## HUNTINGTON HISTORY

The first building for Huntington High School was set up in 1923. It was a portable 2 room structure which was purchased in West Virginia and erected at the northwest corner of St. Rt. 772 and Blain Highway. Three years of high school work was offered to 27 pupils. The school employed 2 teachers who also served as janitors. The building was later moved to the site of the present Huntington School complex, where it was used until the completion of the new Huntington Centralized School. The building was torn down after the completion of the new school in 1931.
