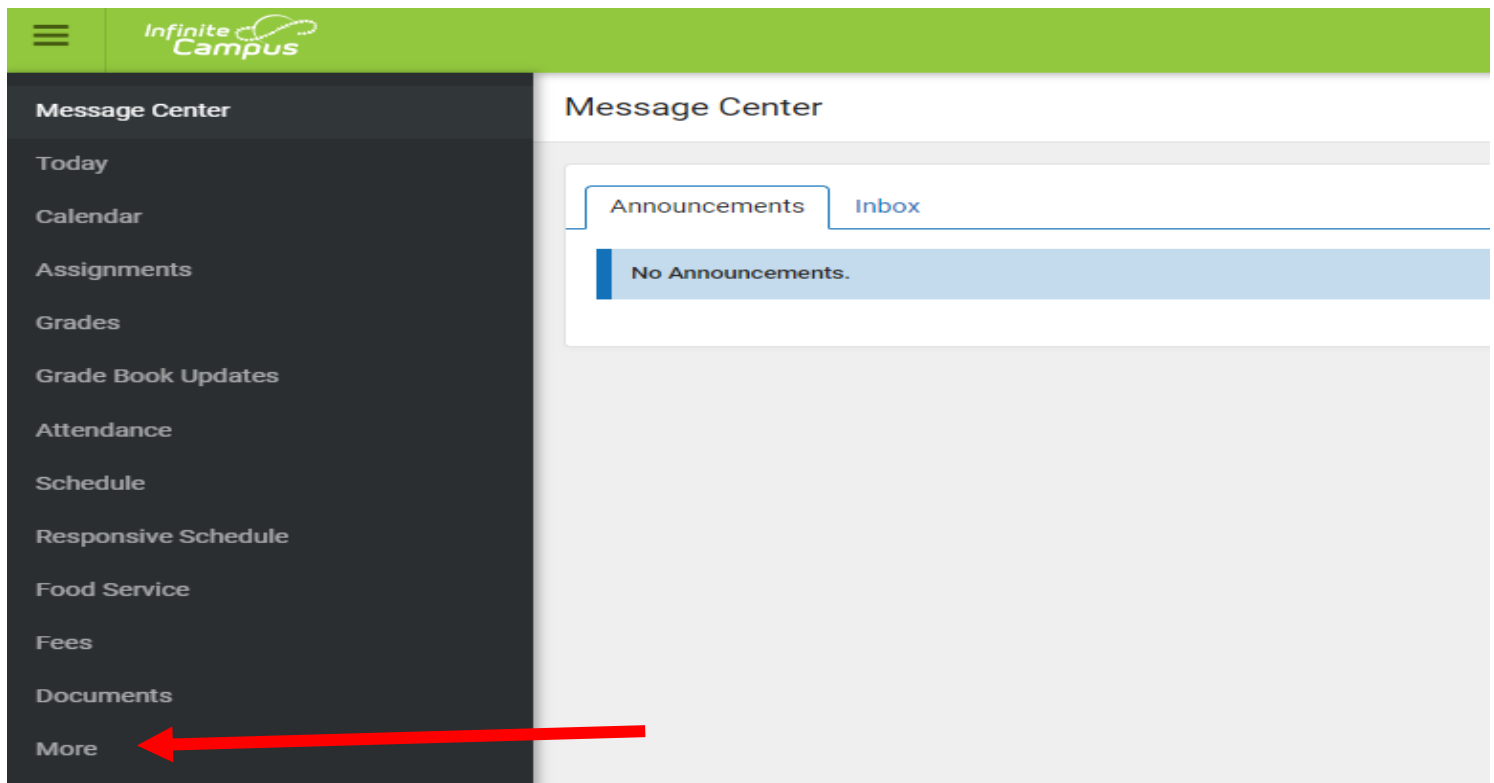
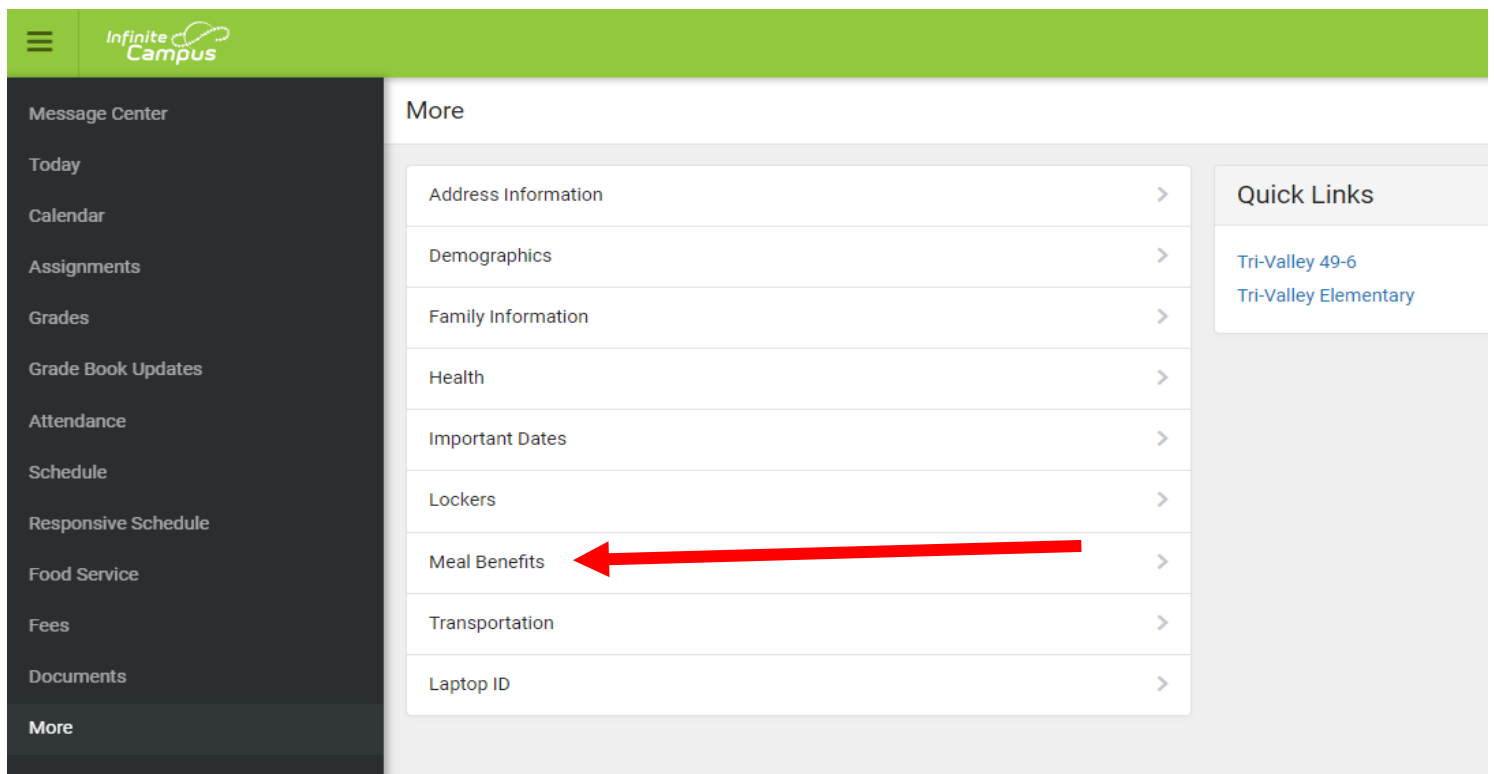


Instructions