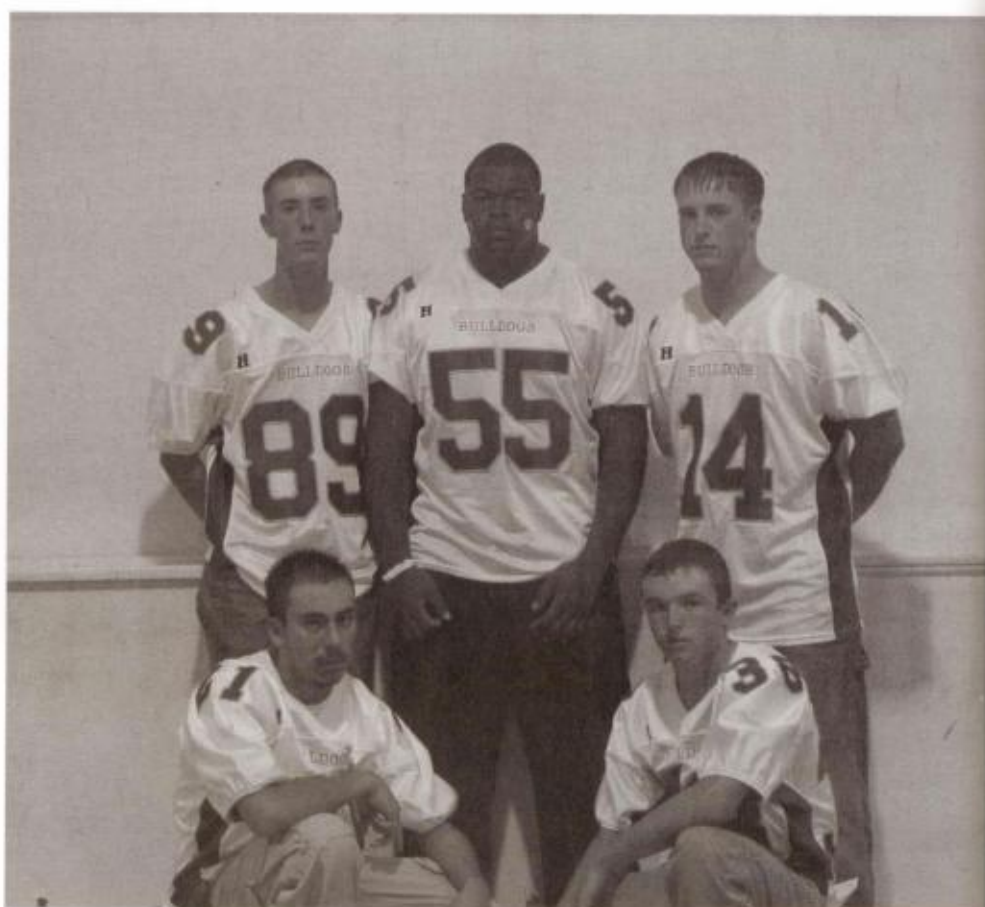
Sharing the spirit

RUN, SYDNEY, RUN! Sydney Robertson is about to cross the finish line after running the 1600m run. I'm glad she's the one having to do that and not me.

