2024 District Graduation Rate

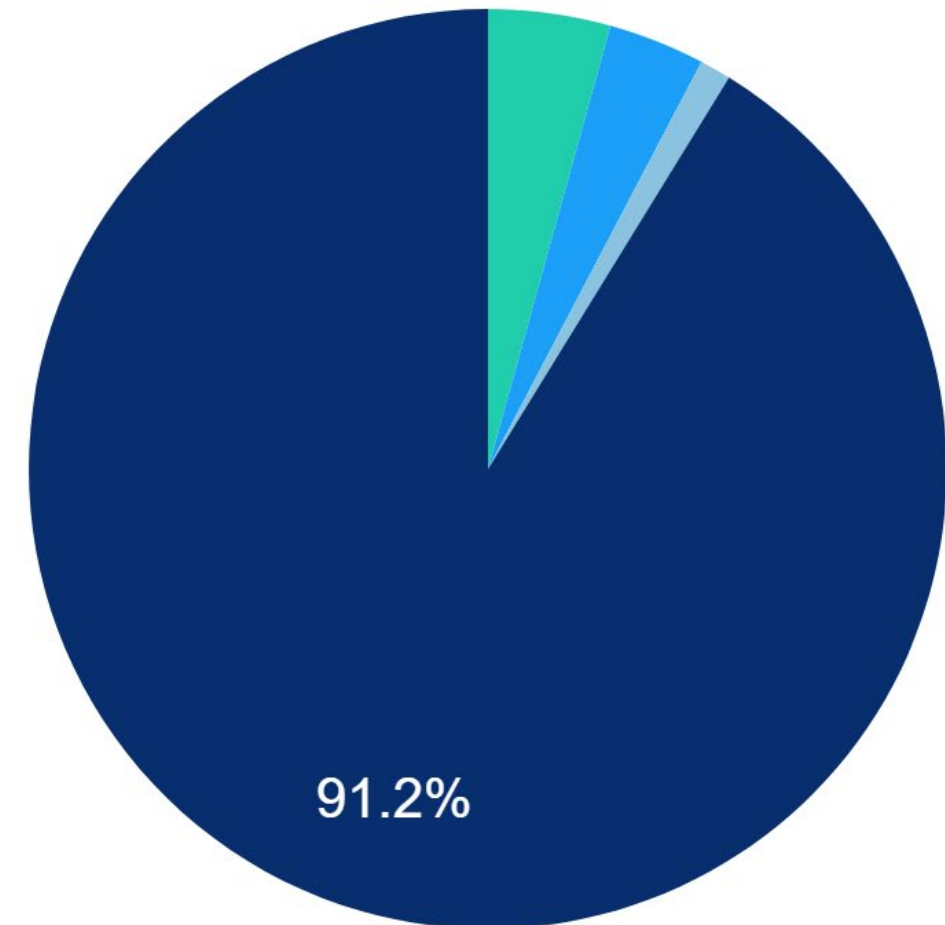
The 2024 cohort had 668 students.

