporations to enter into inter-municipal cooperative agreements; and*

*NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and mutual covenants and agreements contained herein, the parties agree as follows:*

*1. Term – The term of this Agreement shall be from July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013, unless sooner terminated in accordance with its terms. This Agreement may be extended upon mutual agreement under terms as may be mutually agreed to by the parties.*

*2. Bus Maintenance Operations provided by the Greenville SD shall include, but are not limited to:*

*(a) Routine maintenance, repairs, and service and routine inspections including pre-DOT inspections for all Cairo SD owned vehicles. Such services shall not include major engine repairs or engine swaps, head gasket replacements, transmission rebuilds (transmission exchanges allowable), rear-end rebuilds (rear-end exchanges allowable), injector pump replacements and main wiring harness repairs and other repairs that Greenville SD determines cannot be reasonably performed by its equipment and staff (the Cairo SD shall arrange for other sources for such major repairs);*

*(b) Performance of New York State Department of Transportation mandated vehicle inspections on all Cairo SD vehicles;*

*(c) Maintenance of repair and service records for each Cairo SD vehicle;*

*(d) Routine maintenance and service of all Cairo SD vehicles which shall be scheduled as required or recommended by the manufacturer or NYS and shall be arranged between the Director of Transportation for each School District; and,*

*(e) Road call services related to any Cairo SD vehicle that becomes disabled or is in need of road call services.*

*3. Compensation – In exchange for the Greenville SD providing the above services, the Cairo SD shall pay to it the total sum of \$108,533.00 for the 2012-2013 school year. This sum covers all such services listed above. The cost of parts associated with such services is the responsibility of Cairo SD. Cairo SD shall pay said compensation to Greenville in four equal payments quarterly. In the event of early termination of this Agreement, Greenville SD shall be paid for any pro-rated portion of this annual sum earned to the effective date of termination.*

*4. Indemnity and Insurance.*

*(a)The Greenville SD shall be responsible for repairing any damage to the vehicles of Cairo SD caused when under the supervision of the Greenville SD pursuant to this Agreement.*

*(b)The Cairo SD shall be responsible for repair of any damage done to the Greenville SD Facilities when caused by its operation of its vehicles on the Greenville SD site pursuant to this Agreement.*

*(c)The Cairo SD agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Greenville SD and its agents and employees from any cause, claim, action, liability, fine, penalty, or proceeding (including attorney's fees) arising, directly or indirectly out of the negligent acts or omissions of the Cairo SD or its officers, employees, or agents with respect to this Agreement. The Greenville SD agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Cairo SD and its agents and employees for any cause, claim, action, liability, fine, penalty or proceeding (including attorneys' fees) arising directly or indirectly out of the negligent acts or omissions of the Greenville SD or its officers, employees, or agents with respect to this Agreement. This provision, as well as the additional provisions of this Agreement, is solely for the benefit of the parties and the parties intend no benefits to third persons.*

*(d)Each party shall maintain its own insurance to cover the above responsibilities.*

*5. Terms of Agreement*

*(a)This Agreement shall continue in force for an initial period commencing on July 1, 2012 and ending June 30, 2013, and thereafter shall be renewable annually unless terminated by either party at its option upon forty five (45) days' notice to the other party.*

*(b)Either party may terminate this Agreement at any time upon forty five (45) days written notice to the other party or at any time by mutual written agreement.*

*6. Miscellaneous.*

(a) *No Assignment.* The parties agree that this Agreement is based on shared municipal services. Neither party shall assign or subcontract its obligations under this Agreement without the express written consent of the governing board of the other party.

(b) *Notices.* Any and all notices and payments required hereunder shall be addressed as follows, or to such other address as may hereafter be designated in writing by either party hereto:

(c) *Governing Law, Jurisdiction.* This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of New York. The parties agree and understand that the Supreme Court, Greene County, New York shall have exclusive jurisdiction of any controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this Agreement, or the breach thereof.

(d) *Entire Agreement; Modification; Counterparts.* This Agreement constitutes the complete understating of the parties. No modification of any provision hereof shall be valid unless in writing and signed by both parties. This Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be an original for all purposes.

(e) *No Waiver.* No waiver of any breach of any condition of this Agreement shall be binding unless in writing and signed by the party waiving said breach. No such waiver shall in any way affect any other term or condition of this Agreement or constitute a cause or excuse for a repetition of such or any other breach unless the waiver shall include the same.

(f) *Severability.* Any provision of this Agreement is deemed to be invalid or inoperative for any reason, that part shall be deemed modified to the extent necessary to make it valid or operative, or if it cannot be so modified, then severed and the remainder of the Agreement shall continue in full force and effect as if the Agreement had been signed with the invalid portion so modified or eliminated.

7. The parties will meet as necessary to discuss how the agreement is progressing.

8. Agreement Approval – This Agreement is subject to the approval of the Boards of Education of each school district at a duly convened public meeting.)

