



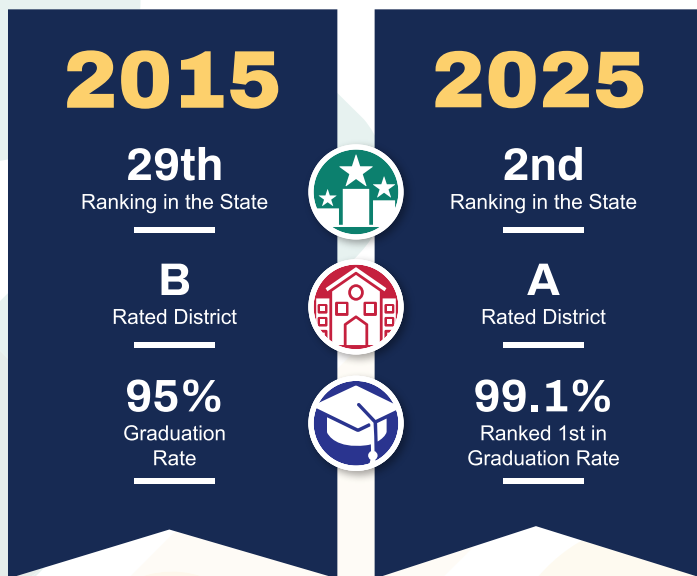
# Millage Renewals

## 2025

On November 15, 2025, voters in DeSoto Parish will head to the polls to consider renewing the current millages to fund district operations, including teacher salaries and benefits, operating expenses, and the day-to-day life of our schools. Having voters participate in this process is required by Louisiana state law and takes place every 10 years. **Early voting is November 1-8.**

### Ten Years Stronger

Since the last time the millage was approved by voters, there have been some big things happening in our schools.



### Locally Funded

62% of local revenue comes from property taxes



## On the ballot, there will be two parishwide propositions to vote on:



The operations millage pays for **high-quality teachers** (salaries/benefits), **school supplies** and **daily school necessities**.



The maintenance millage helps **maintain safe, modern facilities, utilities, and transportation**.

### Millage Renewals At a Glance:



#### Continued Commitment:

These critical millage renewals are **not new taxes** and have been in place and continuously approved by our voters since 1987-1988.



#### Locally Funded:

DeSoto Parish Schools is largely funded by local sources, with **65% of funding from local property and sales taxes**.



#### Educational Investment:

Millages contribute to **maintaining competitive schools** and **high-quality learning environments**.



#### Economic Impact:

Strong schools **boost property values** and **economic stability** in our parish.