91.2% or 609 students graduated on-time with a standard diploma

4.3% or 29 students are still enrolled working to meet diploma requirements

3.4% or 23 students were coded as dropouts

1.1% or 7 students were coded as other non graduates

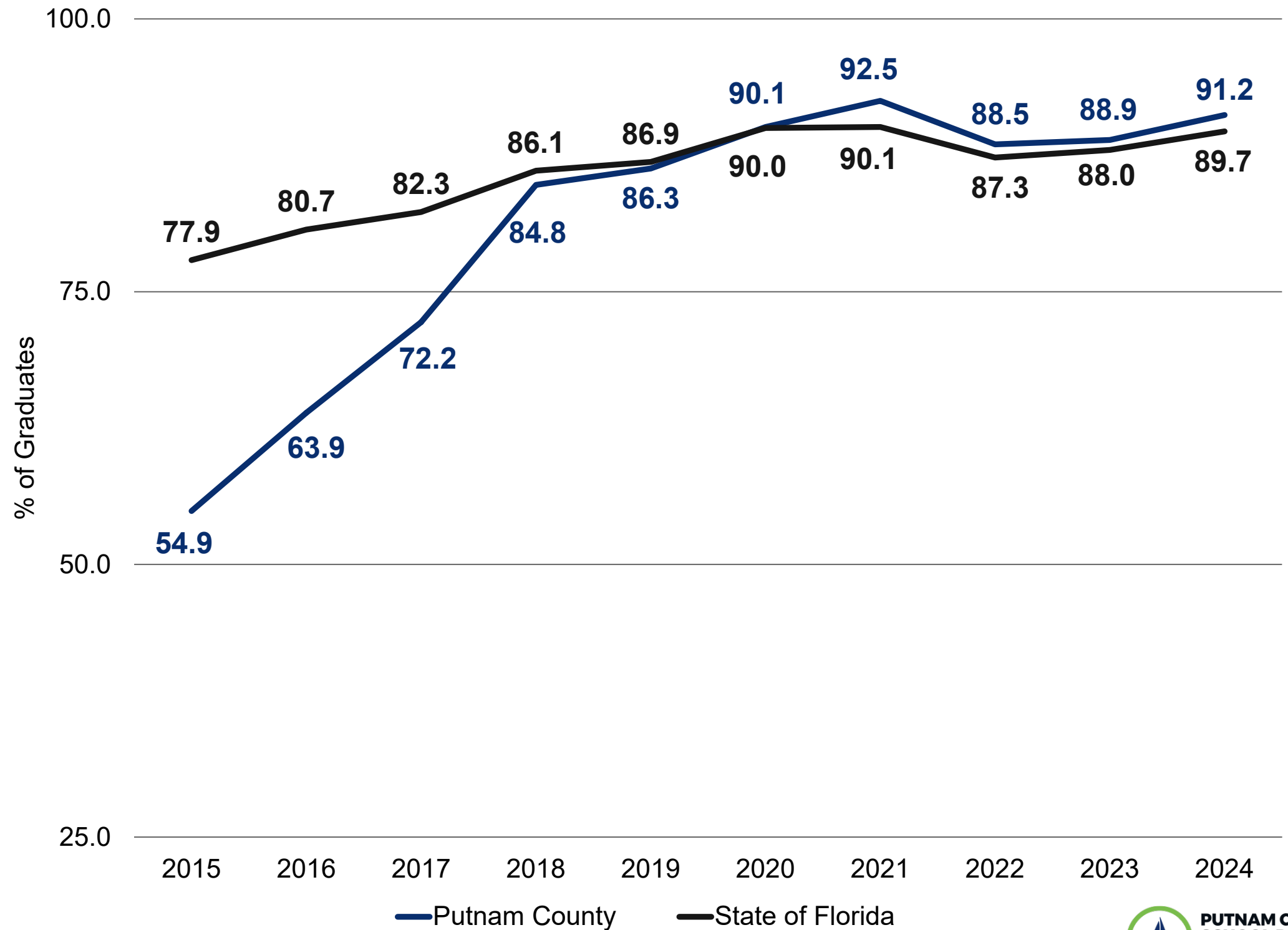
High Expectations for All Students

In 2024, our students outperformed Florida in 5 of 6 tracked subgroups.