## TRANSPORTATION AGREEMENT

This agreement is entered into between the Greenville Central School District, (“Greenville”) with a principal place of business at Route 81, Greenville, New York 12083 and Cairo-Durham Central School District (“Cairo-Durham”) with a principal place of business at P.O. Box 780, Cairo, New York 12413 concerning transportation for certain students of Cairo-Durham (the “Students”) who attend certain programs outside both Greenville and Cairo-Durham.

1. **Transportation Services.** Greenville shall transport the students of Cairo-Durham from the morning pick-up point specified to the following programs, and from those programs to the afternoon drop-off point specified for the 2012 summer as specified below.
  - a. **Columbia-Greene Educational Center:** Cairo-Durham shall pay Greenville \$452.16 (\$54.86 daily rate x 6 days /(\$41.00 daily rate x 3 days ) for Cairo-Durham students transported to the Columbia-Greene Educational Center at 131 Union Turnpike, Hudson, NY 12534. Greenville will transport the students of Cairo from a morning pick-up point at Cairo-Durham High School (June 22 - 29) to the program and from the program to an afternoon drop-off point at Cairo-Durham High School and from a morning pick-up point at the Catskill CSD (July 2, 3 and 5) to the program and to an afternoon drop-off point at Catskill CSD.
  - b. **Center for Spectrum Services:** Cairo-Durham shall pay Greenville \$4,403.94 (\$151.86 daily rate x 29 days) for Cairo-Durham students transported to the Center for Spectrum Services at 70 Kukuk Lane, Kingston, NY 12401. Cairo-Durham will provide and pay for an aide on this transportation. Greenville will transport the students of Cairo-Durham from a morning pick-up point at each student’s home to the program and from the program to an afternoon drop-off point at each student’s home.
  - c. **Wildwood (Curry Road):** Cairo-Durham shall pay Greenville \$3,253.51 (\$112.19 daily rate x 29 days) for Cairo-Durham students transported from Wildwood (take home only) at 2995 Curry Road Extension, Schenectady, NY 12303 and for the cost of a shared aide. Greenville will transport the student of Cairo-Durham from the program to an afternoon drop-off point at the student’s home.
2. **Payment:** Therefore, Cairo-Durham agrees to pay the sum total of \$8,109.61 to Greenville for the above-stated services. Payment shall be due and owing within 30 days after the date of invoice, but in any event no later than September 15, 2012, whichever comes first.
3. **Termination:** This agreement may be terminated by Greenville, in sum or in part, upon 14 days notice to Cairo-Durham, in the event that due to changes in attendance or enrollment:
  - a. Greenville discontinues its bus run to one of the programs; or
  - b. Such bus is filled to capacity with Greenville students.

Further, Greenville may terminate this agreement with 48 hours notice to Cairo-Durham, in the event that a Cairo-Durham student violates the Greenville Code of Conduct or otherwise engages in inappropriate conduct while on the Greenville bus or on Greenville property. Greenville administrators shall also have the authority to suspend the student from Greenville bus transportation in accordance with its policies and the Education Law.

4. **Insurance, Defense and Indemnification:** Cairo-Durham shall provide to Greenville a certificate of insurance, attached hereto as Exhibit A. Cairo-Durham shall defend, indemnify and save harmless Greenville, its officials, employees and agents, from and against all claims, damages, losses and expenses arising out of or in consequence of any negligent or intentional act or omission of Cairo-Durham, its officials, employees, volunteers or agents to the extent of its or their responsibility for such claims, damages, losses and expenses. Cairo-Durham shall further reimburse Greenville for any property damage to Greenville's property which may be caused by the actions of any Cairo-Durham student. Greenville shall defend, indemnify and save harmless Cairo-Durham, its officials, employees and agents, from and against all claims, damages, losses and expenses arising out of or in consequence of any negligent or intentional act or omission of Greenville, its officials, employees, volunteers or agents to the extent of its or their responsibility for such claims, damages, losses and expenses.
5. **Board Approval:** This Agreement shall not become final and binding unless and until it is approved by the Boards of Education of Greenville and Cairo-Durham. By signing below, the Superintendent of Schools for each district represents that he/she has been authorized by his/her district's Board of Education to enter into this Agreement.
6. **Choice of Law and Forum:** This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of New York and any dispute arising out of or under this Agreement shall be resolved in an action or proceeding commenced in a court of competent jurisdiction in the County of Greene, State of New York.
7. **Entire Agreement:** This Agreement contains the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof, and supersedes and replaces all prior negotiations, correspondence, conversations, agreements, and understandings concerning the subject matter hereof. Accordingly, the parties agree that no deviation from the terms hereof shall be predicated upon prior representations, agreements or understandings, whether oral or written.
8. **Modification:** Neither this Agreement nor any of its terms may be changed or modified, waived, or terminated (unless as otherwise provided hereunder) except by an instrument in writing signed by an authorized representative of the party against whom the enforcement of the change, waiver, or termination is sought.