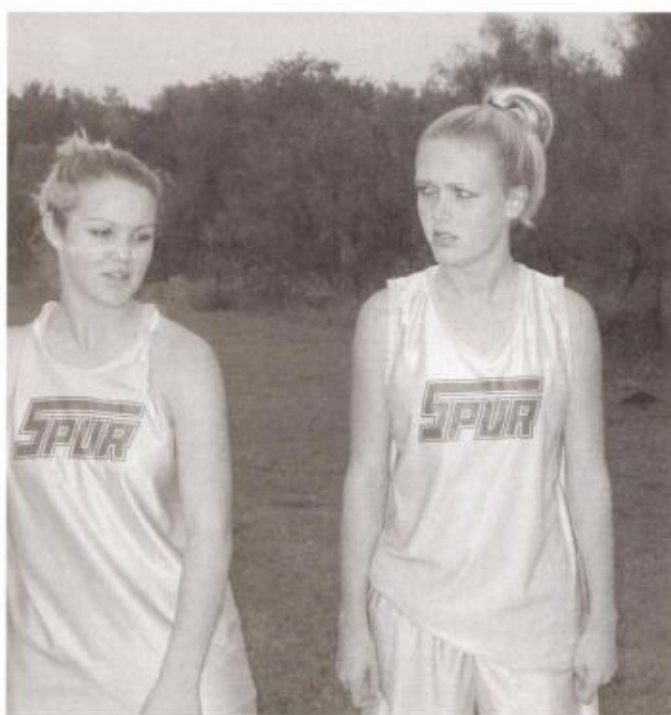

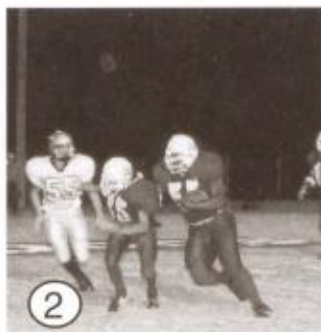

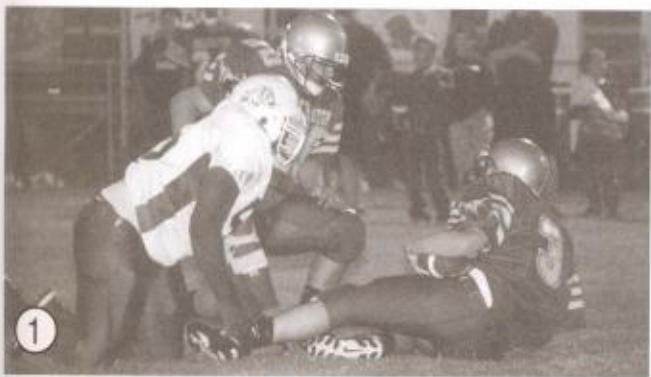

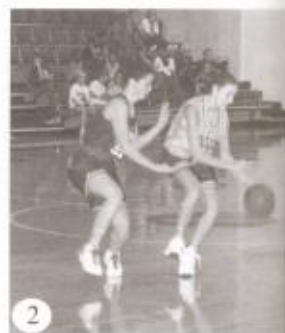

