We ask all parents to check-in at the Front Office to obtain a Visitor's Pass before visiting any classrooms. • To inspect child's school records, particularly attendance and grades. • To be informed of significant facts and school action related to child's behavior and academic progress. • To examine child's personal records.	• Make sure healthy scholar comes to school daily OR misses no more than one day a month for illness and provides doctor's note to Front Office. • Support prepared scholars: ○ Assignments promptly completed in a quality manner, ○ 20-minutes extra practice at home in math and vocabulary, ○ At least 20 minutes of reading, and ○ All other homework completed. • Use kind thoughts, words, and actions. • Check grades often, encourage scholars to earn all As & Bs, and ask what was learned. • Contact teachers as often as possible. • Bring concerns to school immediately by contacting a teacher, coach, or administrator. • Promote positive use of scholar's time out of school. • Promptly notify Front Office with updates on cell phone information.

Miss school less than one day a month. • Attend all classes on time, every day. • Use kind thoughts, words, and actions. • Aim to earn all As & Bs by leaving distractions at home. • Follow all directions given by teachers/staff. • Report problems, concerns, harassment, or special needs to a teacher, the assistant principal, or principal as soon as possible.
Staff	• To expect scholars to behave in a manner which will not interfere with learning. • To teach with minimal interruptions. • To receive parental support for positive academic, social, and behavior actions. • To receive support when enforcing rules designed to provide high levels of learning and a positive climate.	• Prepare plans and materials for engaging and rigorous lessons with additional, daily practice out-of-class (for math, vocabulary, reading, and content homework). • Use kind thoughts, words, and actions. • Actively monitor and encourage learners to learn all that is possible. • Proactively communicate using up-to-date records and hard copy information. • Complete and submit a Liaison Request from when parent information needs to be updated.