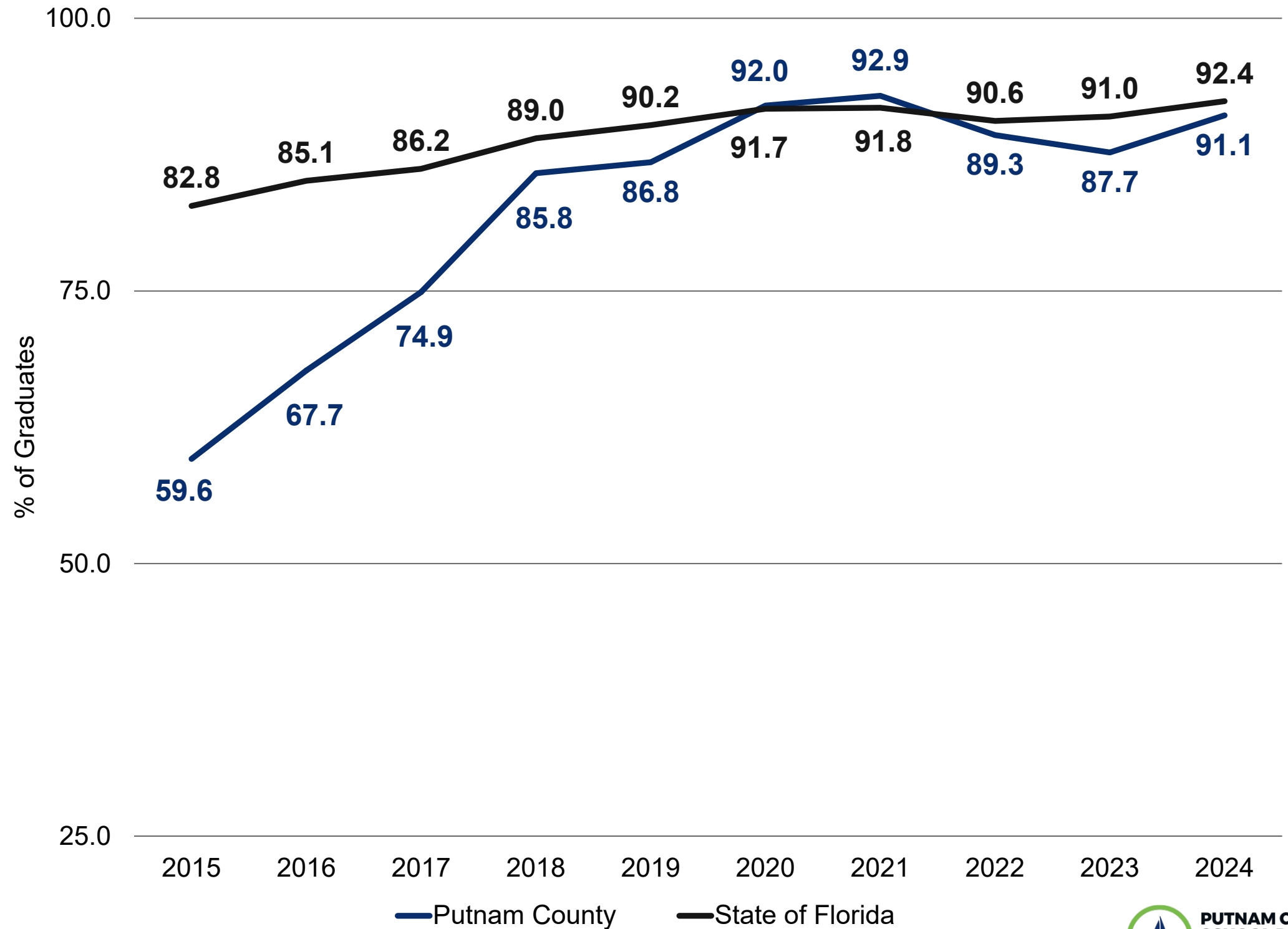
GRADUATION RATE RESULTS

DISTRICT AND