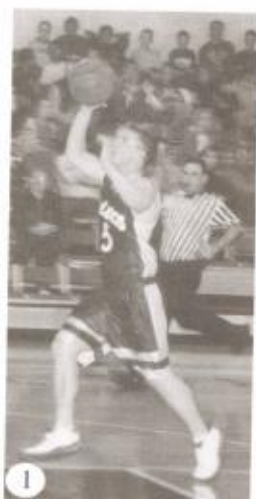

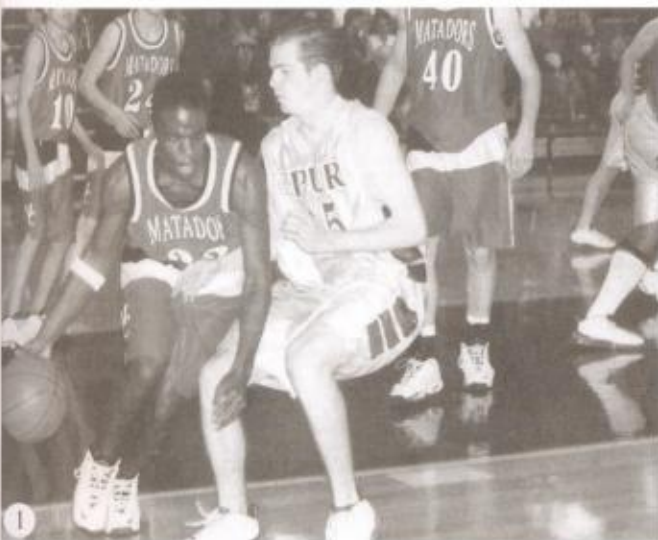

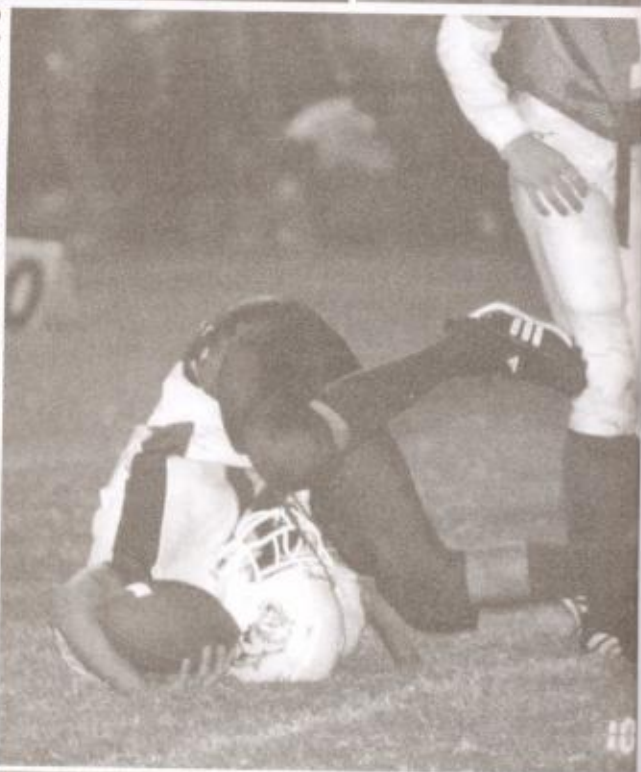

