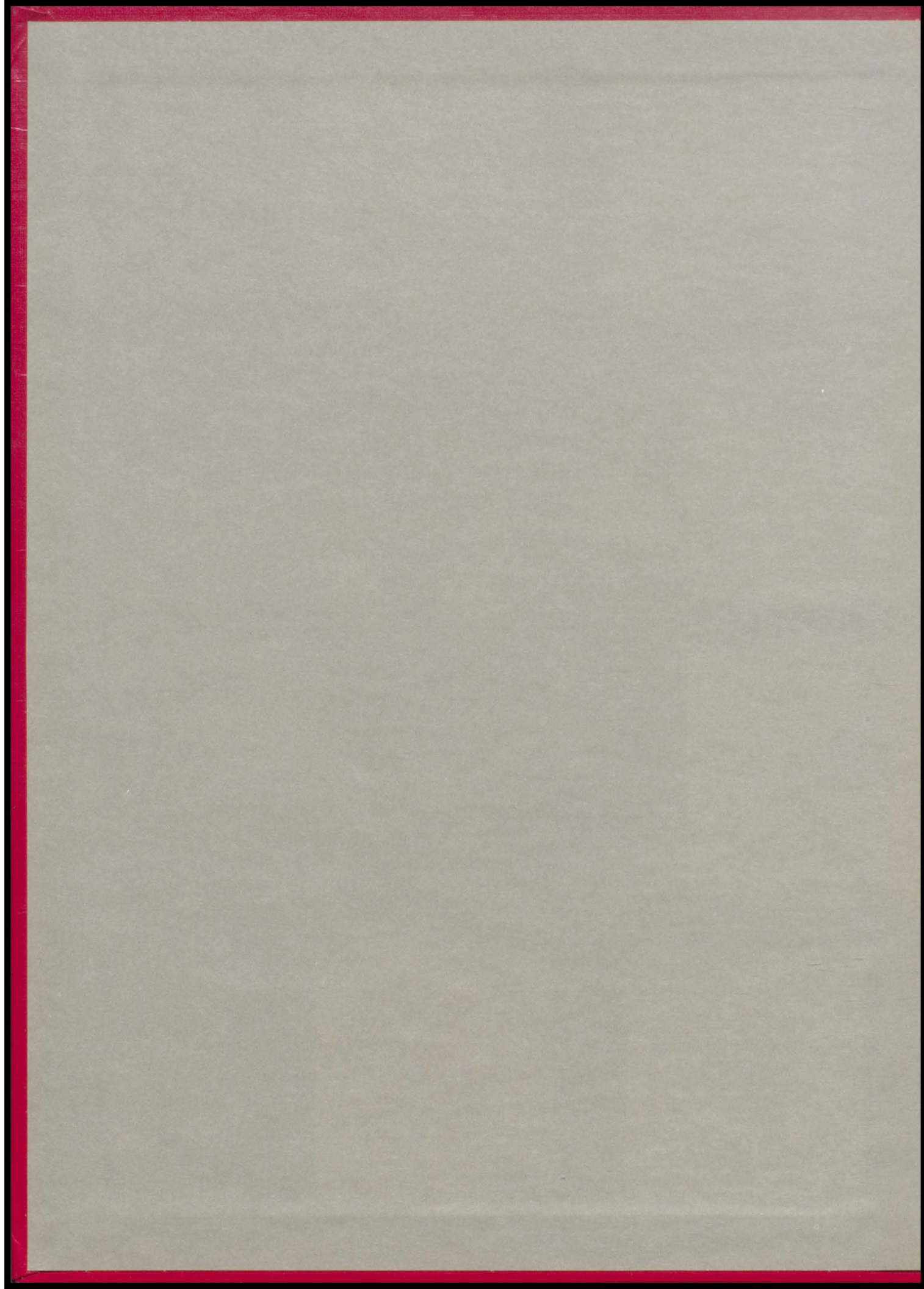


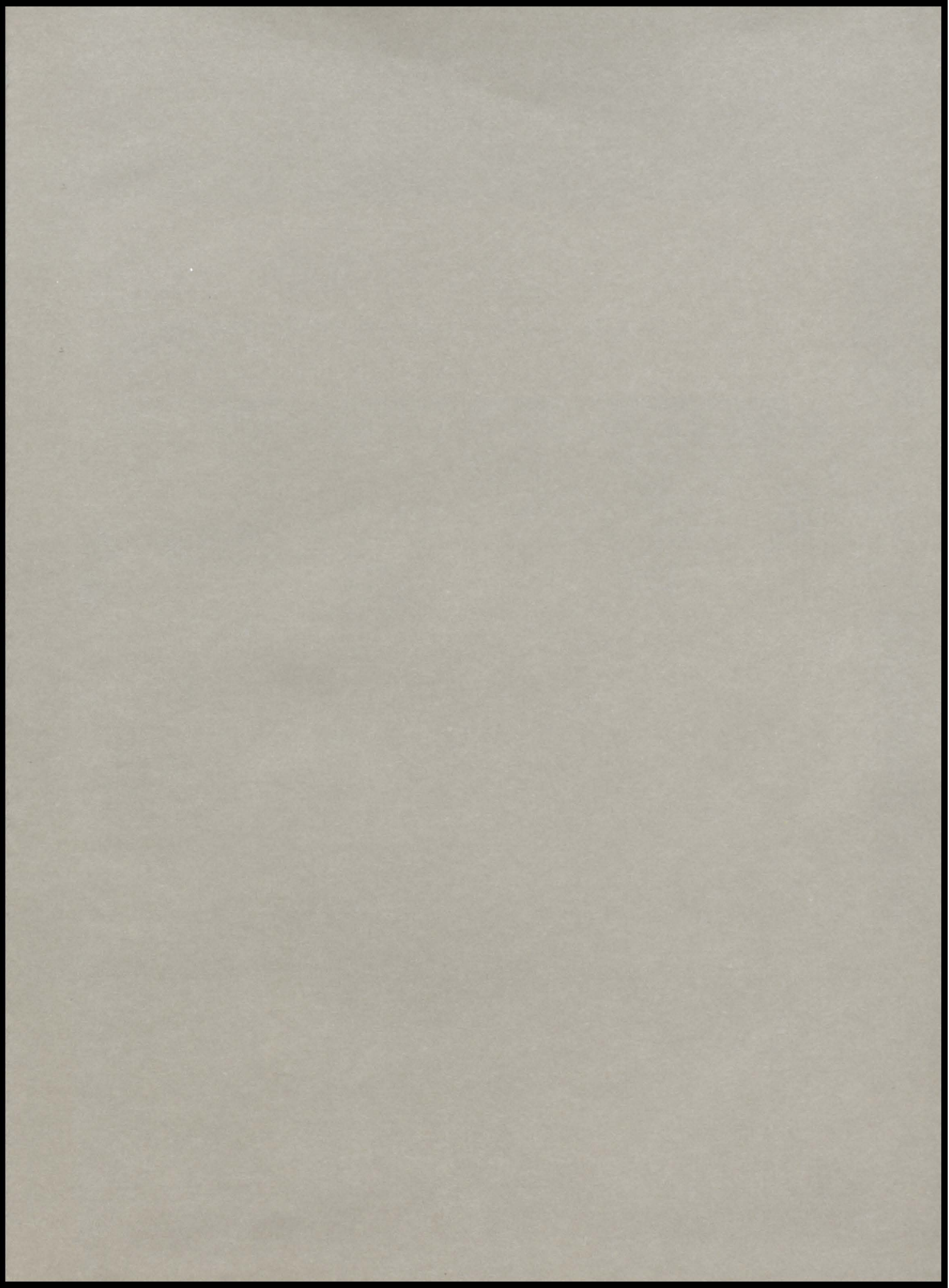

