

MATH

ELA

Students are working on their Common Lit Unit One Culminating Task Prompt: *What will it take to achieve success this school year?* Students will prepare a presentation explaining how they will use the ingredients from the recipe for success to be successful this school year. Students will use examples from the texts and videos in this unit to support the information in their presentation. Their presentation must include a visual component to convey information.



SOCIAL STUDIES
