Breakfast:

Washington - \$2.10, Daly - \$2.20, HMS - \$2.30, HHS - \$2.40

Lunch:

Washington - \$3.25, Daly - \$3.35, HMS - \$3.45, HHS - \$3.90

Families who may qualify for free or reduced-price meals are encouraged to complete an application. Applications are available online through the Infinite Campus parent portal or paper applications are available at each of the school offices and district office.

Reduced price breakfast is \$.30 and reduced price lunch is \$.40. Please note: Milk is \$1.00 and a second entrée is \$1.25, regardless of student's free or reduced-price meal status.
