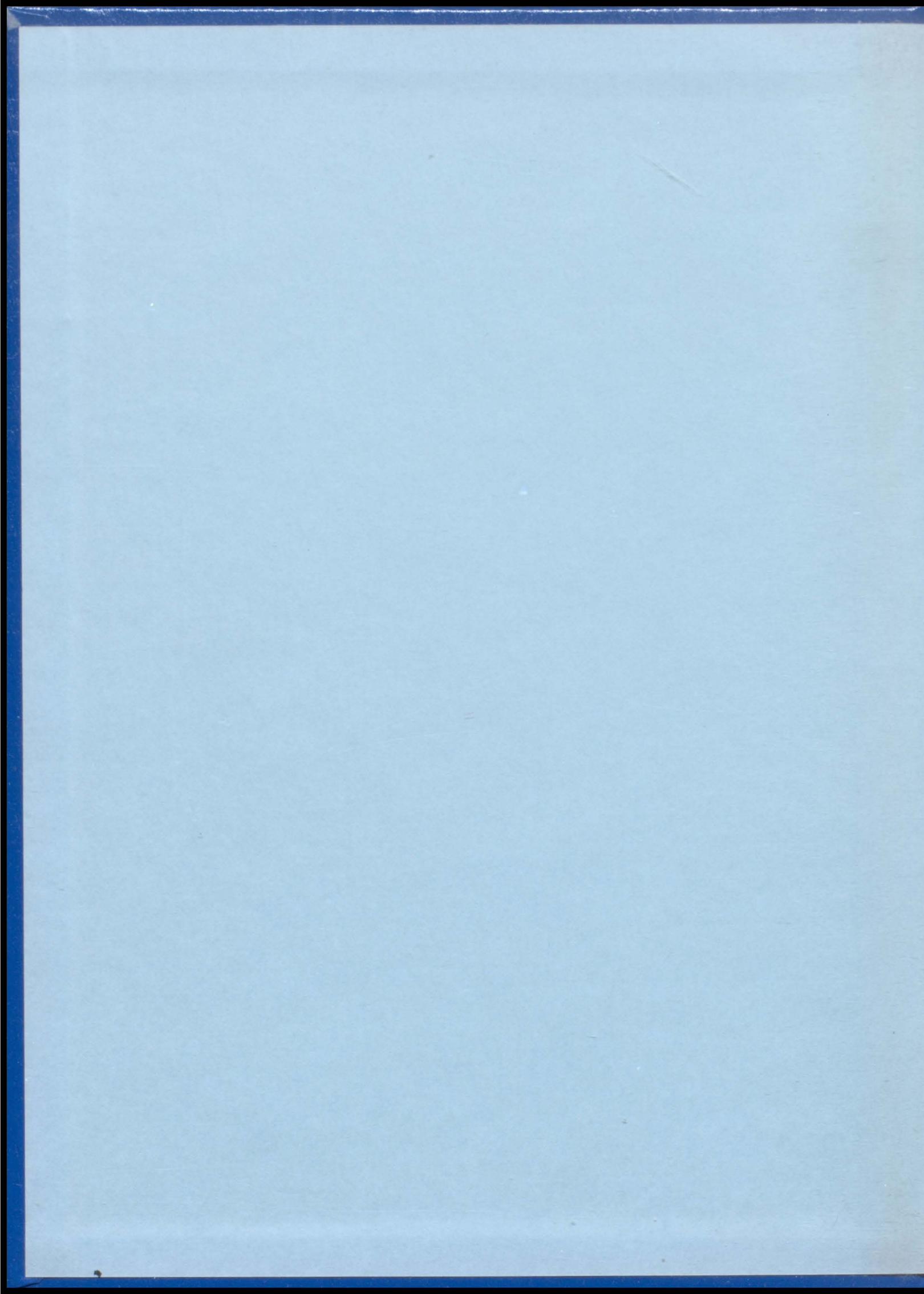


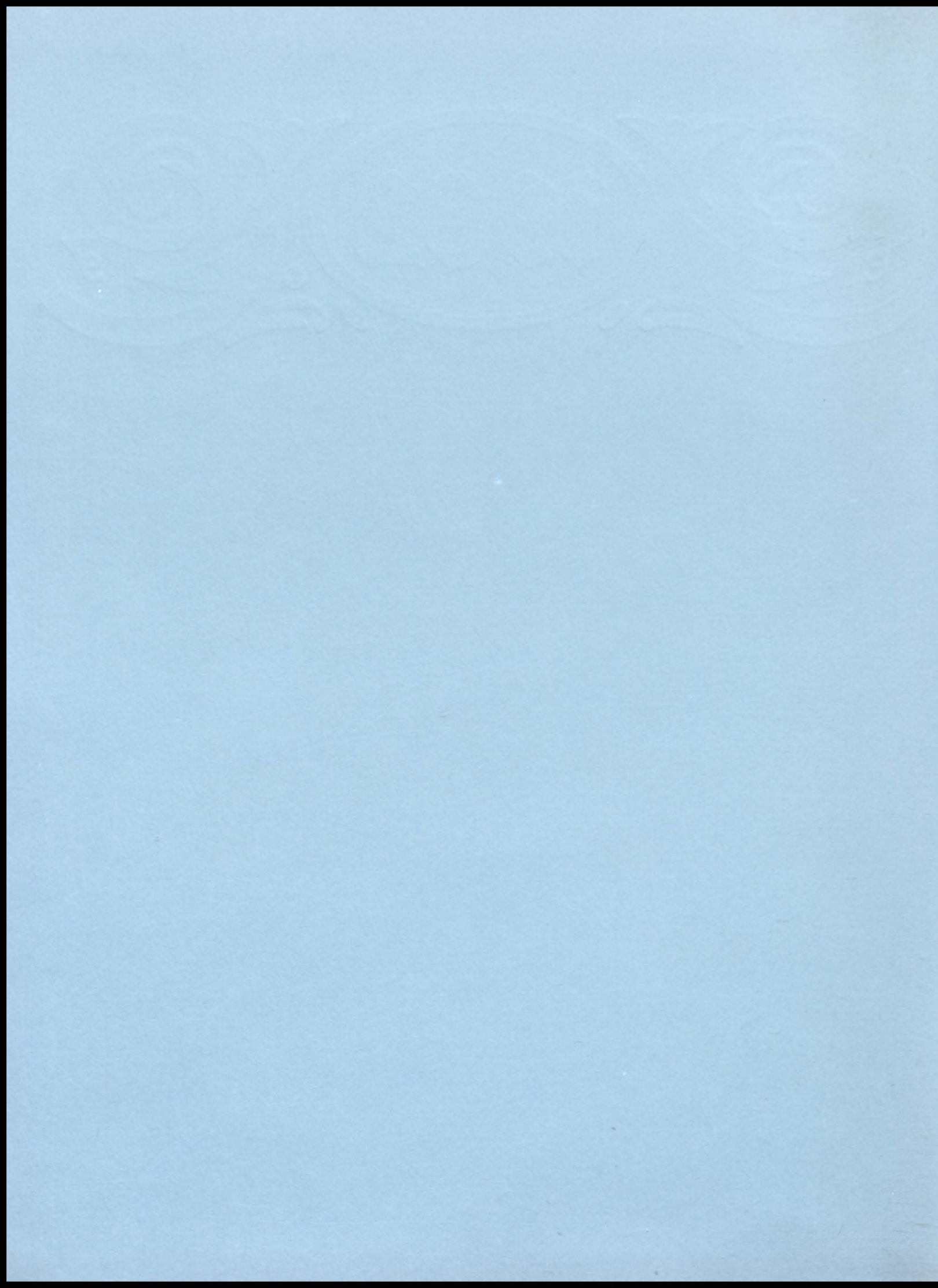

DEDICATION



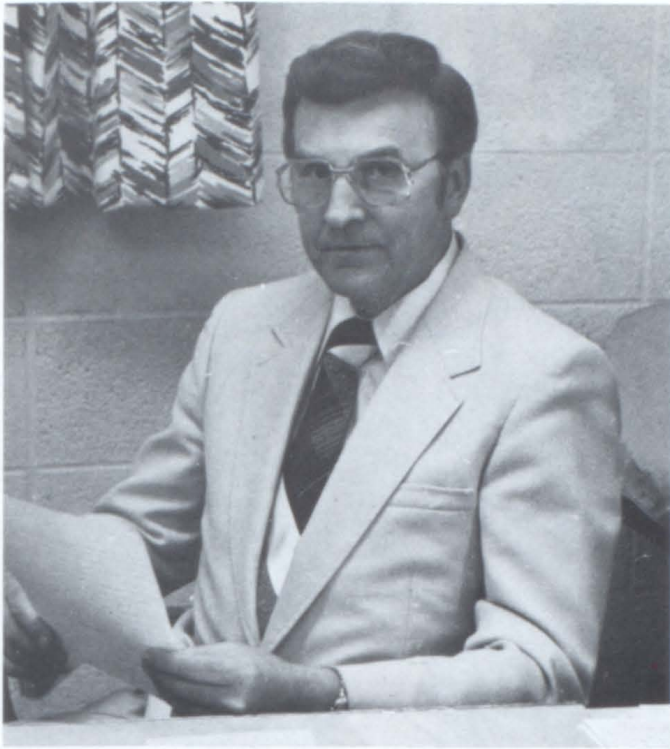

One thing he really misses is being an advisor on the annual