At this time, on behalf of the board of education, Tamara Dody expressed her condolences to the Tim Pflughoeft Family.

On motion by Kayla Cullens and seconded by Josh Hurley, the board voted 7-0 to approve no school, district-wide, for Wednesday, April 16, 2025.

Michael Ryan presented to the board the possibility of expanding the tennis courts at CPJSHS – Claflin. The expansion of three additional courts would provide additional court time for participants, possibly hosting regional tennis meets, and help with the summer tennis program. He reviewed the condition of the existing courts and the cost to resurface, and there may be possible grants to help offset the expense, along with private donations on expansion.

By consensus, the board agreed to move forward on re-surfacing the existing courts and possible tennis court expansion in the future.

Mr. Murphy reviewed the Holyrood Daycare hours for the upcoming summer months and the possibility of having Shawndell Kirmer act as an executive director during that time, to assist with licensing, calendars, and aides at all the daycare centers.

He also discussed the Wilson Daycare addition and adding a bathroom in the building to assist with the addition of the 2nd daycare room at Wilson.

Mr. Murphy discussed the prospective Claflin Daycare facility and the possibility of adding it to the existing CPJSHS building on the east side. This would give the facility access to food delivery from the school kitchen and connect to the electricity of the CPJSHS building. He also reviewed the funds available for the daycare with Advance Barton County Childcare (ABBB) and the current funds the district has on hand for this project.

Discussion: Daycare (cont)

Jeromy Bortz and Layne Bieberle, contractors for the design of the building, discussed the two different plans for the building at an estimated cost of \$1.2 million or \$1.5 million, respectively.

By consensus, the board agreed to instruct the contractors to submit two different plans, with the cost as a stand-alone building or an addition to the CPJSHS building, with both costs of \$1.2 million or \$1.5 million.
