

Dear Parent,

Winter will soon be arriving, and sometimes it brings inclement weather. In some cases, this will cause the district to close because of the unsafe road conditions. Please understand the roads could be clear in part of the district, yet ice covered in other parts. Our top priority will be the safety of our students. Below are the procedures in the event school is cancelled or delayed.

- 1. All announcements will be made through our telephone notification system via text message and the local media as soon as possible. Please tune to KWOZ 103.3; 105.7-The Bull; KFIN 107.9; KISS 101.9; KAIT Channel 8; KARK Channel 4; KATV Channel 7; and KTHV Channel 11 for announcements. The school district's website will also include updates on school closings and/or cancellations: http://www.cedarwolves.org. as well as the district's Facebook page.
 - If your phone number has changed, please call the office and update your child's phone number.
 - Without the correct phone number, you will not receive E-notes messages.

Please do not call the school offices or homes of staff members to ask if school is canceled.

- 2. Should the weather require that we dismiss school before the buses run in the morning we will make an announcement through *E-Notes*, *social media* before 6:00 a.m.
- 3. If the announcement can be made on the previous day, we will do so prior to 10:00 p.m.
- 4. We may have a delayed start of school when the weather is questionable.
- 5. Should inclement weather conditions develop during the school day, we will make an announcement on *E-Notes*, *social media* and notify the media of the time school will be dismissed, and post it on the district's web site.
- 6. On occasion, it may be necessary to run only safe bus routes, known as snow routes. The snow routes are provided on the back of this letter.

Bad weather, dangerous road conditions, and student transportation during those conditions are serious concerns for both parents and school districts. We will always keep your children's safety foremost in our decisions. Your support and understanding will be appreciated.
