PROGRAMS

The Wonder Program is designed to promote self-confidence, self-esteem and to encourage socialization with peers through art projects, singing, stories, sensory and motor activities. Play is also an integral part of each day.

- Ages 3 years to 5 years (Age 3 by November 15 and potty trained)
- Number of days are flexible
- Half or Full Day Available

The Discover Program (Pre-Kindergarten) prepares children for kindergarten within a play-based environment. The Discover Program encourages cognitive, social, and language development through early literacy and early math programs,

problem-solving, art, music, dramatic play, and group learning activities.

- Age 4 by August 1
- Number of days are flexible
- Half or Full Day Available

Early Care (7:00-8:15AM) is for children enrolled in the morning programs only.

The Valley Park Early Childhood teachers are committed to teaching the whole child. The staff of experienced teachers is able to meet the needs of each child as an individual, as well as prepare them with school readiness academics. The teachers use positive reinforcement when working with our early learners to teach them how to be good citizens and friends in the classroom.

Parent communication is an integral part of our program. Parent/teacher conferences are held during the school year to inform you of your child's academic and social development.