## TRANSPORTATION AGREEMENT

This agreement is entered into between the Cairo-Durham Central School District, ("Cairo-Durham") with a principal place of business at 424 Main Street Cairo, New York 12413 and Greenville Central School District ("Greenville") with a principal place of business at Route 81, Greenville, New York 12083 concerning transportation for certain students of Greenville (the "Students") who attend certain programs outside both Greenville and Cairo-Durham.

1. **Transportation Services** Cairo-Durham shall transport the students of Greenville from the morning pick-up point specified to the following programs, and from those programs to the afternoon drop-off point specified for the 2012 summer as specified below.
  - a. Wildwood, Altamont Summer Program: Greenville shall pay Cairo-Durham \$4,710.47 (\$162.43 daily rate x 29 days) for a Greenville student transported to the Wildwood Altamont Summer Program at, 1212 Leesome Lane, Altamont, New York 12009. Cairo-Durham will transport the student from a morning pick-up point at the student's home to the program and from the program to an afternoon drop-off point at the student's home.
  - b. Parsons: Greenville shall pay Cairo-Durham \$4,369.14 (\$150.66 daily rate x 29 days) for a Greenville student transported to the Parsons Summer Program at, 60 Academy Road, Albany, NY 12208. Cairo-Durham will transport the student from a morning pick-up point at the student's home to the program and from the program to an afternoon drop-off point at the student's home.
2. **Payment:** Therefore, Greenville agrees to pay the sum total of \$9,079.61 to Cairo-Durham for the above-stated services. Payment shall be due and owing within 30 days after the date of invoice, but in any event no later than September 15, 2012, whichever comes first.
3. **Termination:** This agreement may be terminated by Cairo-Durham, in sum or in part, upon 14 days notice to Greenville, in the event that due to changes in attendance or enrollment:
  - a. Cairo-Durham discontinues its bus run to one of the programs; or
  - b. Such bus is filled to capacity with Cairo-Durham students.

Further, Cairo-Durham may terminate this agreement with 48 hours notice to Greenville, in the event that a Greenville student violates the Cairo-Durham Code of Conduct or otherwise engages in inappropriate conduct while on the Cairo-Durham bus or on Cairo-Durham property. Cairo-Durham administrators shall also have the authority to suspend the student from Cairo-Durham bus transportation in accordance with its policies and the Education Law.

4. **Insurance, Defense and Indemnification:** Greenville shall provide to Cairo-Durham a certificate of insurance, attached hereto as Exhibit A. Greenville shall defend, indemnify and save harmless Cairo-Durham, its officials, employees and agents, from and against all claims, damages, losses and expenses arising out of or in consequence of any negligent or intentional act or omission of Greenville, its officials, employees, volunteers or agents to the extent of its or their responsibility for such claims, damages, losses and expenses. Greenville shall further reimburse Cairo-Durham for any property damage to Cairo-Durham's property which may be caused by the actions of any Greenville student. Cairo-Durham shall defend, indemnify and save harmless Greenville, its officials, employees and agents, from and against all claims, damages, losses and expenses arising out of or in consequence of any negligent or intentional act or omission of Cairo-Durham,

its officials, employees, volunteers or agents to the extent of its or their responsibility for such claims, damages, losses and expenses.

5. **Board Approval:** This Agreement shall not become final and binding unless and until it is approved by the Boards of Education of Greenville and Cairo-Durham. By signing below, the Superintendent of Schools for each district represents that he/she has been authorized by his/her district's Board of Education to enter into this Agreement.

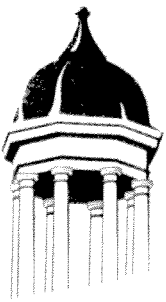

A letter was recently sent to you by the middle/ high school nurses that discussed the administration of insulin during after-school activities. We write to clarify the responsibilities of the District regarding students with diabetes and the administration of insulin during after-school activities.

The District understands and is committed to working with students and their parents/guardians to ensure that students with diabetes are able to participate in school-sponsored extracurricular activities outside of school hours. To ensure that each student's specific needs are met, advance planning and collaboration will be required among parents/guardians, school nurses, school staff, and principals. For example, diabetes management strategies should be included in health care and/or emergency care plans for students who participate in school-sponsored extracurricular activities. In addition, depending on the situation, a school nurse or trained staff may be required to cover such extracurricular activities.

In furtherance of its commitment to educate staff about diabetes, the District plans to train its school personnel, including bus drivers, cafeteria workers, athletic personnel, and nursing staff, on diabetes, what it is, how to recognize it, and what to do if a student with diabetes seems to be behaving differently from one's norm. The first training for coaches is planned for August 2012.

In order to plan for the coming school year, please contact your principal and/or school nurse if you are interested in updating your child's health care and/or emergency care plan to include diabetes management strategies for school-sponsored extracurricular activities.
