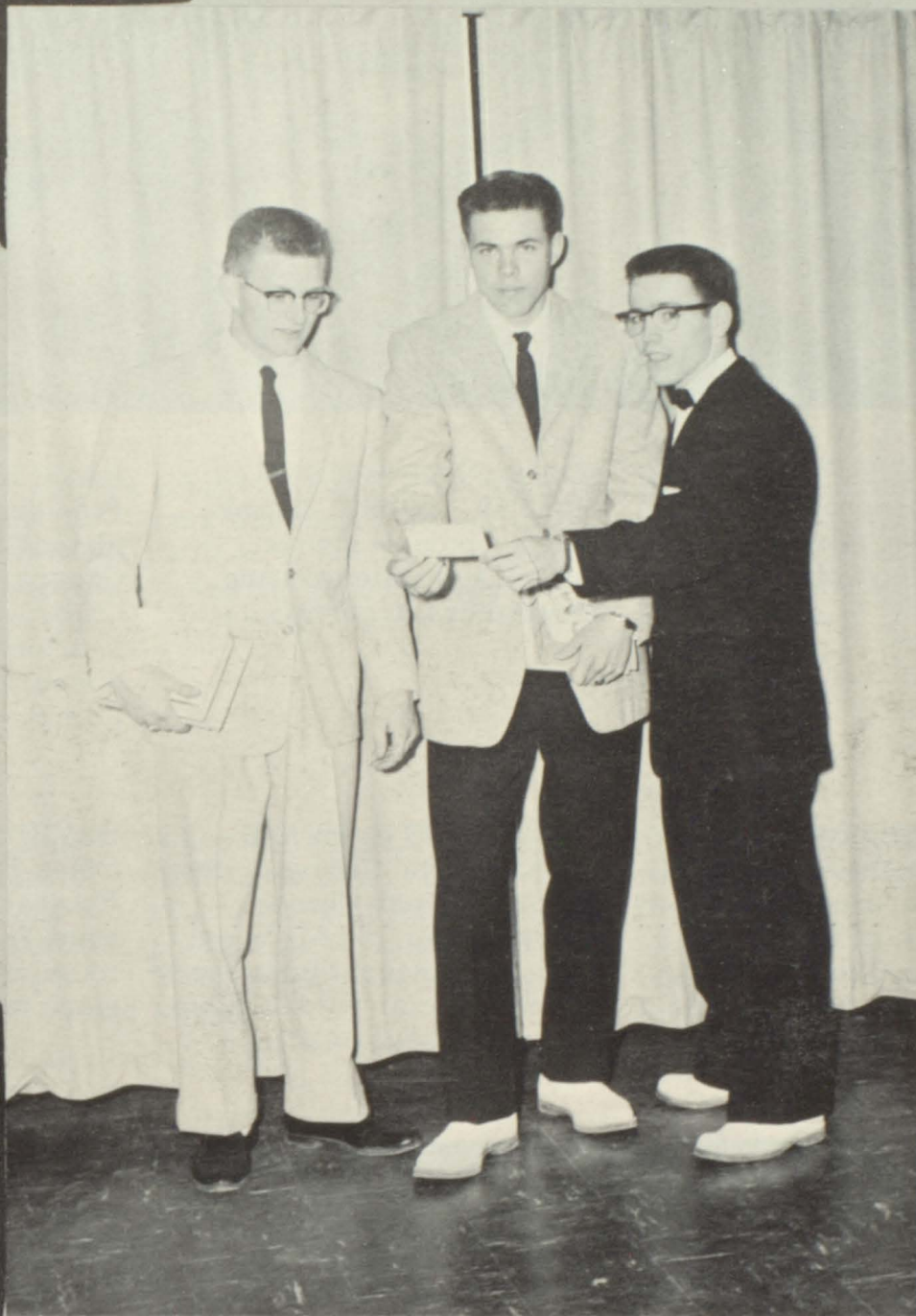

Board of Education



A complete re-organization of the school district was brought about during the 1959-1960 school year. The territory is now known as the Turtle Lake Special School District No. 72.

The area was divided geographically into five parts. One man was chosen from each area to serve on the Board of Education. These members are Edwin Britton, Addison Parks, Glenn Love, Jake Schlafmann, chairman; Ole Gunderson, George Grooters, superintendent; Glenn Moore, treasurer; and Leonard McMillan, clerk. This board immediately brought about plans to finance and construct a new school building for grades 7-12.

The new building will include 10 classrooms, a band room, farm shop, industrial arts room, home economics room, science room, library, furnace room, teachers' room, and offices for the principal and superintendent. Siefert and Staszko are the architects.