STATE GRADUATION RATES



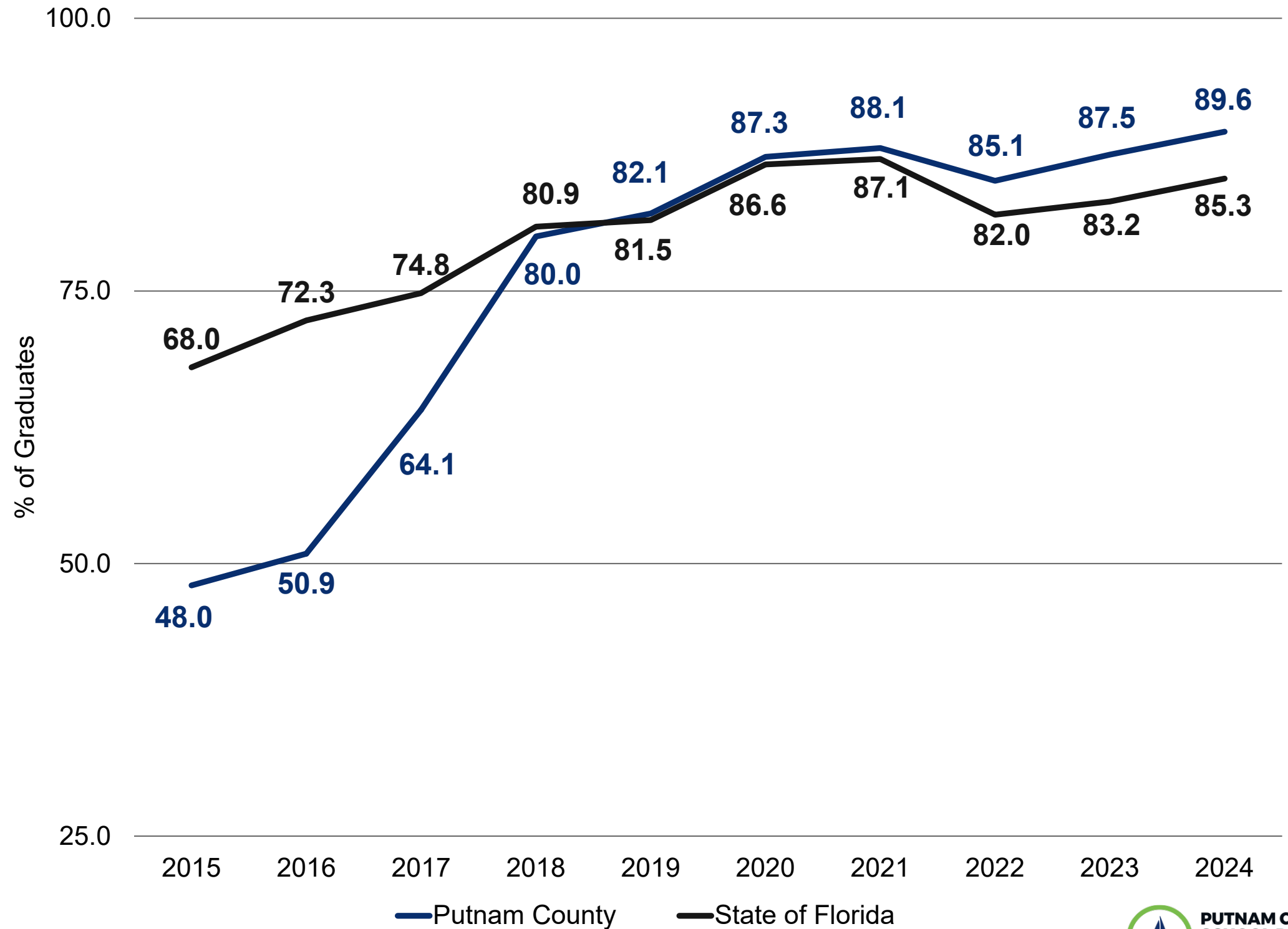

RACE/ETHNICITY