We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2022-23 educational progress for Parchment Innovation Center. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2023-24 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2022-23. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been given one of these labels.

We continue to identify gaps in student achievement between socio-economic groups and concentrate our efforts to meet the needs of all students. State law requires that we also report on the following additional information:

State law requires that we also report additional information. The District School Improvement Plan includes goals in Reading, Writing, Math, Science and Social Studies, and guides our curriculum review, implementation and evaluation processes. Professional Development activities were held to enhance instruction in each of these areas, with particular emphasis on training staff on the MTSS process and social and emotional learning. Through professional learning communities (PLCs), staff have identified targeted elements for focused support, and have designed supporting resources for the implementation of these elements. Staff members met often by grade level and with coaches to review and update these resources, analyze the effectiveness of their implementation, and make instructional adjustments as necessary.

## Specialized School within the District

Parchment Innovation Center is the alternative education program for the Parchment School District. The building programs include the high school completion program and the Parchment Virtual Academy. Enrolled students come from all over the county, with the main student population being from Parchment and Kalamazoo. Students may choose to enroll at Parchment Innovation Center or The Parchment Virtual Academy.
