Brad Casto thanks all the candidates for applying, there was a tough pool to pick from. He also thanked Ken Haptonstall for his help and support to the board.

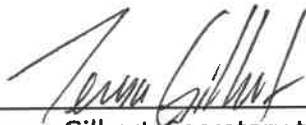