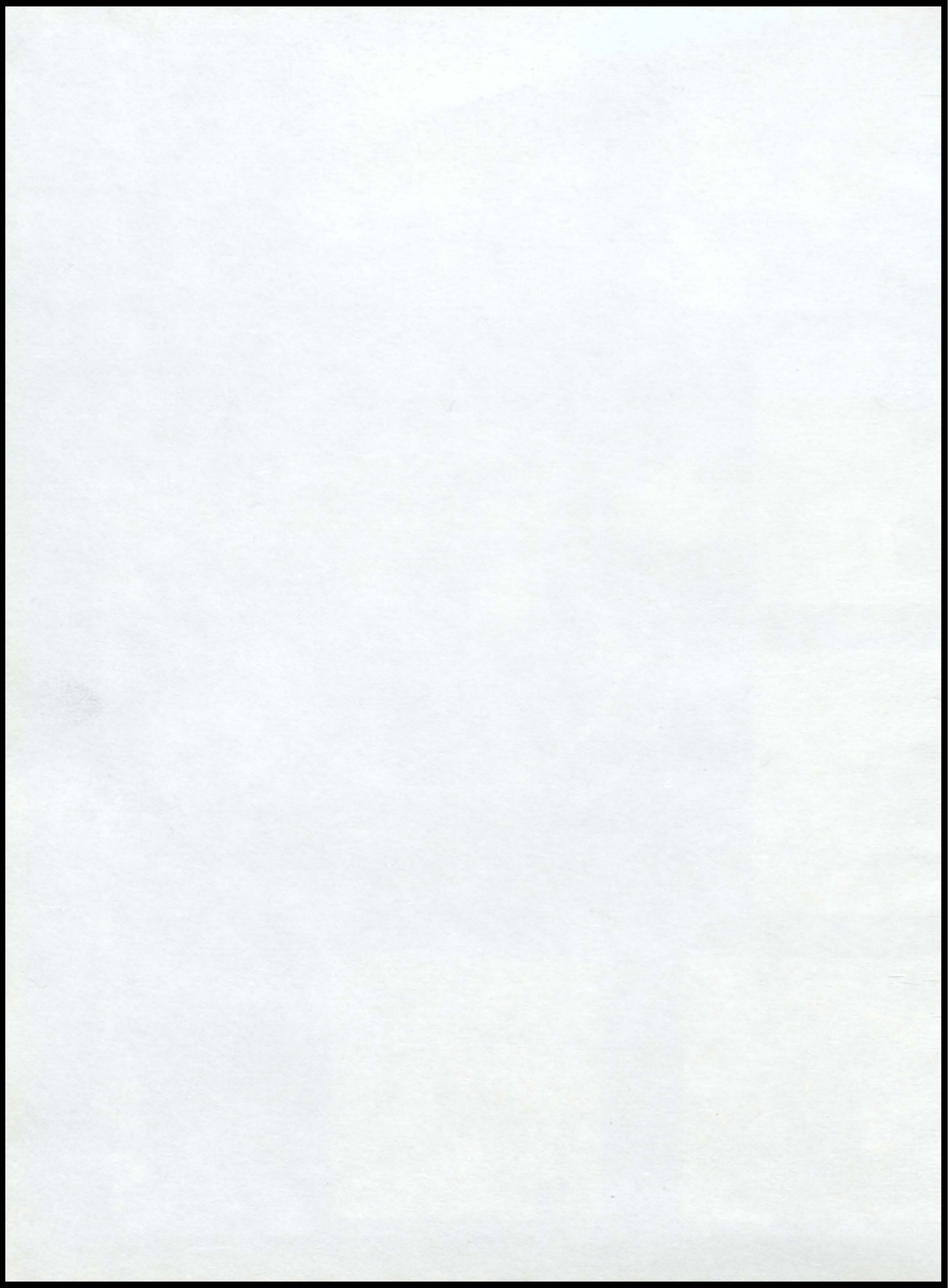

# Dedication



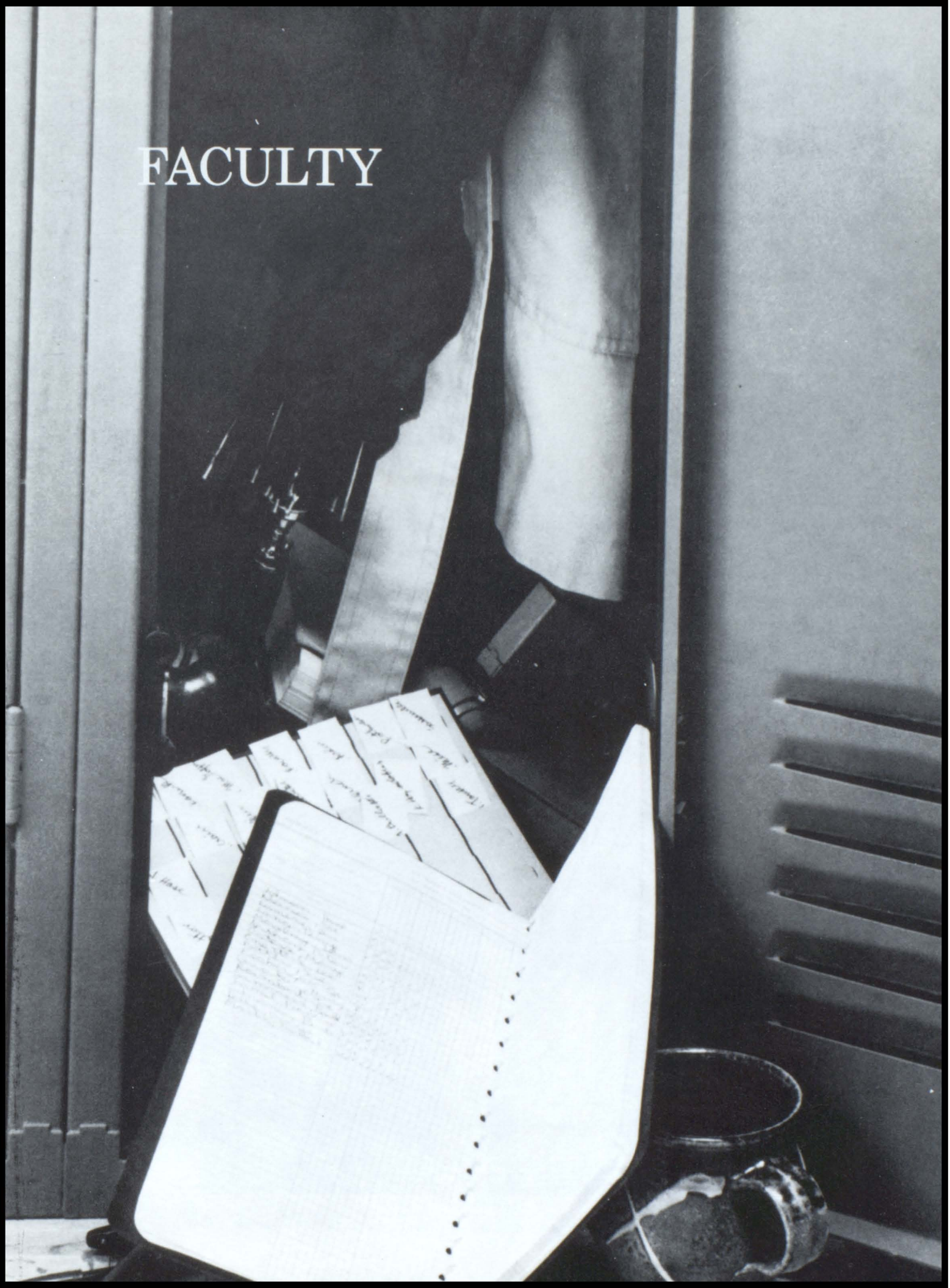

