

## HIGHLY CAPABLE PROGRAMS

The district will offer a highly capable program which provides kindergarten through twelfth grade students selected access to basic education programs that accelerate learning and/or enhance instruction.

The board will annually approve the district's highly capable plan including:

1. The number of students the district expects to serve by grade level;
2. The district's plan to identify students'
3. A description of the highly capable program goals;
4. A description of the services the program will offer;
5. An instructional program description;
6. A description of ongoing professional development for highly capable program and general education staff;
7. Program evaluation;
8. Fiscal report; and
9. Assurances that the district is legally compliant.

The superintendent will establish procedures consistent with state guidelines.
