9. **WHEREAS**, the Wyckoff School District is desirous of renewing its food service contract with Pomptonian, Inc., its current Food Service Management Company (“FSMC”), now,

NOW BE IT RESOLVED, to renew the Pomptonian, Inc. Food Service Management contract for the 2026-2027 school year, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Wyckoff Board of Education acknowledges that the addendum contains the following language:

The FSMC shall receive, in addition to the costs of operation, a management fee of \$.0977 for each \$1.00 of sales to compensate the FSMC for administrative and management costs. This fee shall be billed monthly as a cost of operation. The District guarantees the payment of such costs and fee to the FSMC.

In the event that no services are required by Pomptonian during periods of time that schools are ordered closed for in person instruction, no fee will apply.
10. To approve the 2026-2027 Eisenhower Middle School Cafeteria Pricelist.
11. To approve the Agreement between the Wyckoff Board of Education and Bergen County Technical Schools Board of Education for technology support services for the period from July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027.

12. Pursuant to PL 2015, Chapter 47, the Wyckoff Board of Education intends to renew, award, or permit to expire contracts previously awarded by the Board of Education. These contracts are, have been, and will continue to be in full compliance with all State and Federal Statutes and Regulations; in particular, New Jersey Title 18A:18 et. seq., NJAC Chapter 23, and Federal Procurement Regulations 2CFR Part 200.317 et. seq.
13. To authorize the close out of the Social Club Fund and transfer the cash balance of \$32,513 to the General Fund.
14. **WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-14.3 and N.J.A.C 6A:23A-14.4, the Wyckoff Board of Education (the "Board") may, by resolution, supplement a Capital Reserve, Maintenance Reserve, and Emergency Reserve account(s) through a transfer of unanticipated revenue and/or unexpended line-item appropriation amounts during the period of June 1 through June 30 for withdrawal in subsequent school years; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined to retain as year-end unreserved, undesignated fund balance for the year end June 30, 2026 an amount not to exceed the State allowable 2% cap plus an additional \$750,000 with the excess above this amount to be deposited as follows: \$350,000 deposited into Maintenance Reserve, \$250,000 into Emergency Reserve, with the balance to be deposited into Capital Reserve, in an amount not to exceed the maximum allowable amount set forth in the Board's Long Range Facilities Plan, subject to the verification upon completion of the Audit;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby authorizes the District's School Business Administrator to make these transfers consistent with all applicable laws and regulations.
