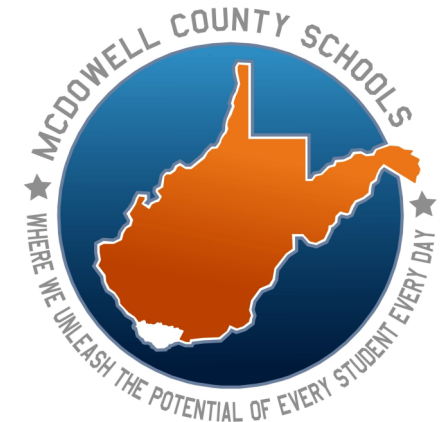

McDowell County Schools Strategic Plan Overview 2024-2025



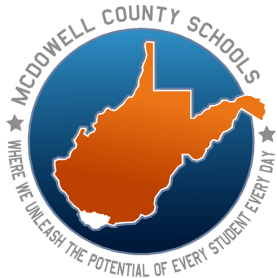
