8. REPORTS FROM THE SUPERINTENDENT, ADMINISTRATORS, AND COMMITTEES

8.1 BOCES - BOCES Board Member - no new meetings but finished surveys for Brads evaluation. Next meeting in Rangely.

8.2 Parkview Principal - Carlene Cantrell - 1st semester report cards went home in January. MAPS testing completed last week, excited about growth seen in students scores. UPK-preschool enrollment- is open on state website and April 24th is the date set for the Health fair to enroll preschoolers.

8.3 Rangely JR/SR High Principal - Sarah Hepworth - not in attendance- at HS wrestling

8.5 Superintendent- Matt Scoggins - did "page flip" with Professional Services about colors and carpets. Meta Glasses are becoming more popular, they are classified as an Electronic Device like cell phones and are not allowed in school. Working with Bart on the GPS systems on the buses. Asked the board's opinion of online classes and the possibility of RSD offering more online classes or hybrid classes-this idea was presented in the last admin meeting so Mr Scoggins agreed to do more research about what online classes could look like in our district. Reports starting to look for cafeteria tables and furniture-already approved thru the bond. RSD has an agreement with Moffat County for transportation reimbursement for bussing students from Dinosaur. Moffat County has a new superintendent, giving pushback on this agreement. Mr. Scoggins will be working through this issue and continuing to have discussions to resolve this.

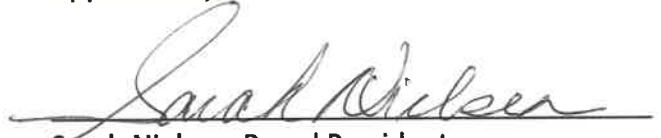
