

What do testing days look like?

Students in grades K-10 will take 2-4 ATLAS assessments, with only one test given per day. Testing is typically scheduled in the morning when students are most alert and focused, helping them do their best. Students are given as much time as they need to finish, although most tests take between 35 and 90 minutes; details can be found below. All students test on a school-issued Chromebook or in a computer lab, using headphones with built-in microphones. Before testing begins, students complete a quick sound and recording check to make sure everything is working properly. Students are already familiar with the ATLAS testing platform, so the process should feel comfortable and routine. Our goal is to create a calm, familiar environment so students can focus and show what they know.
