# School Performance Score

Letter grades are given to all public schools each school year unless waived by the federal government. These letter grades are usually released in late October or early November.

79.4 B

75% - State Assessments - The school gets points for all students who score Basic and Above.  
20% - Student Growth - This is student progress points that is determined by growth year to year.  
5% - Interest and Opportunities - This is measured by the amount of opportunities provided to the students outside of traditional learning.
