

Hello and Welcome to the GRHS Esports Team!

My name is Mrs. Seaton, and I am the coach for the Esports Team here at GRHS. I am so excited to have you! Please read the information below and let me know if you have any questions:

What is my commitment?

To be a member of our team, you need to commit to the following:

1. Play one game for one hour a week. If you choose to play more than one game, you need to be present for each game for 1 hour. Practice is not required, but how will you get better if you don't practice?
2. You are required to participate in our concession stand fundraiser. This one time, either for an evening such as during football season or one Saturday like during basketball season. I put students in 2-hour shifts for the evening ones and 4 hours on Saturdays. You will know by September 1st what our time is so you can plan around work and family schedules.
3. You agree to follow all policies and rules regarding school and matches.

What do I get from participating?

If you meet the qualifications, you can earn a letter! You can also earn bragging rights in the games you play. You will also make new friends and gain a sense of belonging to a group who are like minded. Most of all, we have FUN!

Is there a cost to play?

No, there are no fees or costs to play. The team provides all the equipment and licensing fees. This is the reason we fundraise. We do not travel; every match is played here at GRHS in room 302, which is our Computer Science room.

Can I bring my own equipment?

Nintendo Switches are the only hardware we are allowed to bring from home. We play our matches on Alienware computers here at school. You are welcome to bring your own controllers and headphones if you wish.

Do I have to be eligible to play?

Since we are not recognized as a sanctioned sport, we do not fall under the eligibility requirements. However, passing your classes and getting good grades are important, and I encourage you to make sure you take care of business. If you get into disciplinary issues and they are significant, you and I will have a conversation about your continued participation.
