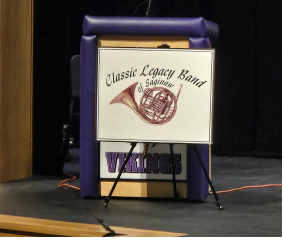

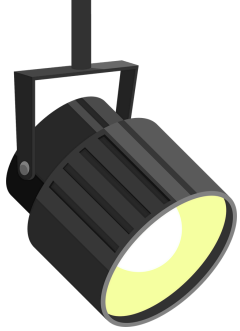




# The Classic Saginaw Legacy Band Winter Concert 2025

# Music Department News

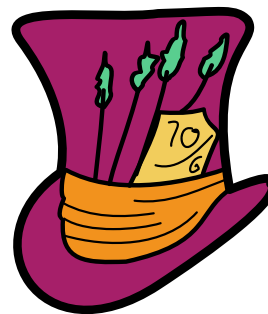
