



These are handed out the first day of school:

Pay to play fee: \$30/sport (for a maximum of \$60/year) Due before athlete can play in their first contest






The athlete should not be left alone and must go to a hospital at once if they:


- Have a headache that gets worse
- Are very drowsy or can't be awakened
- Can't recognize people or places
- Have repeated vomiting
- Behave unusually or seem confused; are very irritable
- Have seizures (arms and legs jerk uncontrollably)
- Have weak or numb arms or legs
- Are unsteady on their feet; have slurred speech

Remember, it is better to be safe. Consult your doctor after a suspected concussion.



- Home school students must provide proof of enrollment in a qualified home school
 - Students who are not passing a class will not play.
 - Students who failed a course 4th quarter of last year are not eligible for 2 weeks.
- The first eligibility will be September 2nd (two weeks after school starts)
 - Warnings are sent to coaches on Sundays
 - Students are notified in school on Monday and have until the end of the day to grades up
 - Final eligibility is run Tuesday morning at 8 a.m.
