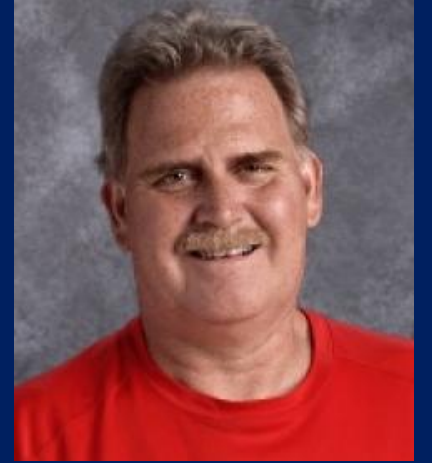

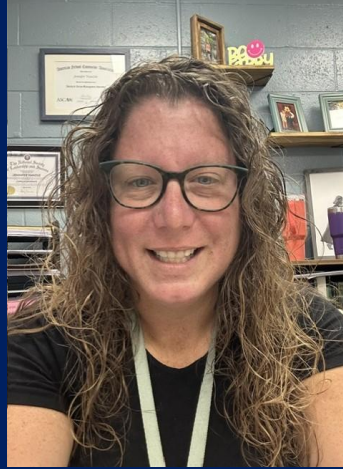

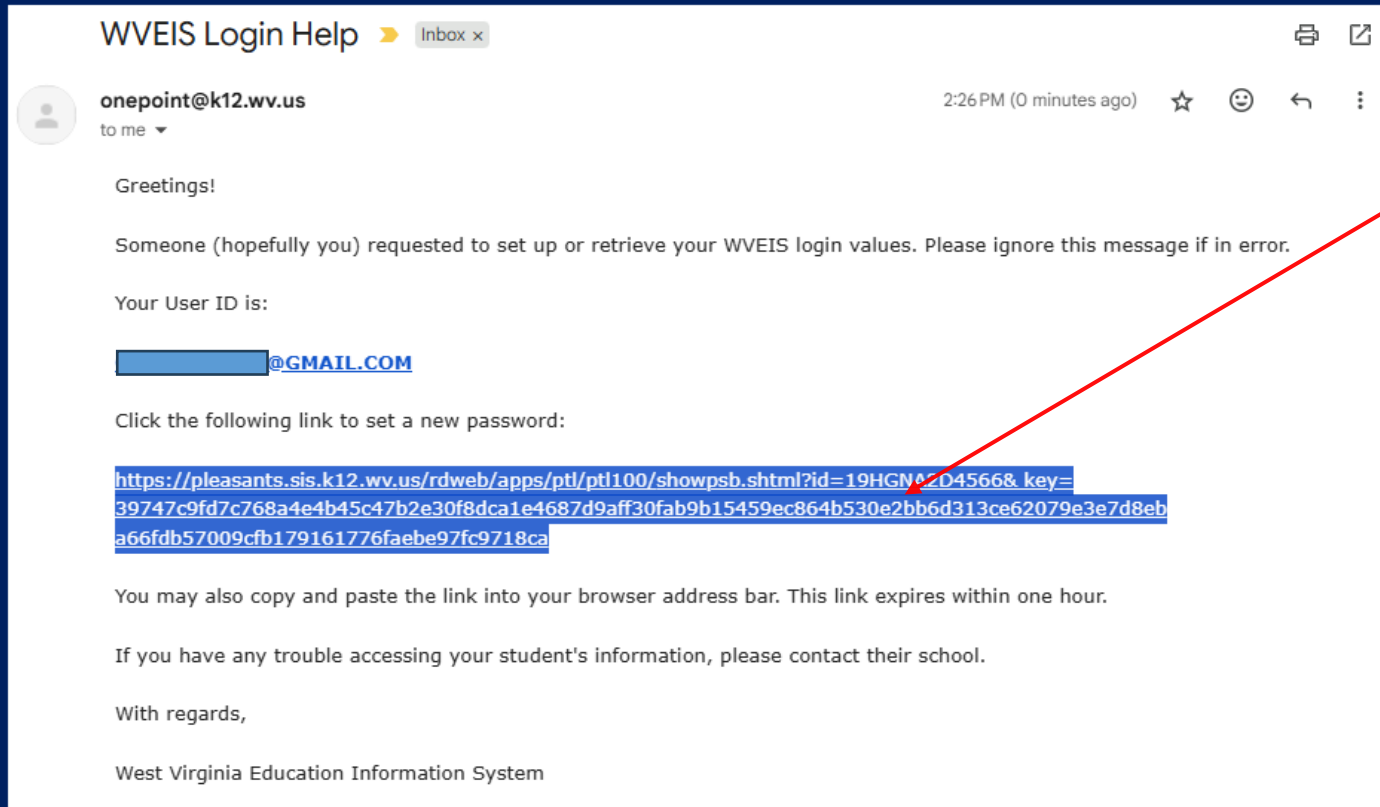

- What is Title 1?
 - A federally funded program that provides extra support to schools and students/families
- What is the goal of Title 1?
 - To help every student have the opportunity to be successful in school
- What does the Title 1 teacher do?
 - Provides extra academic support to students who may benefit from additional instruction or practice
 - Tier 1, Tier 2, and Tier 3 supports
- Data analysis-->work with classroom teachers to identify students' strengths and areas for improvement-->monitor student progress-->adjust instruction accordingly
 - Communicate with families about student progress and ways to support learning at home (look out for iReady reading and math reports in report cards, each 9 weeks)

