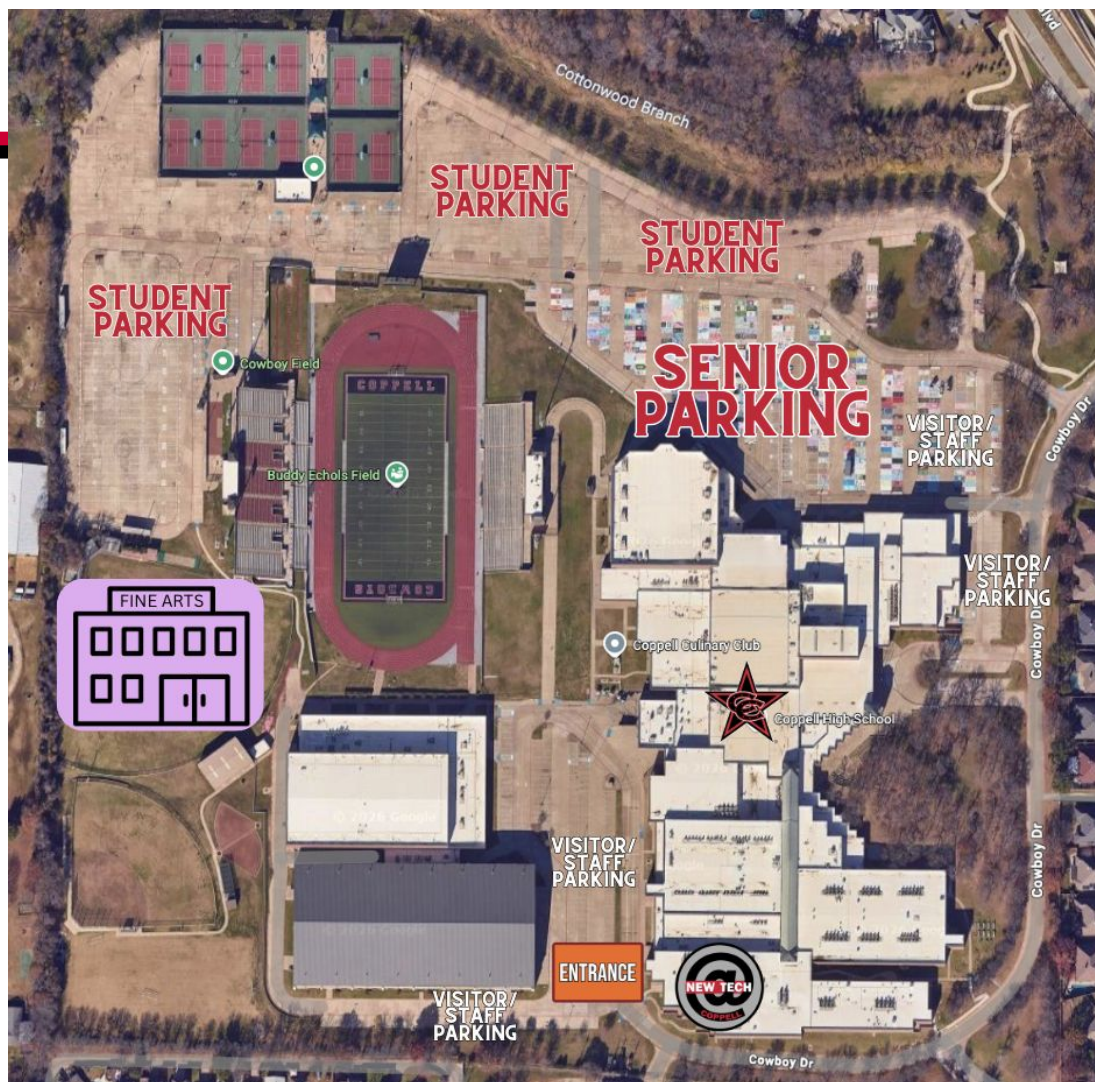

Operational Changes

Parking – Parking will follow CHS guidelines. Learners may purchase a general parking pass, and seniors may purchase a reserved painted parking spot. Because NTH@C begins earlier (8:00 AM), congestion in hallways and parking lots should be reduced.

Entrances – There will be five entrances into NTH@C: four from interior hallways or stairwells and one exterior entrance. At each of these doors, learners will be able to move both into and out of the NTH@C space, while the doors and interior design will clearly signal that they are entering a different school space.



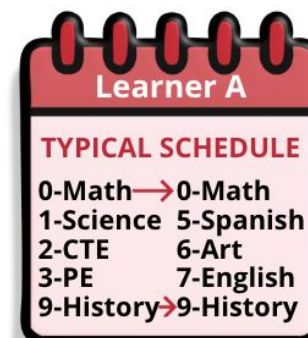


Operational Changes

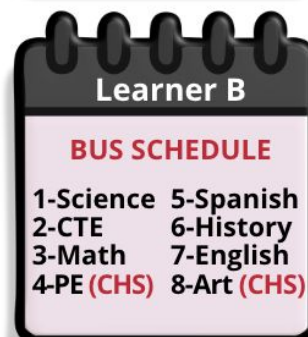
Transportation – Transportation will be provided from home, if needed, based on qualifications, to NTH@C/CHS or CHS9, following the CHS base schedule of periods 1–8.