for Free & Reduced Applications Online

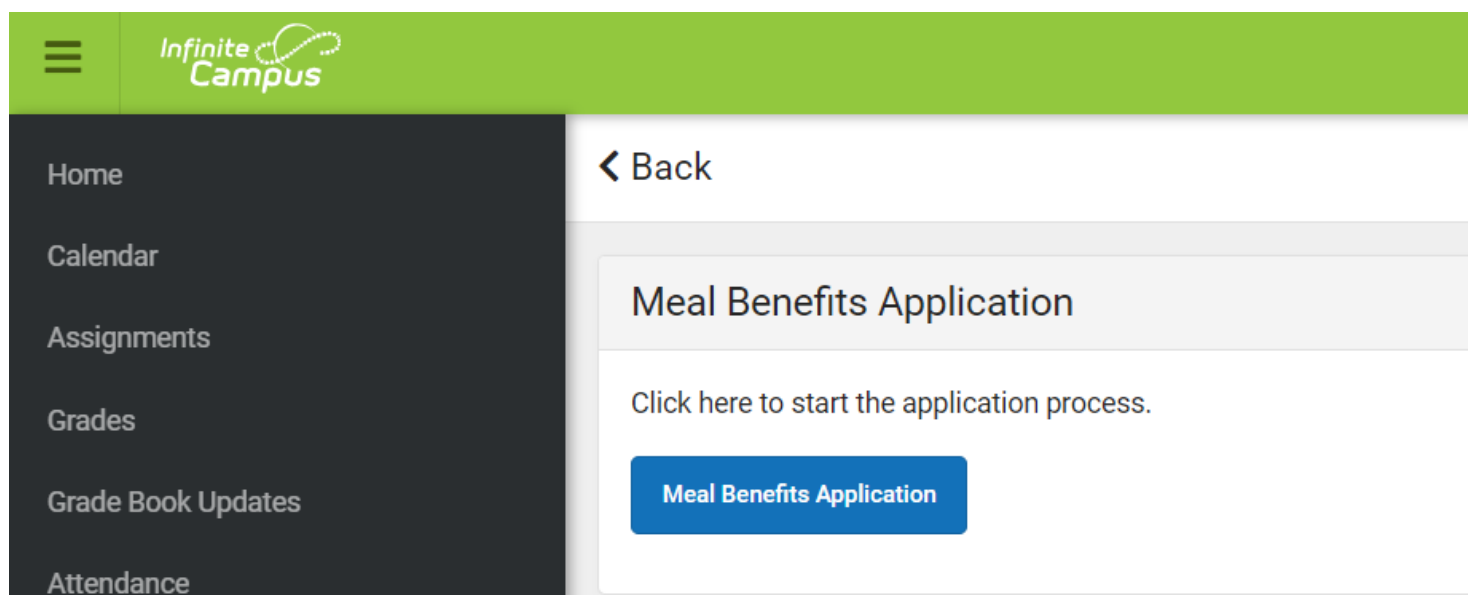


First, log in to