APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mrs. Kaufman and Mr. Hurt agreed to amend motion to approve minutes as amended. Corrections noted were: **1)** In the Approval of Minutes section, replace “with a changes” with “with changes;” **2)** Regarding Request for Quotation #743 Hunnicutt Stadium Repairs (Board Memo #35), replace “Bids were sent to the four vendors” with “Bids were requested from four vendors;” **3)** Regarding Purchase of 30 Computers and Monitors and 2 Network Printers (Board Memo #37), replace “Technology request authorization” with “Technology requested authorization;” **4)** Regarding Transfer of Student from Summers County (Board Memo #40), remove the phrase, “which sits between the boundaries of Mercer and Summers County;” **5)** Regarding Option to Purchase Real Estate (Board Memo #41, add an “s” to “Mercer County School;” **6)** Regarding Personnel (Board Memo #42), remove the phrase, “contingent upon the return of a clean background check;” **7)** Regarding Personnel (Board Memo #42), move “Note: Employment is contingent upon acceptable background checks and drug testing.” before the word “Leaves” and under “Professional” (on page 5) as well as “Service Personnel” (on page 9).

Board Memo #269

This policy was updated to add Sections 2.2 and 2.3, detailing who has access to an employee's file. The last sentence in Section 2.4 was deleted. This section conflicted with Section 2.6. Sections 2.7 and 2.8 have been added to include the release of information in an emergency. No comments were received.
