### **Community**

Shawnee High School is a public, four-year comprehensive high school. The total enrollment of 761 includes a senior class of 185 for 2024-25. Shawnee is a residential suburb located southwest of Lima, Ohio, a city with a population of approximately 38,000. Residents are employed in a cross section of careers with most being employed in business, professional, and auxiliary occupations. Shawnee High School has earned the reputation of preparing students for both college and career opportunities. Programs are available in Special Education, accelerated courses, and Advanced Placement courses. Shawnee is a member of the consortium of local high schools comprising Apollo Career Center. Students may attend Apollo all day, or for a portion of the day to take specialized vocational courses not available at Shawnee.

### **Achievements (U.S. News & World Report)**

For the past twelve years, U.S. News and World Report has ranked Shawnee High School in either the top five or ten percent of over 21,000 charter, magnet and public high schools throughout the nation. The ranking is based upon the actual student performance compared to a statistical expectation, the performance of our least advantaged students and how well students are prepared for college.

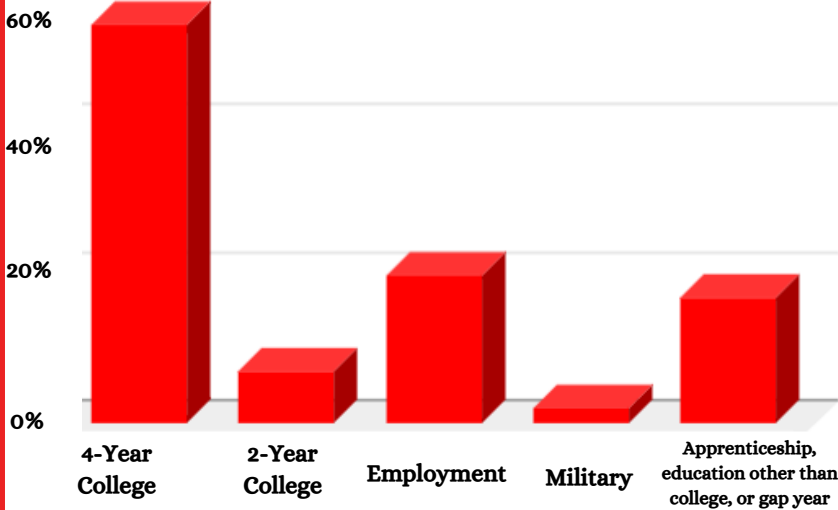

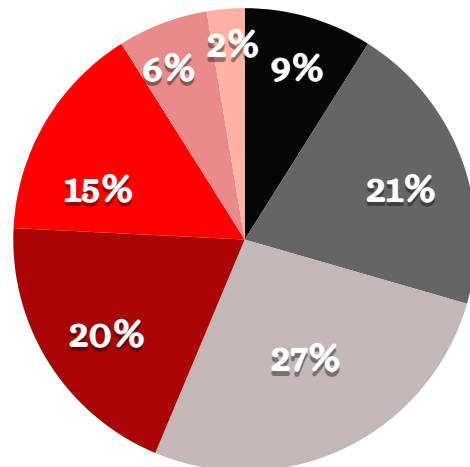
