Fellowship of Christian Athletes

Fellowship of Christian Athletes or FCA is a national organization with local chapters. At Fremont High School FCA is open to all students, not just athletes. The meetings are weekly during FLEX and are student led. Key Club

Key Club is an international organization dedicated to the development of students as service leaders. Anyone can join the Key Club here at Fremont. There are annual dues that go to support the state and national organization but we can help anyone who can't afford to pay dues. As part of the Kiwanis Family of organizations we work as closely as possible in cooperation with our local Kiwanis Club who sponsors our group and provides us with help and advice. We share their goal of helping children and work with them to support the CMN, March of Dimes, and UNICEF. Locally we do whatever we can to serve our students and people in our area who need help. We have helped with a variety of service projects since 2009. We have been a chartered club since 2010.

National Honor Society

The National Honor Society includes members who exemplify qualities from the four pillars: scholarship, service, leadership, and character. Membership not only recognizes students for their accomplishments, but challenges them to develop further through active involvement in school activities and community service. Each year, juniors or seniors with a GPA of 3.5 or higher are eligible to complete a Candidate Form. A panel of educators then selects the new members. Monthly meetings will focus on various service opportunities.

It consists of a large group of student leaders who are encouraged to take active roles in philanthropic activities.
