* ALL high school seniors and their families should fill out and submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). This application determines families' eligibility for federal grants (money you don't have to pay back), work-study (where the student has a federally funded job on campus), low-interest student loans, and scholarships. The only way to find out if you qualify is to fill out the form. Federal tax information will be used to determine the student's eligibility for financial aid.
