The MISD Gifted and Talented Program considers all students in kindergarten – fifth grade for services. This involves the collection of information for identifying students who are performing at a high level in intellectual ability. In upcoming weeks, the district will begin to consider students for services. The 2024 Texas State Plan for the Education of Gifted and Talented Students requires a parent or guardian to give consent to participate in the GT Evaluation Process and for GT services, if the student qualifies. The consent will be provided at the beginning of the Parent Observation Inventory. The parent consent and parent observation window opens Monday, September 8, 2025, and closes on Friday, September 26, 2025.

Teacher Observation Inventory (Kindergarten – 5th)

The Teacher Observation assists educators in recognizing students who show characteristics of giftedness.

B. Parent Consent and Observation Inventory (Kindergarten – 5th)
(Completed at home by parent or guardian September 8,2025 – September 26, 2025)

The Parent Observation Inventory allows parents the opportunity to provide information regarding gifted characteristics they see outside of school. The Parent Observation Inventory will be available via Google Form.