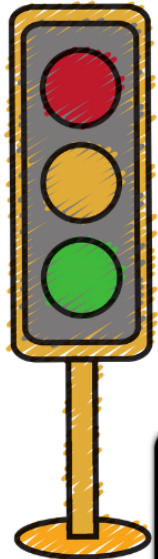

 - Instruction types: whole group, small group and individualized instruction.



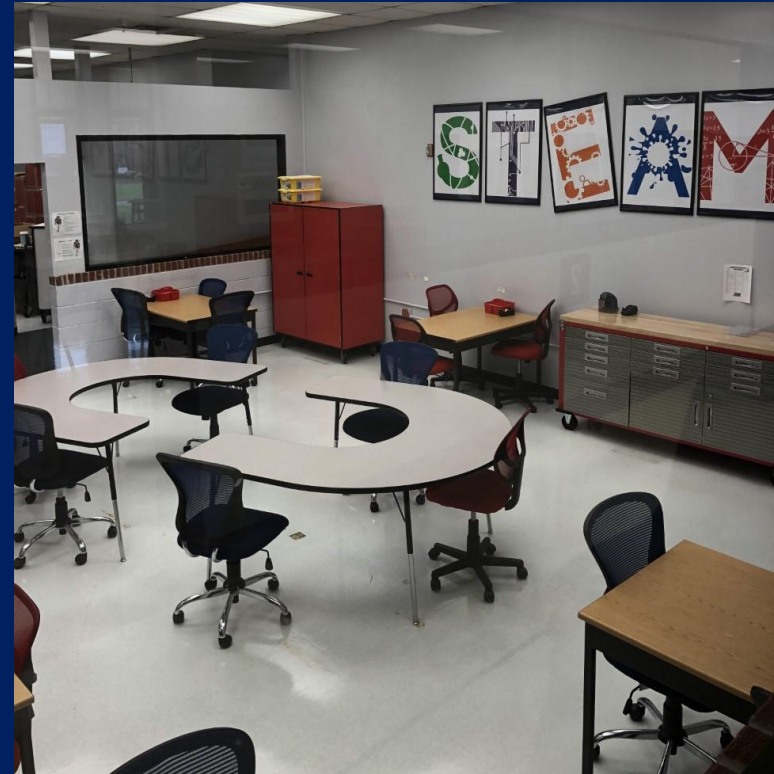
General Class Information

- Each class period is 46 minutes (excluding lunch and SPL).
- Support for Personalized Learning (SPL) is 5th or 6th period each day. SPL is designed for students to get additional help in content area subjects. Class period is 40 minutes per day.

Communication/Electronic Devices



ALL communication/electronic devices must be kept in the student's locker and not to be carried upon their person at any time throughout the school day, unless otherwise approved by the school's administration.