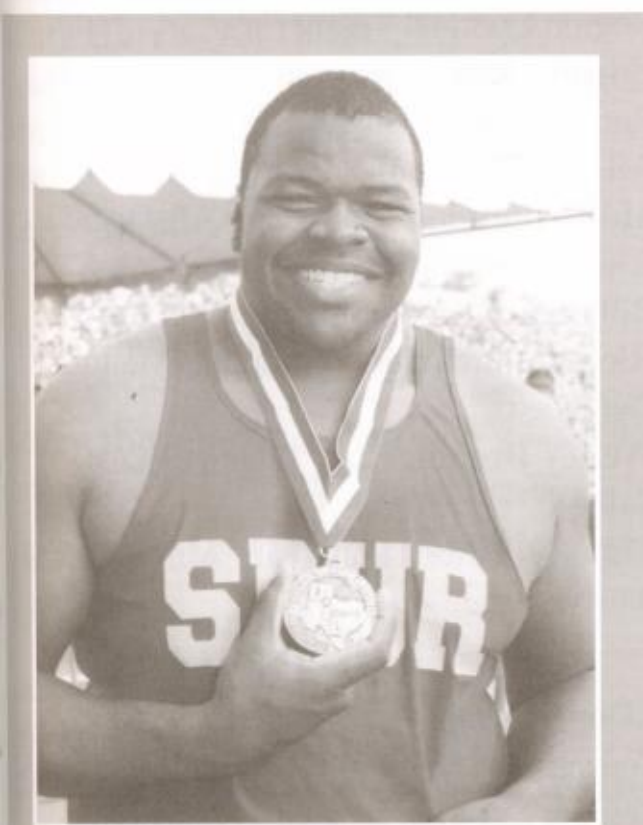

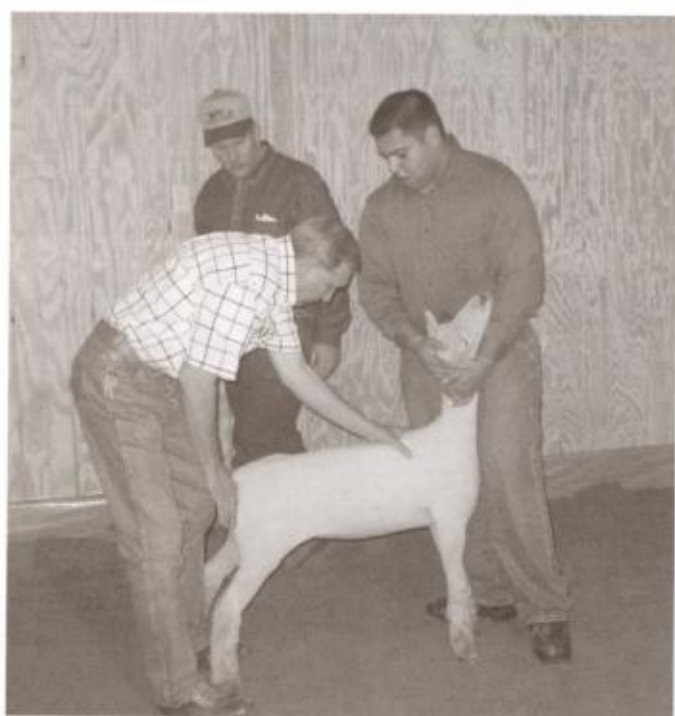

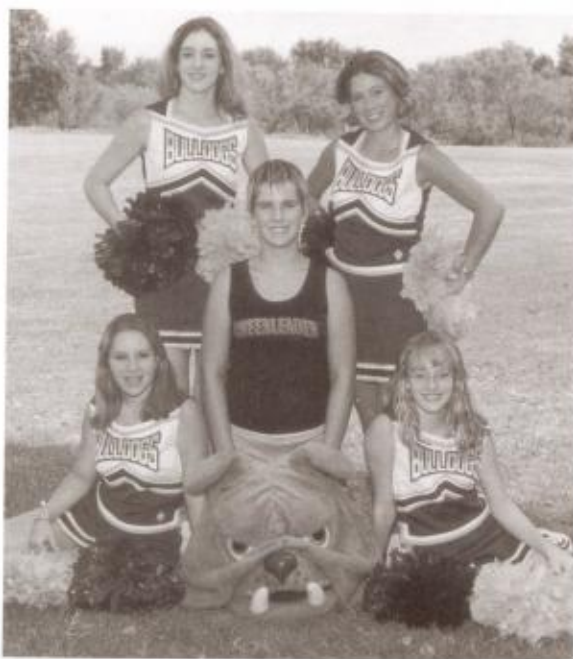

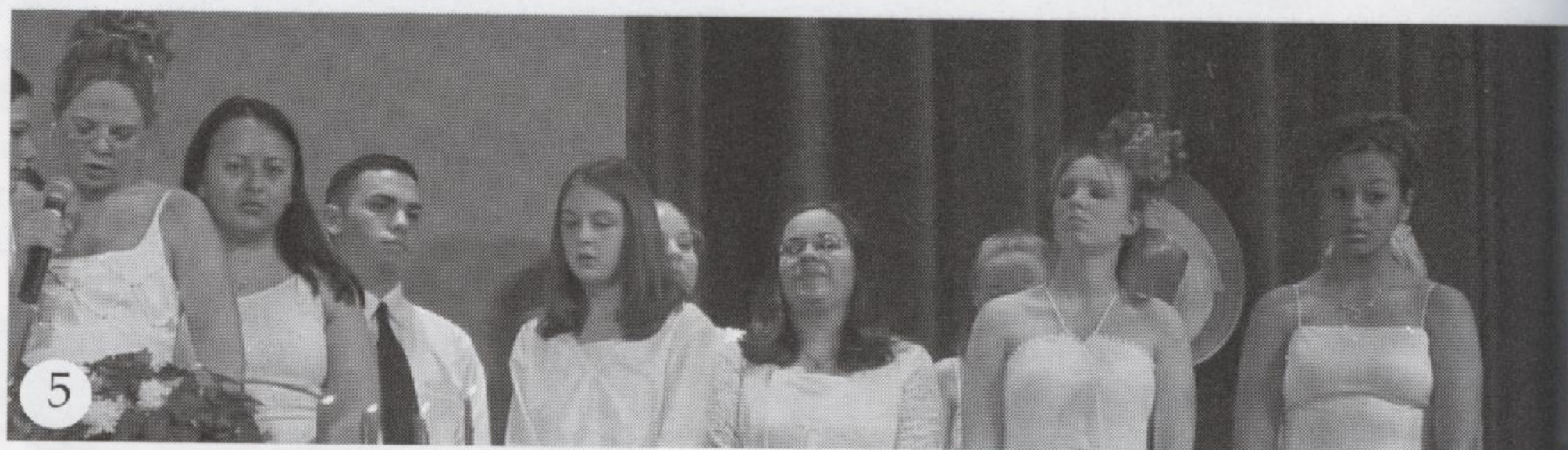
