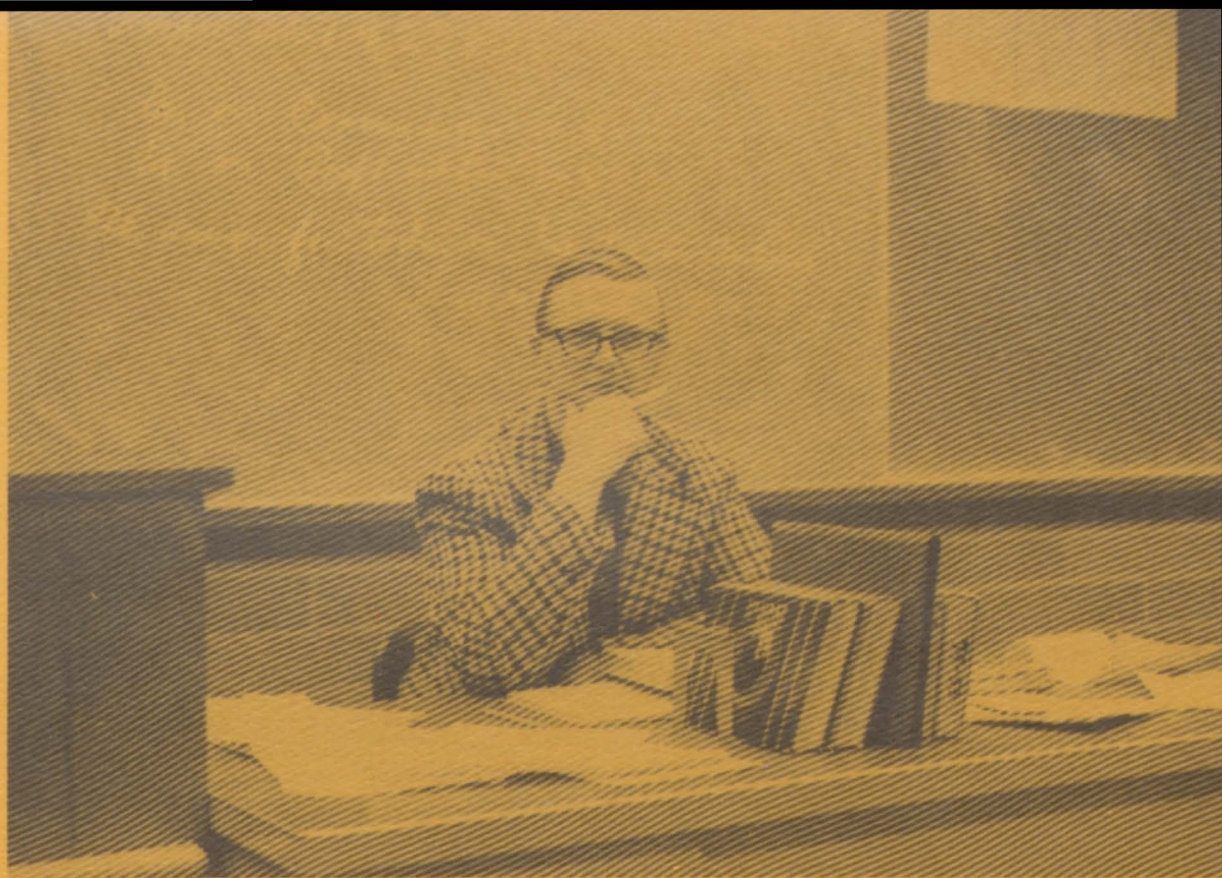


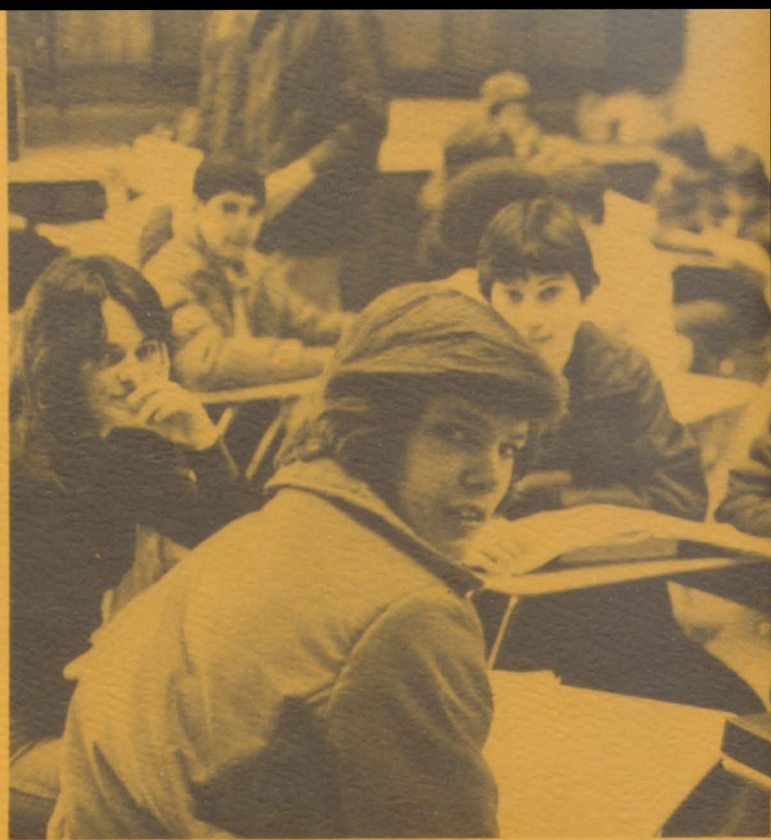
Foreword

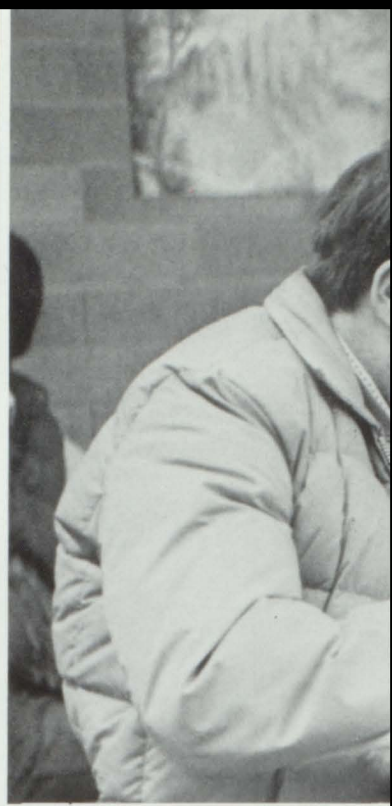