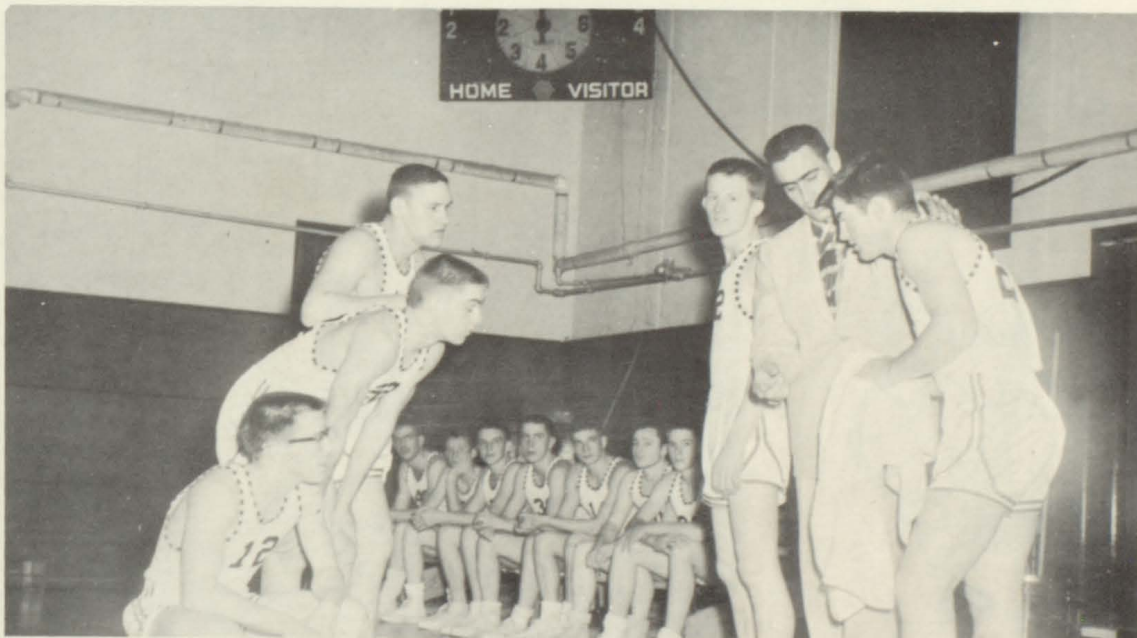

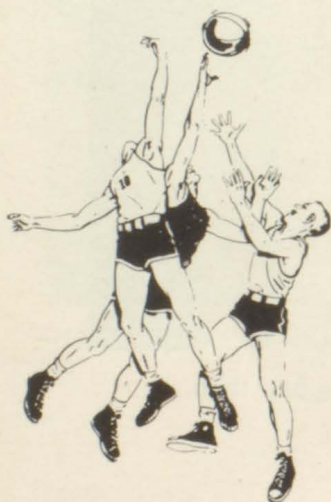

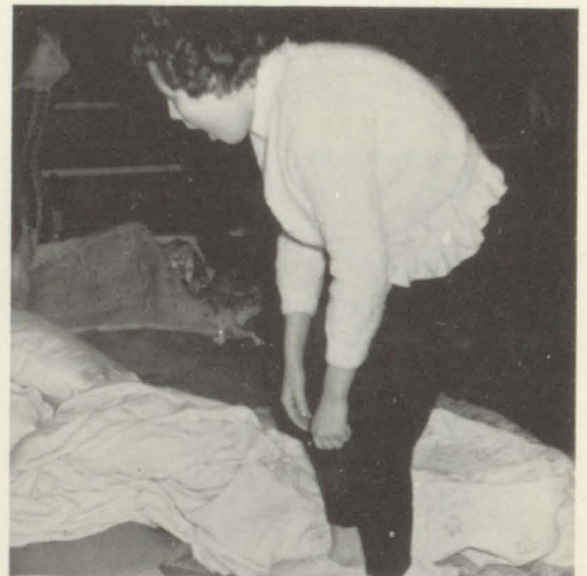
Pep Club

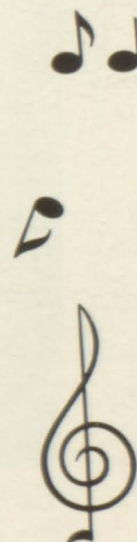

