
## Foreword

Second Grade pupils are taught reading skills from their basic reader. Reading is carried over into Science, Health, Social Studies, and many books are provided for reading pleasure. We teach the children good health habits and the need for being healthy. Arithmetic comes in many ways. We use out text, but also have many occasions for incidental arithmetic. Social Studies, English, Spelling, Art, and Music come in our unit work.

A vital achievement in the First Grade is the happy and favorable attitudes developed toward school, the teacher, and classmates. The program includes development of skills in listening, speaking, writing, reading, science, health, social studies, and arithmetic skills.



Third Grade pupils have a busy schedule from the first bell of the school term, until the last bell at the close of the year. They are taught Reading, Writing, Language, Science, Social Studies, Current Events, Spelling, Physical Education, and Arithmetic. Every minute of the school day is planned and the child participates in a learning situation from early morning until school is out for the day.



In the Fourth Grade the curriculum is planned with the interests and abilities of children in mind which includes Arithmetic, Social Studies, Science, Safety and Health, Art and Music.