SUBGROUP: WHITE



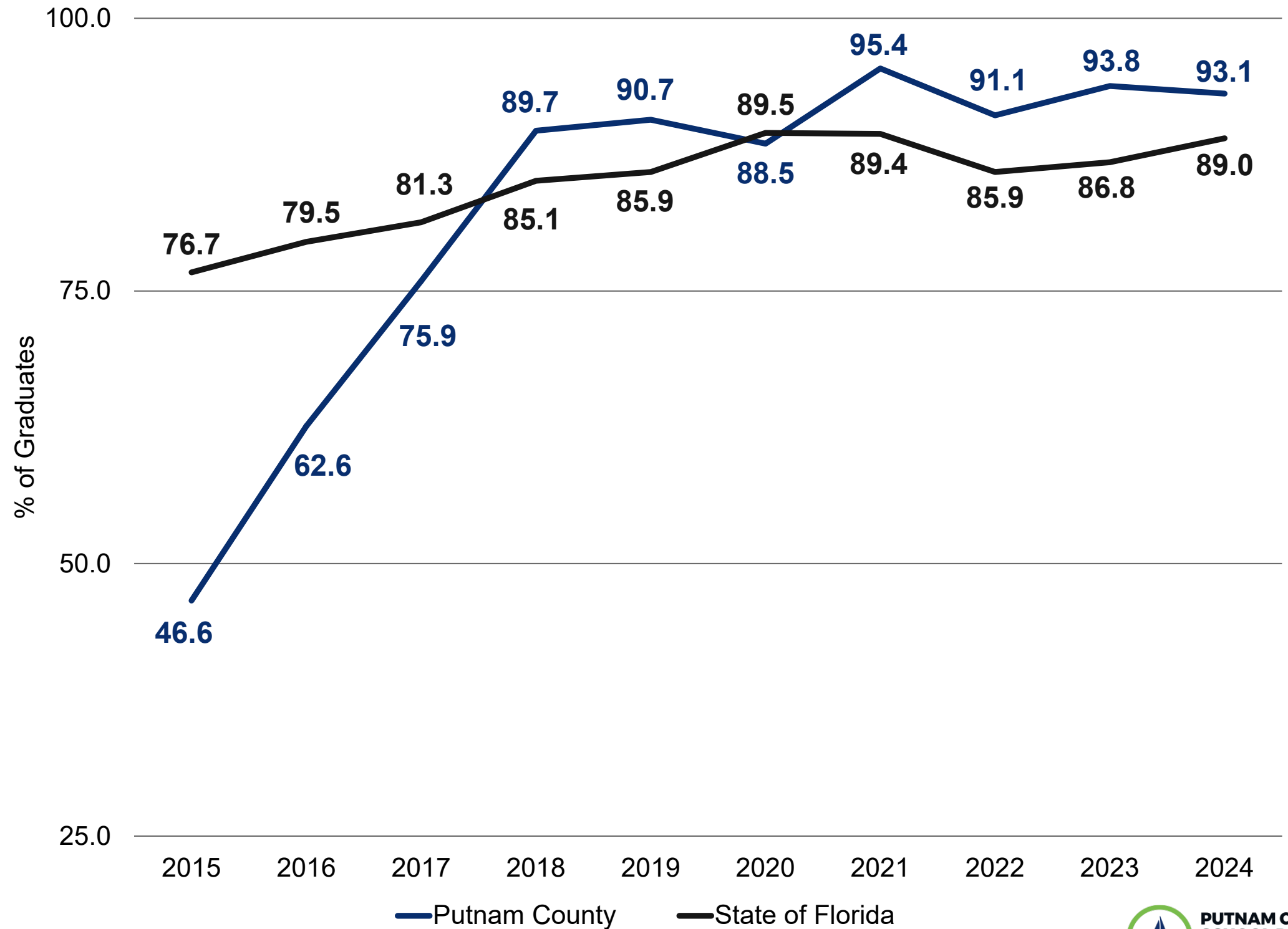

BLACK/AFRICAN AMERICAN