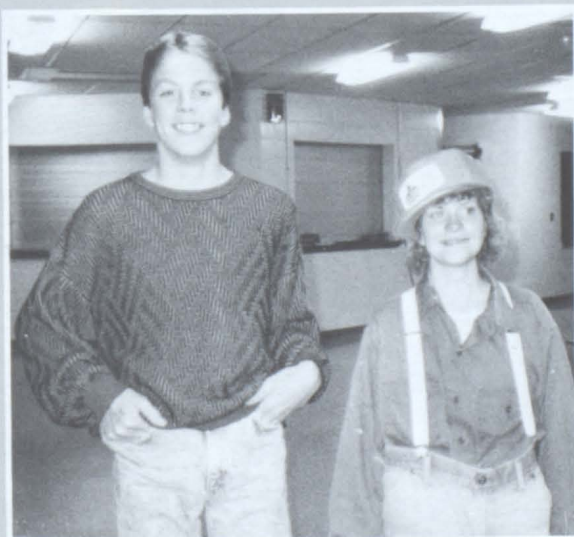

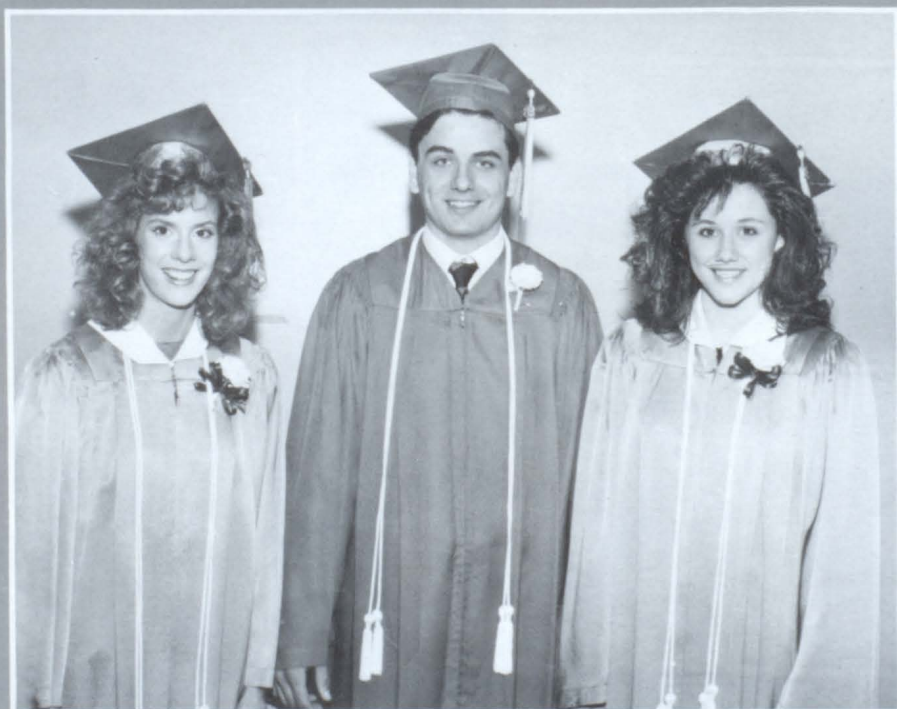