Scheduling – Learners will either follow the NTH@C schedule with a 0-Hour and 9th Period (which replace 4th and 8th periods) or be scheduled for 1st–8th period on the traditional schedule. Unless learners have a class or transportation exception, they will follow the 8:00 AM–3:25 PM schedule.

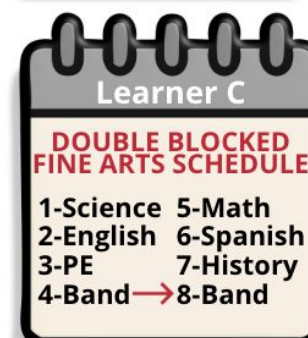
Shared Spaces – Scheduling for shared spaces (gyms, large areas, lecture hall, commons, etc.) will be coordinated between NTH@C and CHS administration. Both schools will reserve spaces as needed, with shared responsibility and flexibility.

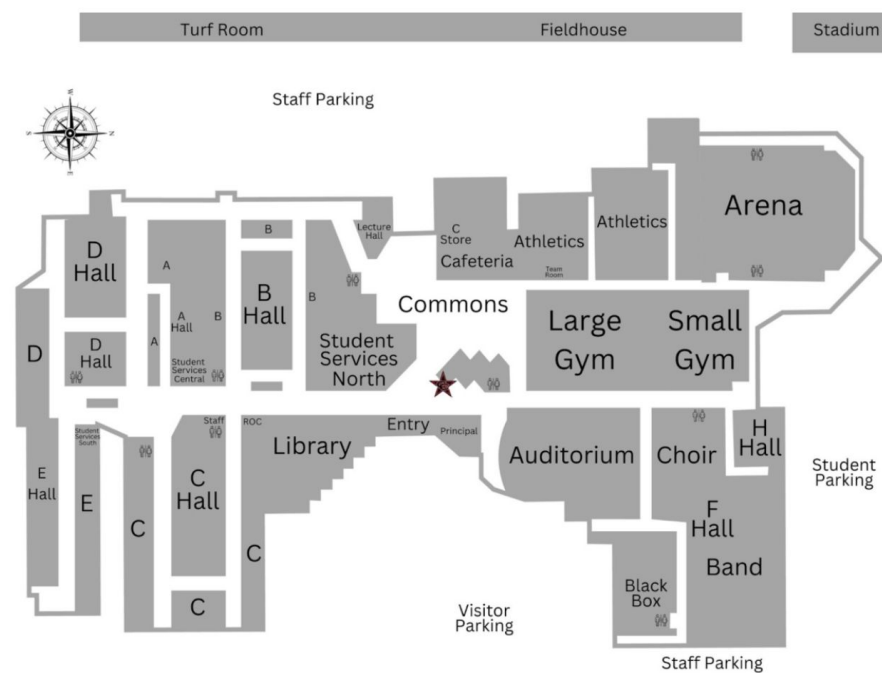


Meeting Student Needs

Continuation of NTH@C Culture

- Some events will be combined with CHS as they are now like adulting day, homecoming, fine arts and athletics, etc.
- Culture building events like Olympics, Snacker Challenge, NTH@C Pep Rallies, etc. will be separate.
- New opportunities for collaboration and celebration will occur too, since we will be on the same campus.
- Many clubs and organization will remain school based, especially StuCo, NTC, and Yearbook.
- The learners and sponsors of NTC, StuCo, HOPE Squad lead the charge for preserving the culture of NTH@C; however, administration will provide accountability and protection for those groups to plan and create.
- Learners and staff have been a part of the “culture shaping” phase of this relocation through committees and conversations about the changes in location, schedules, architecture, etc. These conversations and this planning will continue into the new school year.
- A strong indicator of preserved culture will rely on “user feedback.” NTH@C will have periodic round tables to discuss “thorns, roses, and buds” as a reflection of cultural strength and determining needs for future changes.
- Streamlining Capstone to the fall and adding some senior showcase celebrations in the spring to highlight the effects of NTH@C culture on learners and the community.

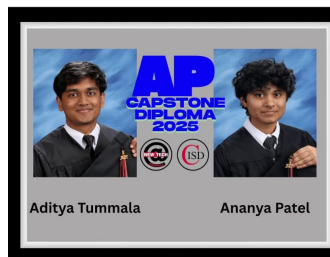
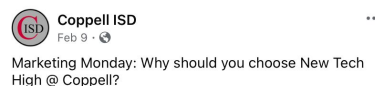