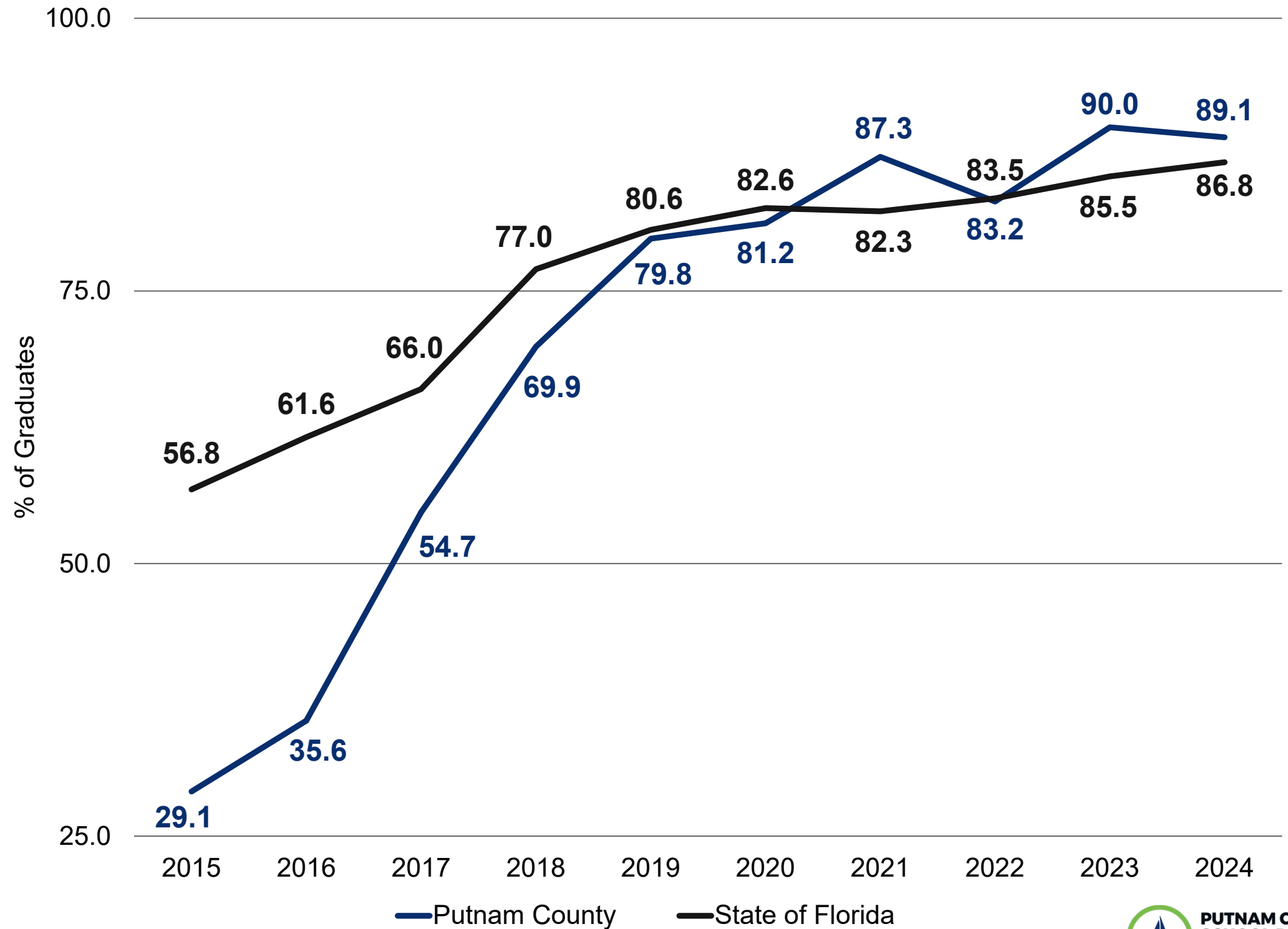

RACE/ETHNICITY SUBGROUP: HISPANIC



