#181 PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION IN INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETIC COMPETITION

Parents/Guardians' Consent:

Every pupil wishing to participate in interscholastic athletic activities shall be required to request same on a form furnished by the district. The parents/guardians of the student shall also be required to complete this form, consenting to their child's participation and acknowledging that physical hazards may be encountered.

Medical Examination Requirement:

All pupils in ~~grades 7 through 12~~ **secondary schools** participating in interscholastic athletics must ~~be given~~ **document an annual medical examination conducted at the medical home of the student** not before July 1st of the year in which participation will take place. **The medical home could be defined as a health care provider and that provider's practice site chosen by the student's parent or guardian for the provision of health care. The medical examination must be completed** on a form furnished by the district and, ~~as a minimum,~~ include that content adopted by the Board. **If the medical examination was completed more than 60 days prior to the first practice session, a health history update must be completed which should include any medical problems experienced since the last medical examination.**

~~no more than 60 days prior to the first practice session. The medical examination shall be given by the district's medical officer or designated team doctor. If requested by the parents/guardians, the medical examination may be given by another licensed physician, but must be reported to the district medical officer or designated team doctor. In the event a private physician is used, the medical examination shall not be at the expense of the Board of Education.~~

~~The parents/guardians shall be sent written notification signed by the examining physician testifying to the pupil's physical fitness to participate in athletics. The reason for the physician's approval or disapproval of the pupil's participation shall be included in the notification. The health findings of the medical examination for participation in athletics shall be made part of the general health examination record.~~

The medical examination to determine the fitness of a pupil to participate in athletics shall include, as a minimum, the following:

- A. A medical history questionnaire, completed by the parent/guardian of the pupil, to determine if the pupil:
 1. has been medically advised not to participate in any sport and the reason for such advice;
 2. is under physician's care and the reasons for such care;
 3. has experienced a loss of consciousness after an injury;
 4. has experienced a fracture or dislocation;
 5. has undergone any surgery;
 6. takes any medication on a regular basis, the names of such medication, and the reasons for such medication;

7. has allergies including hives, asthma, and reaction to bee stings;
 8. has experienced frequent chest pains or palpitations;
 9. has a recent history of fatigue and undue tiredness;
 10. has a history of fainting with exercise;
 11. has a history of a family member having a sudden death.
- B. A physical examination which shall include, as a minimum, no less than the following:
1. measurement of weight, height, and blood pressure;
 2. examination of the skin to determine the presence of infection, scars of previous surgery or trauma, jaundice, and purpura;
 3. examination of the eyes to determine visual acuity, use of eyeglasses or contact lenses, and examination of the sclera for the presence of jaundice;
 4. examination of the ears to determine the presence of acute or chronic infection, perforation of the eardrum, and gross hearing loss;
 5. examination of the nose to assess the presence of deformity which may affect endurance;
 6. assessment of the neck to determine range of motion and the presence of pain associated with such motion;
 7. examination of the chest contour;
 8. auscultation and percussion of the lungs;
 9. assessment of the heart with attention to the presence of murmurs, noting rhythm and rate before and after exercise;
 10. assessment of the abdomen with attention to the possible presence of hepatomegaly, splenomegaly, or abnormal masses;
 11. assessment of the back to determine range of motion and abnormal curvature of the spine;
 12. examination of the extremities to determine abnormal mobility or immobility, deformity, instability, muscle weakness or atrophy, surgical scars, and varicosities;
 13. examination of the testes to determine the presence and descent of both testes, abnormal masses or configurations, or hernia;
 14. assessment of physiological maturation;
 15. neurological examination to assess balance and coordination and the presence of abnormal reflexes.

4. Utilize test score results for the recommendation of improvements to the assigned services and programs.
5. Make recommendations concerning the implication(s) of applicable legislation.
6. Establish and maintain contacts with agencies and organizations that could serve program goals and utilize them where appropriate.

B. Supervision:

1. Assist in the interviewing and recommending of candidates as requested.
 2. Observe and report on staff performance relating to program requirements for the assigned services and programs.
 3. Consult with appropriate administrators in the scheduling of staff with multiple building assignments and, when requested, in the scheduling of any personnel connected with the assigned services and programs.
 4. Schedule and hold meetings with staff members of the assigned services and programs.
 5. Provide staff with Professional Development information for various topics, including but not limited to, standardized testing preparation, and for the assigned services and programs.
 6. Supervise and coordinate Middle School Athletics.

WHEREAS, the employment contract between the Board and Robert Zega, Ed.D., Superintendent of Schools, provides for the payment of a merit bonus to Dr. Zega upon the achievement on specific quantitative and qualitative merit criteria; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned employment contract and merit bonus provision have previously been approved by the Executive County Superintendent pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-3.1; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that Dr. Zega has satisfied merit criteria for his work during the 2012-2013 school year, warranting the payment of a merit bonus; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-3.1(e)10iv requires the Board to submit a resolution to the Executive County Superintendent certifying that specific merit criteria have been met prior to payment of any merit bonus.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The Board hereby certifies that Dr. Zega has satisfied and achieved merit criteria as set forth in his employment contract with the Board and shall be paid a merit bonus in a total amount of \$6,802, upon the approval of the Executive County Superintendent, as follows:
 - i. \$2,299 for increasing classroom projection inventories by greater than 10% (15.6% total increase)*;
 - ii. \$2,280 for increasing interactive boards by greater than 10% (59.3% total increase)*;
 - iii. \$2,223 for developing/implementing a thorough training program (all principals and supervisors now certified to perform teacher evaluations using the Danielson Framework);