- **1st Offense:**

The device(s) will be confiscated and maintained in the principal's office. The student may pick up the device at the end of the day. The student will be assigned detention.

- **2nd Offense:**

The device(s) will be confiscated and maintained in the principal's office. A parent/guardian will be required to pick up the device. Written notification will be given to the parent/guardian indicating the violation and the penalty for future violations. The student will be assigned detention.

- **3rd Offense+:**

The offending student will be considered insubordinate and may be suspended from school for up to 10 days.

IPad Charging Policy



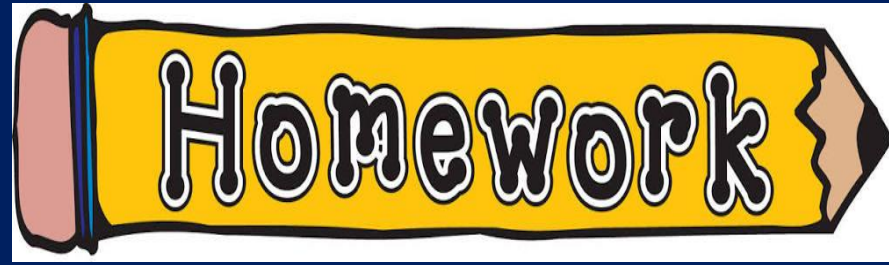
- Students must arrive at school with their school-issued iPads charged to at least 50%.
- If a student's iPad is below 50% charge at the start of the day, a referral will be written to the office by the home room teacher.
- After the second violation of the week, students will receive detention for repeated non-compliance.
- **PBIS Incentive Program:**
 - Students who have their iPads charged to 90% or more will receive a PBIS reward dollar.
 - This reward is given for each day the iPad meets the 90% charge requirement.
- **Please remind students to charge their devices at home, or leave them at school on the charger. This will ensure the students are prepared for class.**

Homework/iReady

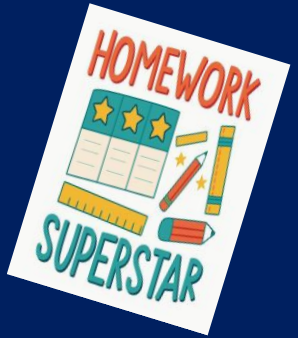


Homework

Homework is assigned by the teacher and should be written in students agendas and posted on Class Dojo.

IReady

- 2 Lessons ELA + 45 minutes, graded weekly
- 2 Lessons Math + 45 minutes, graded weekly
- Due by Thursday afternoon in order to be eligible for Free Choice Friday
- Students who have not completed by Friday morning, will report to designated small group instead of FCF.



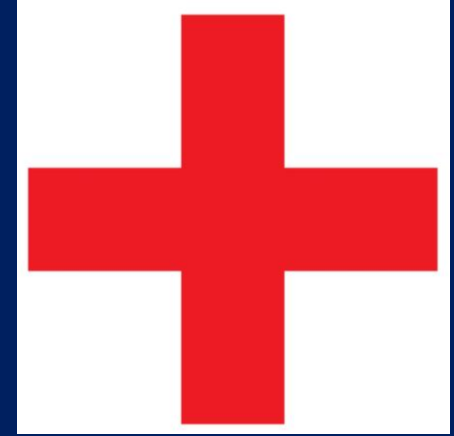


Student Sign-Out and Pick-Up

- Parents/Guardians use the FRONT entrance when picking student up/dropping off during day.
- Parking restricted in front loop until 8:30 a.m. and after 3:10 p.m.
- When picking student up early, parents (or individuals authorized on emergency cards) must sign student out in the office.
- When students return to school, they do not need to be signed in by a parent/guardian. Student can sign themselves in with a medical/parent note.
- Students arriving AFTER 10:00 a.m. or LEAVING prior to 2:00 p.m., are counted ½ day absent.



Medication Protocols



- Same protocol as for elementary school.
- Any medications kept at school (prescription and non-prescription) must be kept in the nurse's office.
 - Medication must be in the original container, they cannot be in baggies.
 - A form must be filled out by your student's doctor for each medication.
 - Forms are available in the office.
