### Programs

- **Blessings in a Backpack**

Blessings in a Backpack provides food on the weekend for students who experience food insecurity at home. Each week students are sent home with a bag containing two lunches, two snacks, and two breakfasts.

- **Child Outreach**

Child Outreach is a free developmental screening program for children ages 3-5 to ensure all children have a good start to kindergarten. Every Wednesday from 3:00-5:00 staff from RI Legal Services housing unit and Tri County Community Action's Family Care Community Partnership Program are at the OFL office to meet with families. We help with issues including eviction prevention and sealing, accessing DHS benefits, and more. A free clothing and basic needs closet is available for families visiting at that time.

PAT is a home visiting program open to families with children prenatal to kindergarten entry. Our Parent Educator, Robynne Wildman, works with everyone from teen moms to older adult guardians to support child development.
