SCHOOL BUS RULES AND EXPECTATIONS

The following are expectations of student behavior while riding the bus:

- Students shall be kind and courteous to the driver and fellow students.
- Students shall have written permission to leave the bus other than at regular stops.
- Respect assigned seats that may be made.
- Be on time for the bus both morning and afternoon.
- When necessary to cross the road, students shall cross in front of the bus as instructed by the driver.
- Keep your hands to yourself and do not touch other people's property.

Unacceptable Behaviors:

- Refusing to follow directions from the driver.
- Fighting, name calling, wrestling, or boisterous activity on the bus.
- Eating or drinking on the bus, (candy, gum, drinks, etc.) Except water.
- Using profanity or being disrespectful, please use inside voices at all times.
- Students shall not carry any glass containers or other glass objects on the bus.
- Standing or changing seats while the bus is in motion. If you would like to change seats please ask the driver and wait until the bus is stopped and the driver gives the okay to do so.
- Taking pictures and videos of other students.
- Throwing objects on the bus of any kind including paper, wrappers, pencils, etc.
- Extending arms, legs, feet and backpacks in the aisles. Aisles must be kept clear at all times.
- Extending hands, arms or heads through windows. Refrain from yelling out the windows or opening windows without permission from the driver.
- Leaving trash, garbage or unwanted belongings on the bus.
- Possessing and/or use of alcohol, tobacco or illegal drugs.
- Spraying hairspray, perfume, deodorant, body spray or other like item.
- Removing or rearranging seat assignment name tags on the bus.
- Using the emergency exits when not in an emergency situation, including the doors and windows.
- Bringing weapons, knives, firearms or other potentially hazardous materials on the bus.
- Bringing animals on the bus, except approved ADA Service Animals.
- Bringing skateboards, musical instruments, or other large objects which might pose safety risks or barriers to safely exiting from the bus.

We want everyone riding the bus to have a safe and comfortable ride. Corrective actions will be taken in order to keep the bus environment safe for everyone.