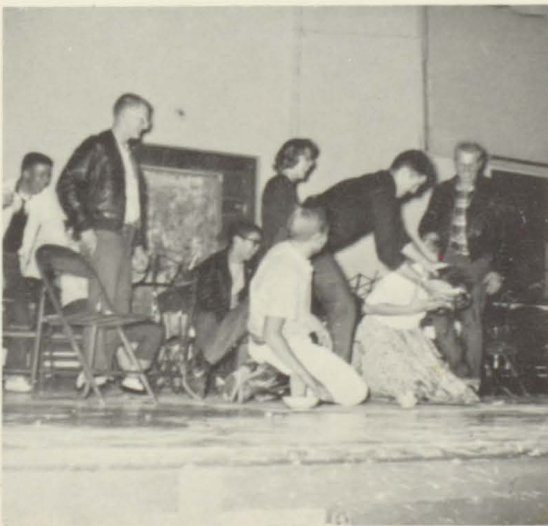

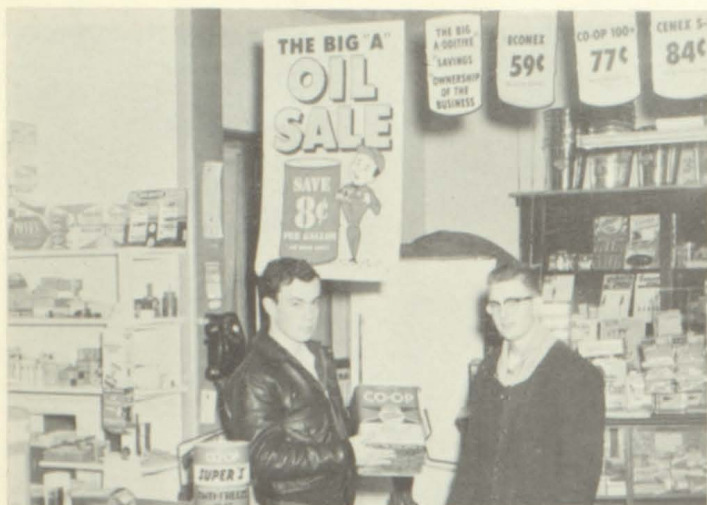

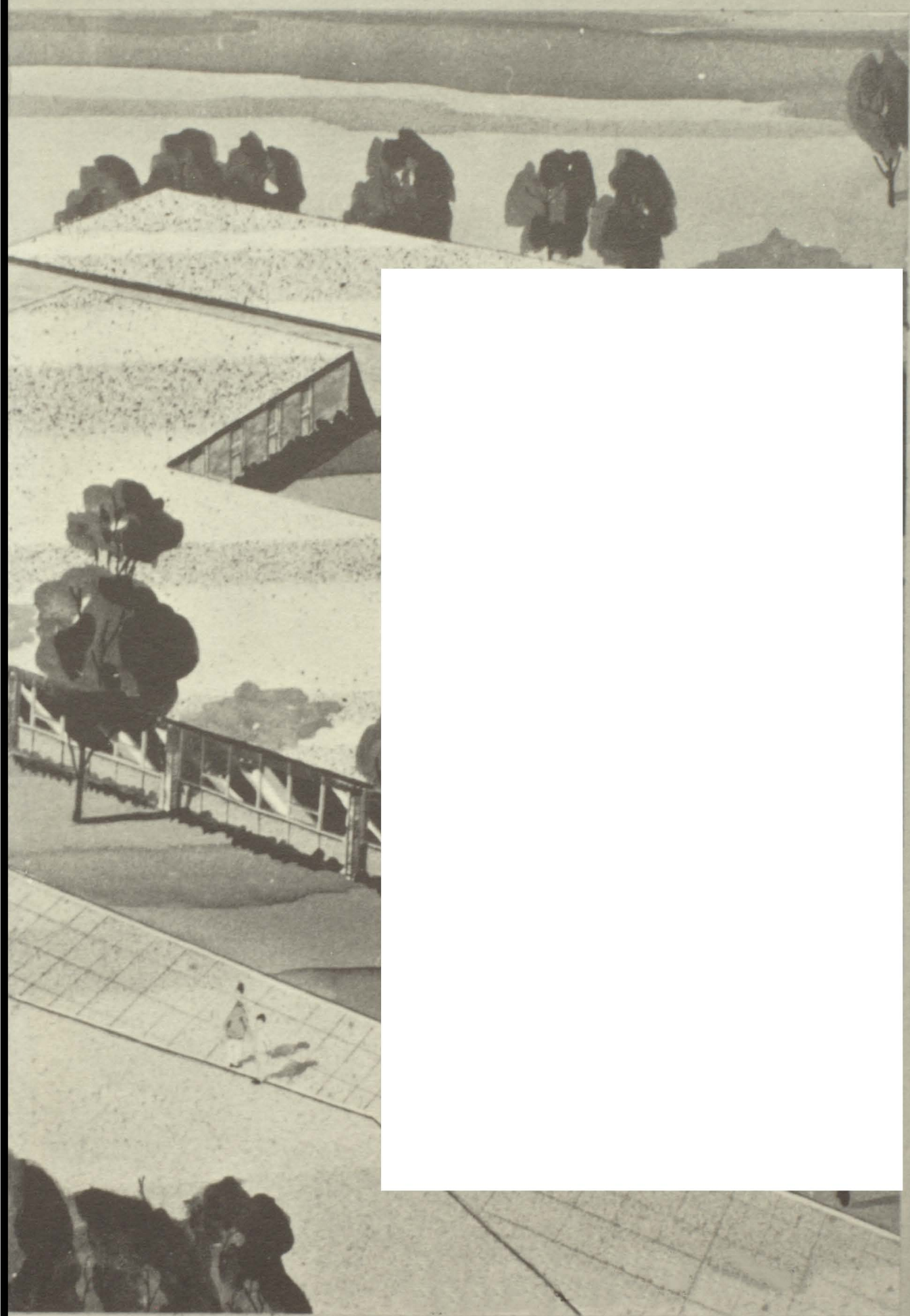
Grade Pep Club
