

Harry Tsujimoto Memorial Scholarship

Harry Tsujimoto was a 1944 Graduate of the East Aurora High School. Harry and his family came to the Buffalo area to accept a farm opportunity on a share basis in Elma, New York in December of 1943. Following graduation, Harry earned an agricultural scholarship to Cornell University. Upon graduating from Cornell he served as a research scientist, technical resource person, and mentor to newcomers at Berkeley University of California. While at Berkeley University, he was an author of many published papers along with being recognized as a lecturer who exerted a major influence in the field of plant biology and microbiology.

A scholarship will be awarded to an East Aurora High School senior attending College/University in the Fall of 2022 with postsecondary studies in any of the following fields: Environmental Science, Natural Sciences, Microbiology, or other related major. Financial need and first or second-generation immigrant status will be considered to the extent feasible.

Each applicant is required to submit:

- High School Transcript
- Acceptance letter from a College / University
- Scholarship Application
- Essay

"What was my decision process in pursuing science as a major and upon completion of my degree, how do I see myself utilizing my education in the field of science." Include financial need and first or second-generation immigrant status if applicable.
