Public Hearing and Final Adoption of the 2025-2026 Budget

Dr. Gouraige and Ms. Ambrose made a detailed presentation of the 2025-2026 Budget followed by an opportunity for public comments. The district continues to build on the new programs implemented this school year. No one in the public wished to speak.

Mr. Sprague had the following comments/inquiries:

The positions of Guidance counselor and Supervisor of Child Study team are not new positions, rather filling currently vacant positions.

He asked what the percentage of increase to Health Benefits versus the health adjustment to the tax levy. The increase in premiums is approximately \$240,000.

He asked about the anticipated withdrawal from Capital Reserve. When the district receives the grant for the playground it will offset the withdrawal, and the capital reserve funds may be returned to capital reserve in the future. Additionally, there was a discussion regarding the quote received from Ben Shaffer under the cooperative bid.

The budgeted IDEA funds are used to offset some out of district tuitions, and Title I funding is used to address academically at risk students.

A Referendum Survey went to the Mayor & Parents of students and a "Pop-Up" link will be put on our school website as well as posting in local businesses throughout town. The survey closes on May 9, 2025.

Ms. Garcia thanked Ms. Ambrose and Dr. Gouraige, as well as the Finance Committee, for all of the work that goes into developing the Budget.