your campus portal. On the left hand side, select “More.”

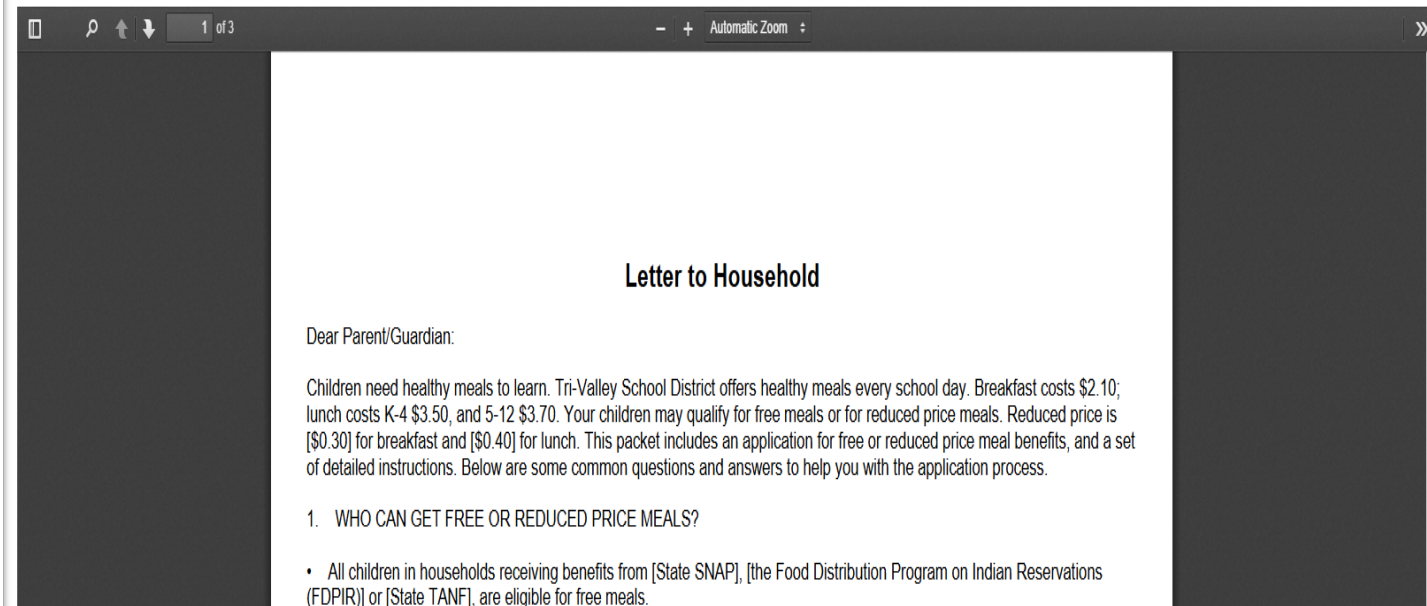
