### Kindergarten - Grade 2

### Grades 3-5

- Basic Business Concepts (needs vs. wants, entrepreneurship basics)
- Financial Literacy (saving, earning, budgeting)
- Introduction to Coding and Digital Tools
- Communication Skills and Presentation
- Work Readiness Skills (teamwork, responsibility)
- Career Exploration (different professions, soft skills)

- Intermediate Business and Economics (market basics, consumer rights)
