Bartow County is located in the scenic foothills of Georgia's Appalachian Mountains, approximately 45 miles northwest of the city limits of Atlanta and included in the Metro Atlanta Service Area. As the 25th largest school district in the state of Georgia, Bartow County School System is home to approximately 13,468 students. There are 21 schools in Bartow County, each accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. These include 12 elementary, 4 middle, and 3 high schools, as well as the Bartow County College and Career Academy (BCCCA).

Curriculum

WHS course offerings include Advanced Placement (AP), Honors, CTAE, and Fine Arts. Advanced courses are available in all academic areas. 23 credits are required to graduate. Class rank is cumulative for four years and weighted on the basis of the curriculum level. All classes and all students pursuing a regular diploma are calculated in the class rank. AP & Honor classes are weighted for GPA and class rank purposes. AP course grades include an additional 5 points to final grade; honors classes have 3 points added to final grade.
