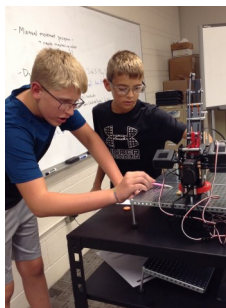
COLD WEATHER EXPECTATIONS

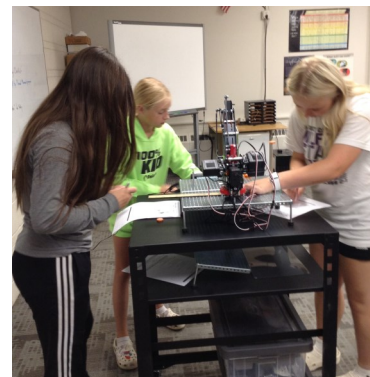
HOME COMING 2022

New this year to the junior high curriculum is a 9-week course in Robotics. This course is aided by a large grant through local business, MetalQuest, and the Educational Service Unit in Beatrice. The grant funded a total of five Vex5 robotic arms for students to program. While not all of the equipment was received until late in the quarter the students learned about mastering values, 3-space coordinates and basic programming. They even got to program the robot to write their initials, which wasn't as easy as most thought. The class was also fortunate to tour both MetalQuest and Reinke Manufacturing to learn more about local career opportunities in this field.

3. Exercise for at least 30 minutes a day.
4. List 3 things you are proud that you did each day.
5. Focus on 1-2 positive affirmations throughout your day.

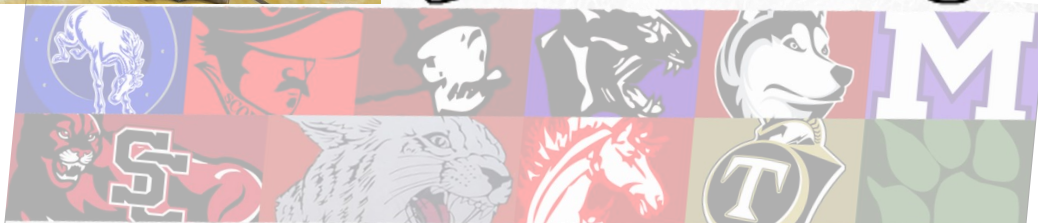