# Graduation. A Time For Joy.

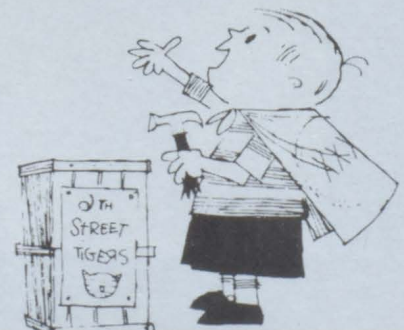

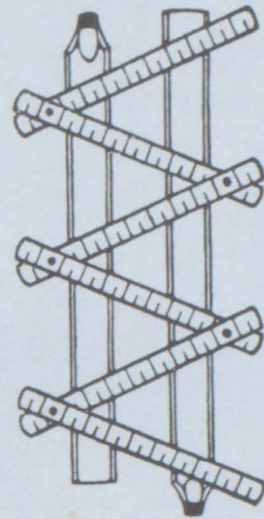
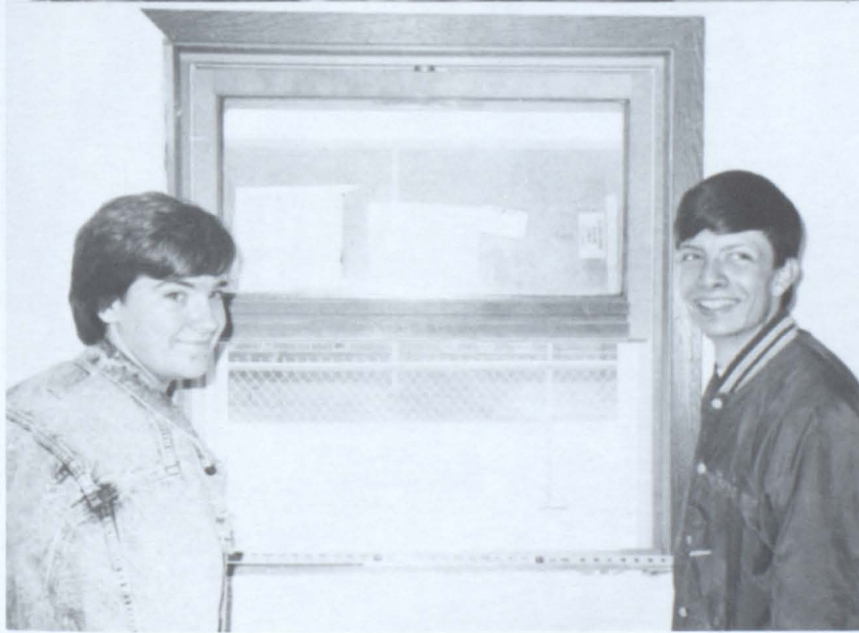