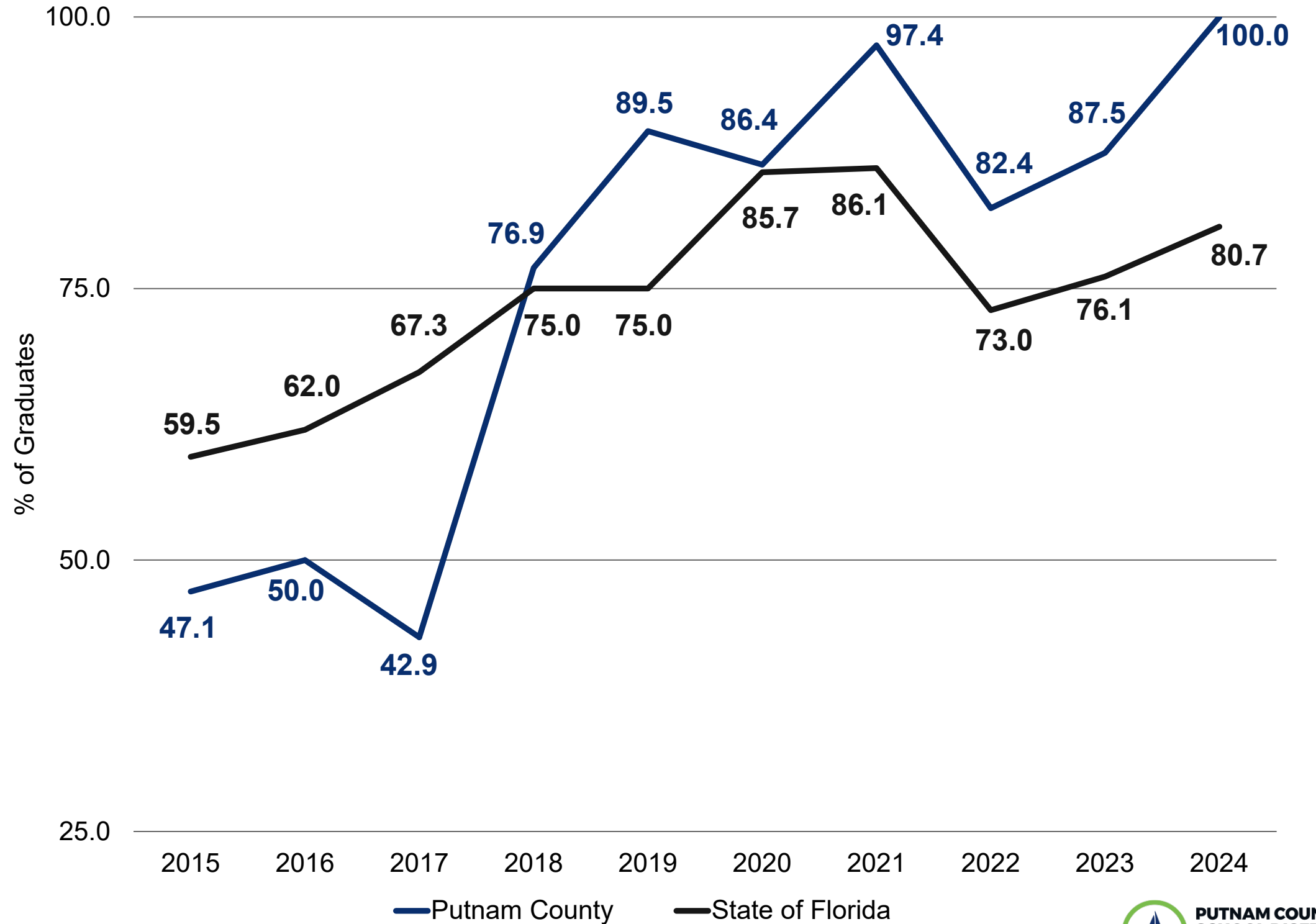

SUBGROUP: STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES



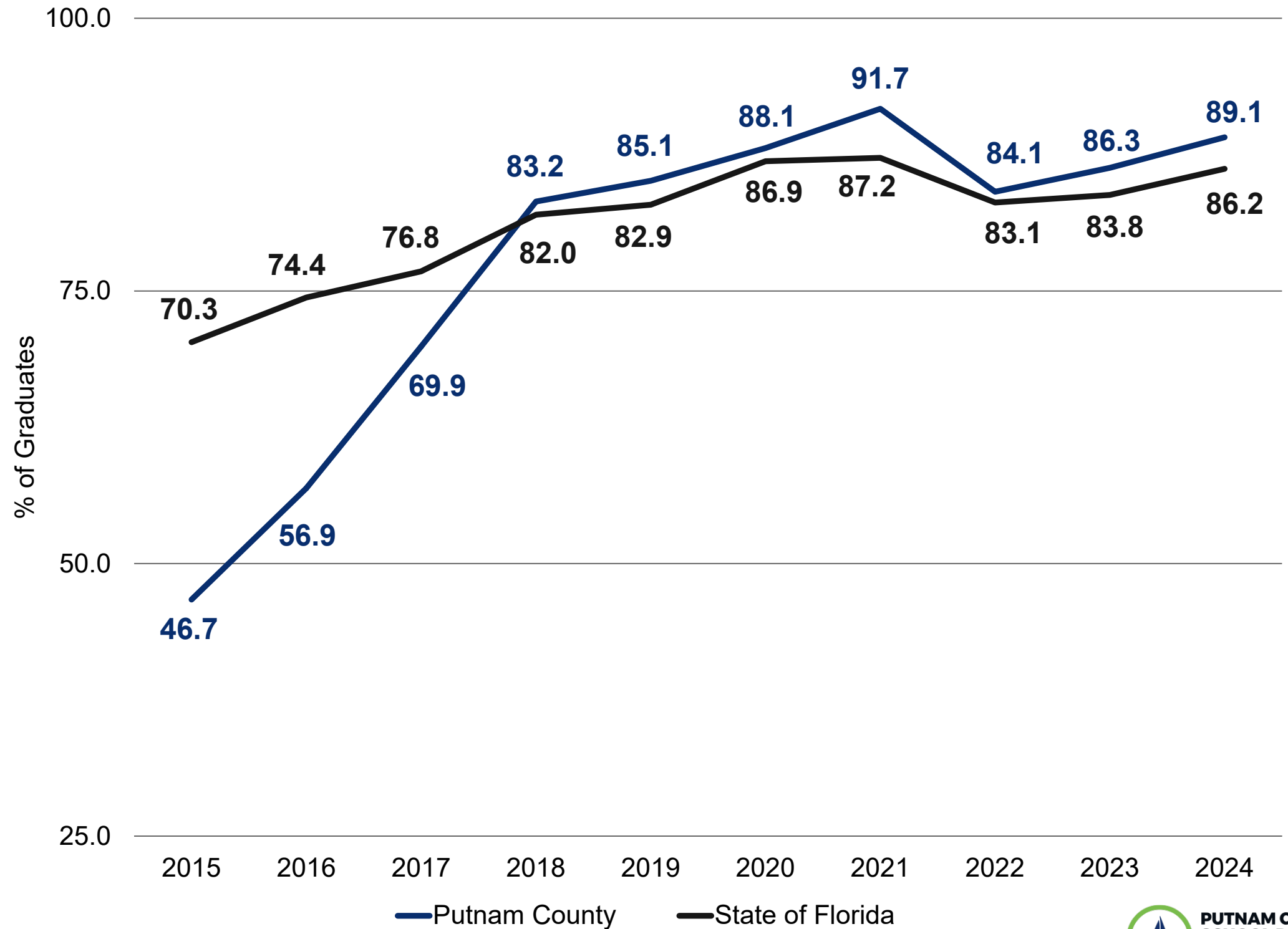