staff. He had to give it up because his work load became too heavy.

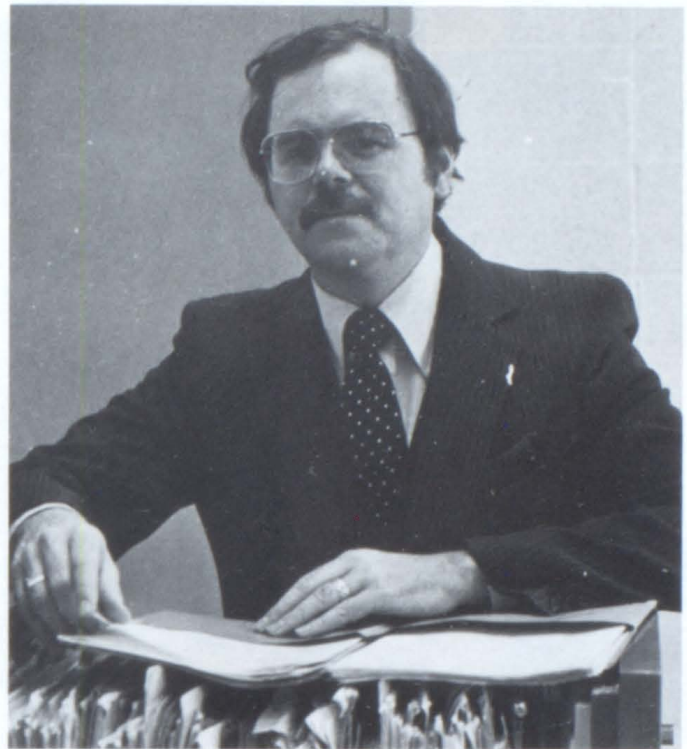
After retirement, Mr. Lawson plans on traveling to the Southern parts of the United States.