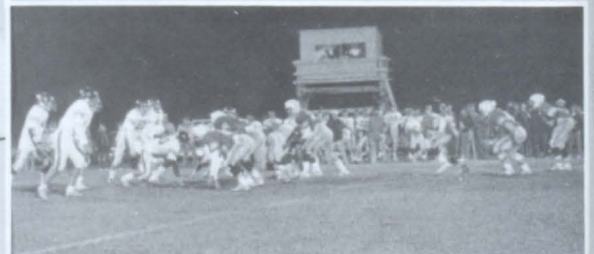

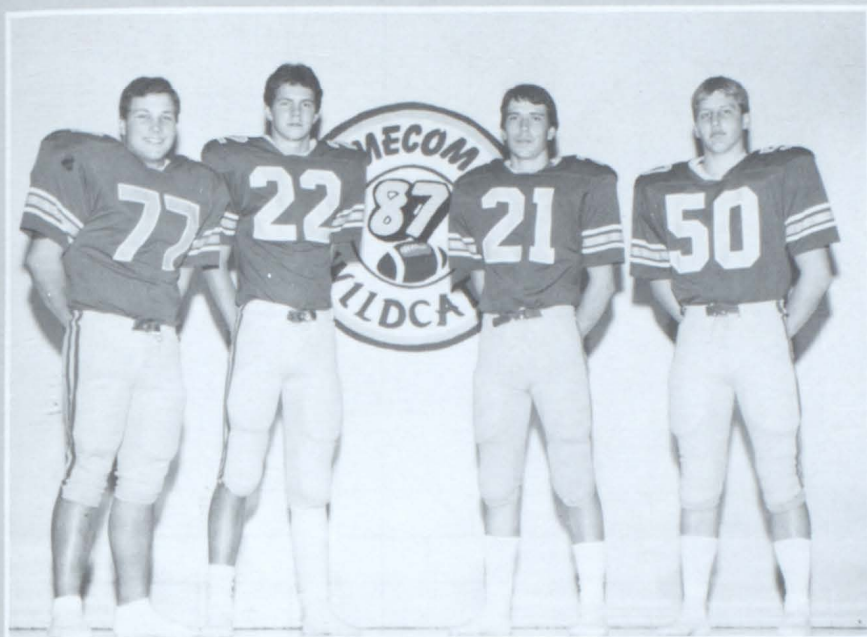

The Wildcat Offense prepares to make a crushing blow against the Doland-Conde defense.



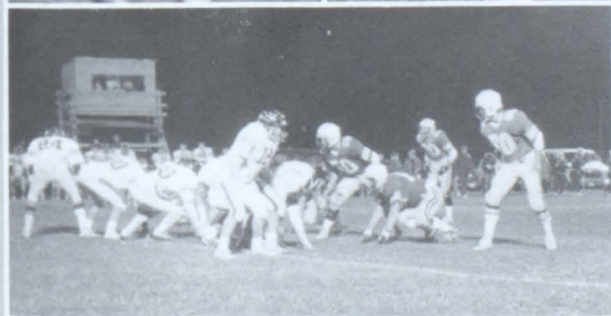

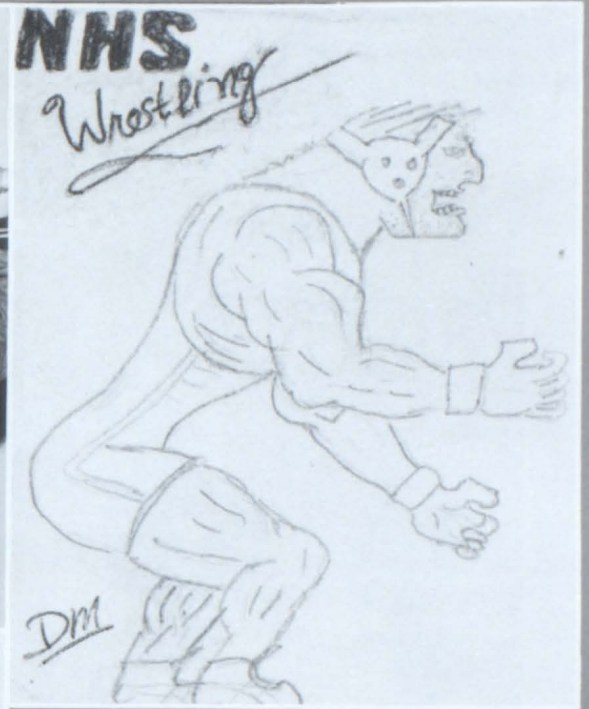

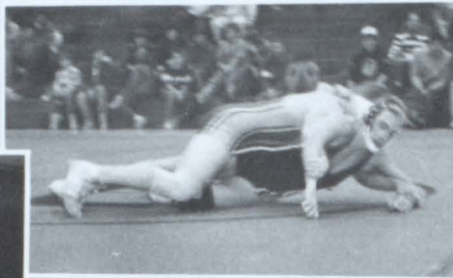
