

OFFICIAL MINUTES
BOWMAN COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT #1

The Special Meeting of the Bowman County School Board was held on Monday, November 3rd at 5:00pm in the Bowman County High School Conference Room. Members present: President Stacy McGee, Vice President Chad Njos & Board Members Amy Fischer, Camie Janikowski, Andy Mrnak, Kirsten Stotts, Laura Wallman. Others present: Superintendent Anni Carlson, Business Manager Lauren Sense.

1. **Call to Order:** President Stacy McGee called meeting to order @ 5:02pm
2. **Pledge Of Allegiance**
3. Rhame Music Transportation:

Public Comment: McGee opened the floor for the individuals who signed-up for public comment, 4 individuals (Lyndsay Fossom, Blaine Homelvig, Kim Oakland, and Jessica Sarsland) each speaker was allowed up to 5 minutes to speak. Discussion continued among Board Members and Administrators.

McGee asked the Administration if they would like to speak and add anything more to the printed three Options given to the Board. Administration declined.

McGee read outloud the three Options provided by Administrators.

Fischer moved to provide all educational services for Rhame students at the Rhame campus. This includes interventions, support services and all electives, with the sole exception of band, Stotts seconded the motion. Discussion was held. McGee called for the vote, motion passed with Janikowski & Mrnak voting no.

3. **Adjournment at 5:21 pm.**

At 5:47 the Special Meeting reconvened at the request to clarify the passed motion on services for Rhame campus. Members Present included: McGee, Njos, Wallman, Stotts, Fischer, Janikowski, Carlson, Sense and Mrnak via phone.

The Administration requested clarification on how to proceed with implementation. Administration was concerned that the motion implied replication all Bowman Campus services in Rhame for students, which would disrupt the master schedule.

Fischer stated the motion's intent is for Rhame students to continue receiving the services they have historically received in Rhame, such as interventions and title services, potentially being delivered by paras or virtually in Rhame. Band can be an exception for students to travel to Bowman, the intent of the motion was not to disrupt the master schedule.

No further discussion.

Meeting adjourned at 5:47 pm.
